ABSTRACT

Most of the statistics reported in this Service Record were supplied by the U.S. Office of Education (USOE), National Center for Educational Statistics. USOE compiled the statistics from the information available in the library section of its 1971 Higher Education General Information Survey. The statistics reported are for the 1970/71 school year. The Academic Library Directory reflects the changes brought about as the result of the 1971 merger of university and state university systems in Wisconsin. All institutions have been entered under their appropriate new name. This publication contains a directory (by county) of academic, public and special libraries; statistics on academic libraries; a directory of academic libraries; and a directory and statistics of special libraries. INTRODUCTION

In 1971 the Wisconsin Division for Library Services published in addition to the well-established PUBLIC LIBRARY SERVICE RECORD, a SCHOOL LIBRARY SERVICE RECORD, a SPECIAL LIBRARY SERVICE RECORD and an ACADEMIC LIBRARY SERVICE RECORD. These publications were produced to meet the increasing need of librarians and others for accurate, current information about all types of libraries and information centers in the state. An additional objective was to further and promote interlibrary cooperation. The project was supported in part by funds from Titles I and III of the Library Services and Construction Act.

In 1972 the Division is producing two publications: ACADEMIC AND SPECIAL LIBRARY SERVICE RECORD and PUBLIC LIBRARY SERVICE RECORD.

NOTES ON ACADEMIC LIBRARY INFORMATION:

Most of the academic library statistics reported in this Service Record were supplied to the Division for Library Services by the U. S. Office of Education, National Center for Educational Statistics. USOE compiled the statistics from the information available in the library section of its 1971 Higher Education General Information Survey. A slightly revised edition of this same survey was distributed by the Division for Library Services to those libraries not participating in the USOE survey.

In October of 1971 a bill which merged the former university and state university systems in Wisconsin became effective. The statistics which are published in this Service Record are for the 1970/71 school year. The Academic Library Directory in this Service Record reflects the changes brought about as a result of the merger. All institutions have been entered under their appropriate new name.

INSTITUTIONAL ENROLLMENT, FALL 1971

Enrollment for vocational, technical, adult education institutions includes only those full-time and part-time students enrolled in the full-time programs of the institutions.

REGULAR LIBRARY STAFF (FTE), FALL 1971

Regular Staff is defined as staff in full-time and part-time positions, usually serving with salary contracts. Hourly staff is defined as non-regular staff. If a library had staff members who were paid on an hourly basis but who filled positions for which contract salaries are paid in most other libraries, it was preferable for the purposes of the USOE survey to report such staff with the regular staff.

Professional Librarians are defined as staff doing work that requires training and skill in the theoretical or scientific aspects of library work, as distinct from its mechanical or clerical aspects.

Other Professional Employees are persons who, though not librarians, are in positions normally requiring at least a bachelor's degree.

Nonprofessional Employees are persons in technical assistance, receiving, shipping, storing, secretarial duties, etc., exclusive of custodial service, who are specifically assigned to the library and are covered in the library budget.

A-V and Other Nonprint Materials - expenditures for A-V and other nonprint materials but not for materials in microform.

Other Operating Expenditures - expenditures for wages for non-regular library staff which are charged to the library, binding and rebinding, automation services and all other library operating expenditures.

Total Operating Expenditures - expenditures for salaries, books and other printed materials, A-V and other nonprint materials, and all other operating expenditures as defined above.

LIBRARY COLLECTION, 1970-71

Volume - a volume for reporting purposes is a physical unit of any printed, typewritten, handwritten, mimeographed or processed work contained in one binding or portfolio, hardbound or paperbound, which has been cataloged, classified, and/or made ready for use.

Periodical - a periodical is a publication issued in parts that usually contain articles by several contributors. It generally has a distinctive title and the successive numbers or parts are intended to appear at stated intervals, usually for an indefinite period. It excludes duplicates.

NOTES ON SPECIAL LIBRARY INFORMATION: The special library and information center information reported in this Service Record was taken from either a School of Nursing Library Report 1971 or a Special Library Report 1971. Both surveys were prepared and distributed by the Division for Library Services.

Data concerning the special libraries and information centers are for the last completed reporting year for the library or information center, whether the reporting year was calendar year or fiscal year.

LIBRARY COLLECTION

Volume - a volume is a physical unit of any printed, typewritten, handwritten, mimeographed or processed work contained in one binding or portfolio, hardbound or paperbound, which has been cataloged, classified and/or made ready for use.

LIBRARY STAFF

Professional Library Employees - are professional librarians (those with a fifth year degree in library science) and other library employees who hold positions requiring at least a bachelor's degree.
