ABSTRACT

The document is designed to assist individuals seeking federal scholarships for professional training in the education of handicapped children. Information is provided defining handicapped children, the purposes of scholarships, types of scholarships available, and payment of tuition and fees. Also, details are given regarding who may receive a scholarship and how and where to apply. A directory lists state educational agencies and institutions of higher learning offering federal scholarships. Entries, arranged by state or territory, specify scholarship award areas and types of scholarships available. (JD)

The scholarship program is administered by the Division of Training Programs of the Bureau of Education for the Handicapped, Office of Education, U.S. Department of Health, Education, and Welfare. The primary aim of the Division of Training Programs is to provide the best educational practices to all handicapped children.

DISCRIMINATION PROHIBITED

Grants made under Public Law 85-926, as amended, are subject to the regulations in 45 CFR, part 80, issued by the Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare, and approved by the President to effectuate

the provisions of section 601 of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Public Law 88-352).

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 states: "No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance." Therefore, the Program for the Preparation of Personnel in the Education of Handicapped Children, like every program or activity receiving financial assistance from the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, must be operated in compliance with this law.

NOTE: The term "State," as used in this publication, refers to the 50 States of the Union, the District of Columbia, American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands.

This publication is designed to assist individuals who are seeking Federal scholarships for professional training in the education of handicapped children.

WHO ARE HANDICAPPED CHILDREN?

Handicapped children are defined as being "mentally retarded, hard of hearing, deaf, speech impaired, visually handicapped, seriously emotionally disturbed, crippled, or other health impaired children who by reason thereof require special education." (Public Law 85-926, as amended)

WHAT ARE THE PURPOSES OF SCHOLARSHIPS?

Scholarships are provided through institutions of higher education and State educational agencies to encourage promising persons to prepare or to improve their competencies for positions in the education of handicapped children as:

- Teachers, speech correctionists, physical educators, or recreation specialists
- Supervisors or administrators
- Other specialists providing special services
- Professors for institutions of higher education
- Researchers

WHAT TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE?¹

■ Undergraduate Traineeships

Traineeships are provided for full-time study at the junior or senior

year levels with major emphasis in area(s) of the handicapped.

Traineeships are for 1 academic year. An individual may be awarded only one traineeship at each level.

The recipient of a junior year traineeship receives a stipend of \$300; the recipient of a senior year traineeship receives \$800.

■ Graduate Fellowships

Fellowships are for full-time study at graduate levels with major emphasis in area(s) of the handicapped.

Fellowships are for 1 academic year. An individual may be awarded a total of four fellowships under this program.

A recipient of a master's level fellowship receives a stipend of \$2,200 plus \$600 for each dependent, excluding the fellowship recipient.

In each year of study, a recipient of a post-master's level fellowship receives a stipend of \$3,200 plus \$600 for each dependent, excluding the fellowship recipient.

■ Summer Traineeships

Summer traineeships are for study in area(s) of the handicapped during college or university summer sessions.

Each recipient of a summer traineeship receives a stipend of \$15 a day, with a maximum of \$75 a week.

¹Stipend and dependency allowances are usually not subject to Federal income tax. Policy concerning this is set forth in Revenue Ruling No. 58-498, published in Internal Revenue Bulletin No. 1958-41, dated October 13, 1958. This bulletin is on file in all Internal Revenue Service district offices and local field offices.

■ Special Study Institute Traineeships

Traineeships for special study institutes enable the recipients to participate in a planned program of study sponsored by an institution of higher education or a State educational agency for intensive study, and to acquire experiences relating to handicapped children. The institute, when sponsored by an institution of higher education, must be held for at least 3 consecutive days, but may be held for a longer period of time. When sponsored by a State educational agency, the institute must be held for not less than 2 consecutive days, or not less than 1 day per week for 3 consecutive weeks.

Granting of academic credit is at the discretion of the institution or agency conducting the institute.

Each recipient of a special study institute traineeship receives a stipend of \$15 a day or actual expenses in lieu of the stipend depending upon the agreement between the organization conducting the institute and the U.S. Office of Education.

WHO PAYS TUITION AND FEES?

Tuition and fees are supplied by the institution of higher education and may not be charged to an individual recipient holding a:

- Senior year traineeship
- Graduate fellowship
- Summer traineeship
- Special study institute traineeship

WHO MAY RECEIVE A SCHOLARSHIP?

The following minimum qualifica-

tions are required for participation in the scholarship program:

1. The recipient must be:

A teacher, a speech correctionist, a physical educator, a recreation specialist, a supervisor, an administrator, or other specialist in the education of handicapped children; or a person preparing for such a position; or

A person engaged in, or preparing to engage in, college teaching or research in fields related to the education of handicapped children; or

A person who works with, or whose administrative responsibility includes, the handicapped—e.g., principal, psychologist, social worker. These persons are mainly recipients of special study institute traineeships.

2. The recipient of an undergraduate traineeship, graduate fellowship, or summer traineeship must be accepted by an institution of higher education for full-time study with primary program emphasis in area(s) of the handicapped. This is not required for a special study institute traineeship.

3. The recipient of a senior year traineeship must be able to complete the requirements for the baccalaureate degree or its equivalent.

4. The recipient must be a citizen or a national of the United States, or be in the United States for other than a temporary purpose and intend to become a permanent resident.

5. Generally a recipient cannot simultaneously receive two Federal stipends or grants for educational benefits. However, he may receive

benefits concurrently under Public Law 82-550, as amended (Veterans Readjustment Assistance Act of 1952), as well as loans or work-study assistance.

HOW AND WHERE TO APPLY?

A person desiring to apply for a scholarship under this program should direct inquiries to his State educational agency, or to the institution of higher education he wishes to attend.

Final dates for receipt of applications are set by the State educational agency or institution and are generally well in advance of the beginning date of training. Further information and application materials are available only from the participating State educational agencies or institutions of higher education, not from the Bureau of Education for the Handicapped.

To assist applicants in determining where to inquire about a scholarship, a directory is provided on the following pages. Agencies and institutions are grouped by State. State educational agencies are listed first; institutions of higher education are then listed alphabetically within the State.²

For institutions of higher education, the alphabetical code used to

²It would be wise for persons seeking scholarships not to restrict their inquiries only to institutions listed in this directory. There are some training programs with scholarships from other sources such as foundations, professional associations, fraternal organizations, and State or local governmental agencies which are not listed in this directory.

identify the scholarship AWARD AREAS is:

- A Administrators of Special Education
- CR Crippled
- D Deaf
- ED Emotionally Disturbed
- IN Interrelated
- LD Learning Disabilities
- MH Multiple Handicapped
- MR Mentally Retarded
- PE Physical Education
- R Recreation
- SH Speech and Hearing
- VH Visually Handicapped

The type of scholarships are identified by a numerical code used in conjunction with the AWARD AREA abbreviations. The number assigned to each TYPE of scholarship is:

- 1—Junior year traineeship, academic year
- 2—Senior year traineeship, academic year
- 3—Master's fellowship, academic year
- 4—Post-master's fellowship, academic year
- 5—Summer traineeship
- 6—Special Study Institute

For example, a person wishing to identify INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION which offer SENIOR YEAR type traineeships in the MENTAL RETARDATION award area should seek the code combination MR-2 in the directory.

Numerical codes enclosed in parentheses, e.g., (4), indicate that there is a reasonable likelihood these TYPES of scholarships will be offered as indicated. However, at the time the directory was sent to the printer, the processing of these grants had not

been completed by the U.S. Office of Education. If distribution of this information had been delayed, users of the directory would not have the information in time to meet application deadlines at many institutions of higher education. Therefore, it is recommended that users inquire for the TYPES of scholarships in parentheses as if these had final confirmation from the U.S. Office of Education.

No abbreviations or numerical codes are provided for the State educational agencies listed. They have the authority to offer scholarships in any area of the handicapped, but may choose not to offer any in certain areas. Therefore, inquiries should be made directly to State educational agencies to ascertain what kinds of scholarships are available.
