ABSTRACT

INTRODUCTION

Early in 1969, the Sacramento State College Library began publication of a series of bibliographies designed to aid our patrons to make more effective use of existing resource materials. The first publication in the series was entitled; *Chicano Bibliography: Selected Materials on Americans of Mexican Descent*. That list contained some 300 items. The present revised edition contains 1,000 items, reflecting the efforts of the Library staff to acquire relevant materials in a specialized area of considerable interest to many in higher education today. This revised list does not represent all of the Library's resources in this area, but only a survey as of Spring, 1969.

Mrs. Linda Schramko, formerly Assistant Education and Psychology Reference Librarian, was responsible for the revised edition. The staff regrets very much that the relocation of her husband's work forced her resignation from the staff shortly after completing this bibliography.

At the present time, three additional bibliographies in the new series have been issued and others are in preparation. Students, faculty and staff members may obtain copies at the Library's Information Desk or in the several reference departments. Comments and suggestions from users are always welcome.

FOREWORD

This bibliography has been produced as a service to the students and faculty at Sacramento State College. It brings together in one list a selection of the materials available in the Library that deal with the American of Mexican descent. By no means does this list contain the entire Library holdings on the subject--it simply reflects something of the scope of the collection as of the Spring of 1969. The Library has acquired much more material since this list was compiled. The Guide to Further Information at the end of the bibliography indicates some of the sources available for finding further materials concerning the Mexican-American.

The present bibliography is a revised and expanded version of an earlier bibliography produced by librarians John Liberty, Pearl Spayde, and myself. While the first list showed primarily books, the revision also includes periodical articles, master's theses, doctoral dissertations, and microfiche in the Educational Resources Information Center collection. This list contains not only entries concerned directly with the Mexican-American, but also entries that have an indirect bearing or that provide some pertinent background information.

The list is arranged by broad subject categories, with a more detailed subject index at the end. Call numbers are indicated in the margin to the left of the entry; in the case of periodicals, the reference room in which they are located is shown. The acronym, ERIC, denotes the Educational Resources Information Center files; this collection is housed in the Education-Psychology Reference Room. Some items are available in more than one place in the library; such entries have a note giving the second location.

Particular thanks go to the students who compiled the initial entries for this work: Anita Aguirre, Laura Llano, Elizabeth Medina, Kay Coleman, and Ablasha Hunji, all of whom showed great personal interest in the project, and without whose services this bibliography would not now exist. Cherie Finch was the patient typist, who also--fortunately--knew a thing or two about bibliographic form. Sharron Godbois prepared the production stencil. Thanks, too, to all other student assistants who were pressed into service at various times. And, of course, the moral support of library colleagues has been much appreciated.

GUIDE TO FURTHER INFORMATION

The basic source for book-type materials available in the Library is the card catalogue, which lists books concerned with the Mexican-American under several subject headings, depending on the geographical area involved; i.e., MEXICANS IN THE U. S., MEXICANS IN CALIFORNIA, MEXICANS IN TEXAS. Books which do not deal specifically with the Mexican-American, yet which may treat topics of vital importance to him, are listed under a variety of subjects: DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT, DISCRIMINATION IN HOUSING, CHILDREN OF MIGRANT LABORERS--EDUCATION, SOCIALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN--EDUCATION, are but a sample of the possible categories which might be consulted.
