## INTRODUCTION

RECREATION: A BIBLIOGRAPHY OF SELECTED DOCUMENTS FROM ERIC is a bibliography of documents taken from RESEARCH IN EDUCATION, a monthly publication of the Educational Resources Information Center (ERIC). RESEARCH IN EDUCATION (RIE) is a monthly index which lists resumes of documents published by ERIC. The documents from RIE are available in two forms, hardcopy or microfiche. Hardcopy is reproduced copies of original documents and microfiche are 4 x 6 film cards which must be read using a special reader.

The purpose of compiling the bibliography was to re-package material found in the ERIC system to enable this material to reach more people. It was hoped that this form of re-packaging would allow for easier access and more efficient use of ERIC materials.

The documents found in this bibliography were collected by a search of the 1967, 1968, and 1969 indexes of RIE. Seven descriptors were used in the search; Recreation, Recreational Activities, Recreational Facilities, Recreational Finances, Recreational Legislation, Recreational Programs and Recreational Reading. Only documents with the above descriptors were selected and reviewed. Those documents that had little relevance to the title were not included.

The bibliography is by no means complete. It is meant only to serve as an aid to people using the ERIC system. For those who wish to have a more complete listing, especially in other related fields, the author would suggest using descriptors other than those used in this search.

# APPENDIX

## HOW TO ORDER ERIC DOCUMENTS

ERIC (Educational Resources Information Center) is a national information network sponsored by the U.S. Office of Education as a means of providing the public with information about current research in education. Central ERIC, in Washington, D.C. coordinates the activities of 19 clearinghouses, each focusing on a specific area of education. The Clearinghouses are located at Universities and institutions throughout the United States.

Each clearinghouse is responsible for indexing, abstracting and disseminating documents in its field. Documents, together with resumes, are sent to ERIC Document Reproduction Service (EDRS). The documents are assigned an ED number and published in Research in Education, ERIC's monthly abstracting journal.

Once the document appears in Research in Education, it is available to the public either in microfiche or hard copy form. Microfiche is a transparent sheet of film on which up to 70 consecutive pages of a document can be camera-recorded. These 4 x 6 microfiche cards cannot be read without the use of a microfiche reader. Hard Copy is a 6 x 8 print-out of the microfiche. Each microfiche card costs 25¢. Hard copy costs 5¢ per page. The price of each ED document is listed in the resume. Be sure to cite the correct ED number for each document you order. Specify how many copies of each you want and whether you want microfiche or hard copy. Payment (check or money order, no stamps) must accompany orders under \$5.00. Add a special handling charge of 50¢ to all orders. If your state has sales tax, figure the percentage and add it to the cost of your order or submit a tax exemption certificate. If you plan to order regularly, you may want to set up a charge account. A deposit account of prepaid EDRS coupons is available.
