ABSTRACT

This document presents an inventory of physical facilities in institutions of higher education in fall 1969. Some of the highlights of the report are: (1) Institutions of higher education had an estimated total of about 1.7 billion square feet of gross floor area as of September 1969 of which about 1.1 billion square feet were classified as assignable space. (2) Publically controlled institutions, with 72% of the full-time equivalent enrollment, had about 60% of the total gross area based on these estimates. (3) When space was classified by room type, the largest amount of assigned area was residential, accounting for 32% of the total, and only about 8% of the total assigned area consisted of classrooms. (4) Academic facilities, including classrooms, laboratories, offices, and libraries, accounted for about 62 assignable square feet per FTE student. (5) Privately controlled 4-year institutions had about 93 square feet of residential area per FTE student, as compared with only about 56 square feet in publically controlled 4-year institutions. ### HIGHLIGHTS

Institutions of higher education had an estimated total of about 1.7 billion square feet of gross floor area as of September 30, 1969. Of this total, about 1.1 billion square feet were classified as assignable space.

Publicly controlled institutions, with 72 percent of the full-time-equivalent (FTE) enrollment, had about 60 percent of the total gross area based on these estimates. Private institutions, with 28 percent of the FTE enrollment, had about 40 percent.

When space was classified by room type, the largest amount of assigned area was residential, accounting for 32 percent of the total. Only about 8 percent of the total assigned area consisted of classrooms.

Academic facilities, including classrooms, laboratories, offices, and libraries, accounted for about 62 assignable square feet per FTE student.

Privately controlled 4-year institutions had about 93 square feet of residential area per FTE student, as compared with only about 56 square feet in publicly controlled 4-year institutions.

## FOREWORD

The first of the modern series of statistical manuals in higher education, the Higher Education Facilities Classification and Inventory Procedures Manual, was published in 1968. A summary survey form, using the definitions and categories prescribed in that manual, was used for the facilities portion of the Higher Education General Information Survey in fall 1968 (HEGIS III). In fall 1969, the facilities survey in HEGIS IV used two report forms exactly as prescribed in the manual, thus permitting the institution which had installed the recommended inventory system to transcribe data already on record. Data acquired in the 1969 survey are presented in this report. Future reports are planned to provide consistent data from every institution of higher education, acquired and edited for NCES by the Higher Education Facilities Commission of each State.

The development of this publication drew on the talents of a number of persons. The original tabular formats were designed by Harold Dahnke, of Michigan State University, who was then a consultant to the Office of Education; the general managership of the total survey project was in the hands of E. Eugene Higgins of the Higher Education Surveys Branch, NCES; and the review of the tabular analyses of the data was performed by Richard Holden and Thomas McAnallen of the Bureau of Higher Education.

We are most appreciative of the manner in which the higher education community--the institutions of higher education, the several State governments, and the Federal agencies--has supported these efforts to bring increased consistency and understanding to inventories of physical facilities data.

## INTRODUCTION

As part of the fourth annual Higher Education General Information Survey, institutions of higher education were asked to provide detailed information on space in campus buildings as of September 30, 1969. The items and definitions in the survey questionnaire were based on the Higher Education Facilities Classification and Inventory Procedures Manual.<sup>1/</sup> A reproduction of the questionnaire is included as appendix A of this report.

The 1969 survey of facilities was the first to make full use, without modification, of the tables in the manual which classify space by type of room and organizational unit (report forms 1 and 2 of the manual). However, a number of comparisons with the previous year's survey are possible, since the common data items in these two forms were defined identically both years.

Survey responses were received for 2,260 of the 2,551 institutions in the 1969-70 higher education survey universe.<sup>2/</sup> The responding institutions, which accounted for 88 percent (2,815) of the campuses in the survey universe<sup>3/</sup>, enrolled almost 93 percent of the students in higher education. All tabulations in this report include estimates for non-respondent institutions so that the totals are estimates for the entire universe. Appendix B describes the imputation procedures on which estimates were based. Despite the amount of imputation, the data on space are carried out to the square foot and percentages are carried out to one decimal place for the convenience of the user.

In using the data of this report, several basic space terms, and their interrelationships, should be kept in mind. These terms are:

Gross area: The sum of the floor areas included within the outside faces of exterior walls for all stories or areas which have floor surfaces.

Assignable area: The sum of all areas on all floors of a building assigned to or available for assignment to an occupant, including every type of space functionally usable by an occupant, except for custodial, circulation, mechanical, and construction areas.

Assigned area: Assignable area in use.

Unassigned area: Assignable area not in use.

Nonassignable area: Gross area, minus assignable; nonassignable area includes construction, circulation, custodial, and mechanical space.

## ORGANIZATION OF THE TABLES

The basic findings of this survey are presented in 24 tables, which fall into four main groupings.

Tables 1-3 report information on gross and assignable area. Table 1 classifies the data by institutional control (public or private) and level (universities, other 4-year, and 2-year); table 2, by control and enrollment size; and table 3, by region and State.

Tables 4-17 report assignable area per FTE student<sup>4/</sup> by facilities classification (type of room or combinations of interrelated types of room) in selected percentiles as well as mean values. Tables 4-10 classify data grouped by institutional control and level; tables 11-17, by enrollment size. Appendix C describes the method used for computing percentiles.

Table 18 reports assignable area by facilities classification (residential, classroom, laboratory, and so forth) by region and State.

Tables 19-24 report assignable area per FTE student by facilities classification and organizational unit for institutions grouped by level, control, and size.

Following the 24 basic tables are six brief summary tables, A through F, which provide selected comparisons of 1969 and 1968 data. In interpreting data from the 1968 report, it should be noted that only tables 1A, 2A, and 3A of that report provided estimates for the entire higher education universe; tables 1B, 2B, 3B, and 4 through 13 were based on responding institutions only. Footnotes to the summary tables indicate the tables of the 1968 report from which the data were taken.

Response rates for the 1968 survey are summarized in appendix E, with institutions classified by control and level. As appendix E shows, only about 82 percent of the institutions provided data for the survey. However, the responding institutions accounted for approximately 90 percent of all student enrollments in institutions of higher education.

The final summary table, F, is limited to fall 1969 data. This table provides selected comparisons of public and private universities, other 4-year institutions, and 2-year institutions with respect to assignable area per FTE student.

## INSTRUCTIONS AND DEFINITIONS

### GENERAL

1. The increasing demands for education, and the rapid growth of institutions of higher education, emphasize the needs for long-range planning at all levels of responsibility. Current decisions affect an institution far into the future, and it is believed that most colleges are now utilizing long-term projections as a management tool or guide in planning. An inventory of physical facilities is an inter-related part of an institution's long-range plans. These data, by institution, will be of use to the Office of Education in evaluating applications for grants and loans. They will also be used as an aid in overall projections regularly prepared by the Office of Education.

2. The inventory requests data for the entire institution by main campus, branches, extension centers, etc. The items and definitions used in this report on physical facilities are consistent with the Higher Education Facilities Classification and Inventory Procedures Manual (OE-51016). It is requested that OE Form 2300-7,

3/69, be completed and returned to the U.S. Office of Education, National Center for Educational Statistics, 400 Maryland Avenue, SW., Washington, D.C. 20202, by November 30, 1969.

3. Last year's OE Form 2300-7, 1/68, collected assignable square feet by type of room (*general classification*), organizational unit, and subject field. This form (*Part A*) collects assignable square feet by organizational unit and type of room (*principally by general classification*). Part B collects assignable square feet by type of room (*principally by general classification*).

4. Please read the instructions and definitions. If you need clarification on any item, please write Dr. E. Eugene Higgins, U.S. Office of Education, National Center for Educational Statistics, 400 Maryland Avenue, SW., Washington, D.C. 20202. Dr. Higgins may be reached by telephone on Area Code 202, 962-7301.

### SPECIFIC

1. A separate report should be prepared for the main campus, and each branch campus, extension center, etc., in operation as of September 30, 1969.

2. Identifying information should be placed in the spaces provided at the top of the form, always including the name of the parent institution.

3. Rented and/or shared facilities.--Include in detail form the rented and/or shared space in PART A and PART B, then indicate, as provided for at the end of PART A, the total number of rented and/or shared net assignable square feet of space that have been included in PART A and PART B.

4. Entries of space information should be in square feet.

5. The nonassignable area added to total existing facilities area should equal the gross area. (*See Supplemental and Summary Information.*)

6. Please note that identical items in COLUMN (1) OF PART B, AND IN PART A (*e.g., 110 Classroom*) must have identical data entries.

### DEFINITIONS

1. Refer to Higher Education Facilities Classification and Inventory Procedures Manual (OE-51016) for space definitions applicable to this survey. Two additional definitions follow.

2. **MAIN CAMPUS**--The land area and facilities used by an institution of higher education in its program of instruction, research, or service.

3. **BRANCH CAMPUS**--A campus of an institution of higher education which is organized on a relatively permanent basis

(*i.e., has a relatively permanent administration*), which offers an organized program or programs of work of at least 2 years, and which is located in a community different from that in which its parent institution is located. To be considered in a community different from that of the parent institution, a branch shall be located beyond a reasonable commuting distance from the main campus.

## APPENDIX B

### General Methodology

The survey questionnaire, "Inventory of College and University Physical Facilities" (OE-2300-7, 3/69), was distributed as a part of the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS IV) package for 1969. The distribution included 2,551 institutions, as listed in "Education Directory: Higher Education, 1969-70,"<sup>1/</sup> representing 2,815 (appendix D) "institutional components" (main campuses, branch campuses, specialized campuses, and extension centers), as well as nonowned space made available for use by a "component." The resulting universe may not coincide with State records such as those compiled by agencies or commissions which administer facilities acquisition programs. Indeed, the resulting universe will not necessarily match that of other HEGIS surveys. For example, an institution with branches may submit a consolidated report for one survey and separate reports for the main campus and its branches for another survey.

The computations and tabulations presented in this report include data for all colleges and universities in the higher education universe. Completed questionnaires were received from 2,467 campuses (appendix D). The distribution of these campuses by institutional control and level is reported in appendix E.

(For reference, appendix E also includes a table showing response rates, by institutional control and level, for the previous year's survey (HEGIS III, 1968). However, it should be noted that the 1968 table of response rates is based on institutions, whereas the 1969 table is based on separate campuses.)

Two methods were used to adjust for nonresponse in the 1969 survey. First, if the institution had reported data for the preceding year, those data were used and entered as the institution's report for 1969.

If no other data were available for an institution, peer institution data for 1969 were used. Peer institutions were randomly selected within six major groups, as defined by control (private and public) and level of instruction (university, other 4-year, 2-year), which were further stratified by enrollment, highest offering, type of program, and accreditation. In the case of universities, the schools or colleges associated with the institution were also used in the stratification.

## APPENDIX C

### Methodology for Computing Percentiles

Percentiles are reported in basic tables 4 through 17 to permit an institution to compare its own assignable area (expressed in terms of square feet per full-time-equivalent student) in various facilities' classifications with areas reported by other institutions. In these tables, institutions are grouped by control, level, and size, so that comparisons can be made with relatively homogeneous sets of institutions. The general specifications for the preparation of these tables were as follows:

"For the institution, in a given tabular cell, compute the net assignable square feet (NASF) per full-time-equivalent (FTE) student for each response. Computation of the percentiles of these ratios will be done on a ranking process of the individual ratios within each tabular cell. For example, if there are 50 institutions in the data cell on line 3, column (2), then the NASF-FTE student ratio for the institution with the fifth lowest such ratio is the 10th percentile value to be printed in that table cell."
