This Bibliography on Mental Retardation has been developed to provide special educators, supervisors of special education, students, and researchers with a comprehensive listing of the major references in the area of the education of the mentally retarded. The Bulletin has been divided into four separate sections: (1) Professional Literature; (2) Professional Curriculum; (3) General Literature; and (4) Historical Literature. The reader has also been provided with a current listing of publishers.

The bibliography is not an exhaustive listing. An attempt has been made to include most of the major and better-known references in the field to date. The student will need to seek other references for journal and periodical reports of research studies in mental retardation.
