

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Introduction

This index has been compiled to provide users with a useful reference tool with which to identify and utilize documents on educational administration indexed and abstracted by the ERIC Clearinghouse on Educational Administration from September 1966 to August 1967.

The index is organized in two parts: Part I contains a list of terms used to identify major subjects found in the documents. Beneath each term is a list of accession numbers which correspond to each document in the clearinghouse collection. Part II contains a sequential listing of each document by clearinghouse accession number, EA 000 001 through EA 000 598.

To obtain documents referenced in this index:

1. Determine the subject to be searched. You want, perhaps, to locate documents containing information about inservice education of elementary school principals.
2. Locate the appropriate terms in the subject index. For this particular topic, you would look up elementary schools, inservice programs, and principals.
3. Coordinate the terms with the document numbers. The terms elementary schools, inservice programs, and principals all list document EA 000 469.
4. Match the relevant document numbers with the bibliographic citations in Part II.

5. Obtain abstracts of the documents desired. Documents with an asterisk (*) in front of the document number may also be found in Research in Education, a monthly catalog available from the Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402. Cost is one dollar per issue or \$11.00 per year domestic; \$13.75 foreign.

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
