This analysis involves enrollment data from Fall 1966 through Spring 1968. It compares two colleges and all California junior colleges in terms of age (defined as adults, minors, and baccalaureate degree holders or higher) and hours of attendance (12 or more hours as full-time, less than 12 hours as part-time) of students. Tables provide data as follows: (1) annual increase or decrease in graded classes by full-time or part-time students. The part-time category is analyzed as adults (age 21 and over, enrolled for fewer than ten class hours) and other (students with an Associate of Arts degree or higher); (2) same data as above but for ungraded classes (those for adults); (3) Spring 1968 enrollment of freshmen, sophomores, and all others (students with an Associate of Arts degree or higher) in graded classes analyzed by full- and part-time status as described in (1) above; (4) Spring 1968 enrollment of minors, defined adults, and other adults in ungraded classes (classes for adults) analyzed by full- or part-time status. Spring, 1968

There were 5,839 students enrolled in all Spring, 1968 classes at Golden West College, an increase of 475 (8.9 percent) from the Fall, 1967 total enrollment.

A total of 14,842 students were enrolled in all Orange Coast College classes for Spring, 1968, representing an increase of 2.2 percent (332) from the Spring, 1967 total of 14,510. There were 164 (1.1 percent) more students in the Spring semester than in the preceding Fall when there were a total of 14,678 in all classes.

All California public junior colleges enrolled 600,526 students in all their Spring, 1968 classes. This is a decrease of 1.7 percent, 10,243 students, over the Fall, 1967 total of 610,769 students, but an increase of 54,100, 9.9 percent, from the Spring, 1967 total of 546,426.

Table I shows the number of active student enrollments in graded classes for the Fall, 1966 through the Spring, 1968 semesters and Table II shows the active enrollments in ungraded classes for the same period of time.

Enrollments in Graded Classes, Golden West College, Spring, 1968.
A total of 5,350 students were enrolled in graded courses with 2,246 (42.0 percent) of these in day classes. Full time enrollments in day classes were 1,450, 69.3 percent of which were male and 445, 30.7 percent were female students.

A total of 3,104 (58.0 percent) of the graded enrollments were in extended day classes. Extended day enrollments were 49.7 percent male and 50.3 percent female.

Enrollments in Graded Classes, Orange Coast College, Spring, 1968.
A total of 6,189 (43.2 percent) of the graded enrollments were in day classes. Full time enrollments in day classes were 4,077 and in extended day classes 33. Day graded full time enrollments were 68.8 percent male and 31.2 percent female.

A total of 8,135 (56.8 percent) of the graded enrollments were in extended day classes. Extended day enrollments were 56.3 percent male and 43.7 percent female.

Enrollments in Graded Classes, All California Junior Colleges, Spring, 1968. There was a total of 283,702 of the graded enrollments in day classes in all California junior colleges. Full time enrollments in day graded classes were 189,793 and in the extended classes 2,626.

Enrollments in Ungraded Classes, Golden West College, Spring 1968.
Enrollments in ungraded classes (classes for adults) totaled 489.

Enrollments in Ungraded Classes, Orange Coast College, Spring, 1968.
Enrollments in ungraded classes (classes for adults) totaled 518. All were enrolled in extended day classes.

Enrollments in Ungraded Classes, California Junior Colleges, Spring 1968.
Enrollments in ungraded classes (classes for adults) in California junior colleges totaled 94,347. Of this number, 5,548 were enrolled in 12 or more class hours. Only 2,406 were in extended day classes and the remainder (3,142) were in day classes.

Enrollments by Student Classification, Golden West College, Spring, 1968.
In Golden West College, freshman students represented the largest percentage of all enrollments in graded classes. Of the 5,350 graded enrollments (Table III); 3,784 (70.7 percent) were freshmen; 1,245 (23.3 percent) were sophomores, and 321 (6.0 percent) were classified "all others"*. Day classes enrolled 1,531 freshmen, 701 sophomores, and 14 all others. Extended day classes enrolled 2,253 freshmen, 544 sophomores, and 307 all others.

Enrollments by Student Classification, Orange Coast College, Spring, 1968.
In Orange Coast College, freshman students represented the largest percentage of all enrollments in graded classes. Of the 14,324 graded enrollments (Table III), 9,646 (67.3 percent) were freshmen; 3,559 (24.8 percent) were sophomores, and 1,119 (7.8 percent) were classified all others. Day classes enrolled 1,176 freshmen, 1,883 sophomores, and 130 all others. Extended day classes enrolled 5,470 freshmen, 1,676 sophomores, and 989 all others.

Enrollments by Student Classification, California Junior Colleges, Spring, 1968. Freshman students, both full and part time, represented the largest percentage of all enrollments in graded classes. Of the 506,179 graded enrollments (Table III), 338,154 (66.8 percent) were freshmen; 138,102 (27.3 percent) were sophomores, and 29,923 (5.9 percent) were classified all others. Day classes enrolled 186,204 freshmen, 91,125 sophomores, and 6,373 all others. Extended day classes enrolled 151,950 freshmen, 46,977 sophomores, and 23,550 all others.

Table IV indicates the number of Golden West College and Orange Coast College Students in Ungraded Classes, Spring, 1968. Of the total number of students taking 12 or more hours of work, all were in extended day classes at Orange Coast College. The total number of part time students in ungraded classes was 518 at Orange Coast College and 489 at Golden West College, all of whom were extended day students. There were 84 minors in extended day classes at Orange Coast College and 65 at Golden West.

Table IV also indicates the number of Junior College Students in Ungraded Classes in all California Public Junior Colleges. Of the total number of students taking 12 or more hours of work (5,548), 3,142 of them were in day classes and 2,406 were in extended day classes. The total number of part time students was 88,799 in ungraded classes. 12,183 of the defined adults were in day classes while 68,519 were in extended day classes. 912 of the other part time were in day classes and 7,185 were in extended day classes.

* "All others" refers to students who have been awarded the Associate of Arts degree only or who have a baccalaureate or equivalent or higher degree.
