ABSTRACT

Using the Bibliography and the Exhibit

1. CHECK THE PUBLISHER LIST. Many publishers require payment with orders of all types. Some require prepayment with orders of less than \$10, some with orders of less than \$5, and others with orders of less than \$2.
2. The sections listed on the cover are in the same order in both the exhibit and the bibliography.
3. The numbers preceding each author are on the backs of each corresponding book and are sequential in the exhibit arrangement.
4. The publisher's address in full is in the separate alphabetical list of the publishers following the list of books.
5. Most publishers have an educational discount. Some have special printings or limited editions to which a discount does not apply.
6. You may wish to place orders *at the exhibit*. These will be forwarded to the publishers who will bill you directly. No payments here, please.
7. Apply. These books may be in short supply. The requests for a quantity might be refused.
8. If you order from your home, please make note of this exhibit. The publishers have been most cooperative. The Association wishes to have the publishers know of our appreciation in helping to make this exhibit a success.
9. If there are missing books, please notify the exhibit manager. Some books were in short supply and some were out of print, so might be missing from the list. Any omissions are over-sights, and the suggestions are welcomed.
10. *Browse as you wish*. If you cannot find a book, please ask the attendant to help you.

Policy established by the A.A.H.E. Executive Committee limits books in the exhibit and bibliography to those "pertaining to or about higher education, excluding texts unless these texts meet the above notations."

The sixteen sections on the cover are listed in order. At the beginning of each section, there is a short notation of some of the facets included within that section.

Publishers are invited to exhibit. Not all wish to do so every year, so that the list is not inclusive. Cumulative lists of three or four years would be much more comprehensive.
