ABSTRACT

This document presents a bibliography on the status of collective bargaining in higher education, with specific focus on the literature related to the problems of employee organization and collective bargaining. Given particular emphasis are analyses of the activities of university faculty members rather than those of nonacademic personnel. The bibliography has been categorized into the following areas: (1) Collective Bargaining in Higher Education-General; (2) University Governance; (3) Faculty Collective Bargaining Organizations; (4) Case Studies; and (5) The National Labor Relations Board and Higher Education. ## PREFACE

This bibliography is the second in a series to be published by the Manpower and Industrial Relations Institute of The University of Alabama. Housed within the University's Graduate School of Business and associated with the School's Center for Business and Economic Research, the Institute was established in January 1972 to further the School's teaching, research and technical service programs in the fields related to manpower and industrial relations.

The recent growth of unionism and collective bargaining among government employees has generated great interest among practitioners and researchers in Alabama as well as the rest of the nation. Bibliography No. 1 in our Institute's series, Public Sector Labor Relations, 1972 compiled by Professor Allan D. Spritzer, provides a comprehensive listing of recent scholarly articles on the subject.

Our second bibliography focuses more specifically upon the literature related to the problems of employee organization and collective bargaining in higher education. Given particular emphasis are analyses of the activities of university faculty members rather than those of non-academic personnel.
