## ABSTRACT

This is a two-part bibliography of recently received textbooks and professional resources in the Educational Materials Center. The bibliography on adult basic education lists publications received between September 1968 and May 1970 for teaching adults the first essential skills of reading, writing, arithmetic, community living, and citizenship. Only materials specifically developed for adult basic education are included. Performance levels of materials listed range from 0 through seventh or eighth grade; however, seventh and eighth grade materials are included only if they are part of a sequential program beginning within the elementary grade range. All materials related to teaching English to speakers of other languages published in the United States since 1965 and received in the Center through April 1970 are included in the second part of the bibliography. ## ADULT BASIC EDUCATION

This bibliography reports on publications received by the Educational Materials Center between September 1968 and May 1970 for teaching adults the first essential skills of reading, writing, arithmetic, community living, and citizenship. The compilers have been guided by the following principles:

1. Only those materials are included which have been specifically developed for adult basic education. The compilers are aware that materials originally prepared for use by elementary and secondary school students have sometimes been used with adult learners. Among the Center's holdings of about 5,000 current textbooks are some which have been so used. Visitors to the Center are encouraged to examine these and to evaluate their possibilities for adult basic education. However, such materials have not been included in this bibliography.

2. The performance levels of materials listed here range from 0 through seventh or eighth grade. However, the only material of seventh or eighth grade level included is that which is part of a sequential program beginning well within the elementary grade range. Material for adults which begins at seventh or eighth grade performance level is classed as "Adult Education" and shelved in the Center with publications related to Continuing Education; such material is not included in this bibliography.
