#### ABSTRACT


This publication presents a book classification system which is adapted from the Library of Congress classification and is designed especially for children's books. The classification system was developed to prepare children to use adult materials (employing Library of Congress classification) by means of a gradual transition, provide a system easier for children to understand than the Dewey Decimal classification, and more closely reflect the subject matter of children's books. The classification system could be easily expanded as required, and its use would cause a mandatory re-evaluation of children's subject materials. The system retains a close relationship to the original Library of Congress classification system and employs one or two letter subclasses with numbers as required. The classification system is supplemented by a comprehensive list of index headings arranged alphabetically. Index headings are also arranged by classification so as to illustrate subject groupings of each subclass. There is also a section on suggestions and recommendations for spine labels and special collections. (A similar classification for children's sound recordings is LI 004 322.) (Author/SJ)

#### PREFACE TO SECOND EDITION

This new edition reflects changes made in the <u>Library of Congress</u> <u>Classification Adapted for Children's Books</u> after the Inglewood Library's present children's collection was reclassified and new titles added.

Changes in classification from the preliminary edition include

- (1) omitting three subclasses, (2) adding three new subclasses,
- (3) providing 41 new subclasses by expanding existing classes.

The original introduction and the section on the number of subclasses have been revised. The index has been expanded and numerous changes made in the index headings arranged by classification. There are also some changes and modifications in the section concerning suggestions and recommendations for spine labels and special collections. Detailed notes concerning changes and modifications to the LC classification and examples of titles illustrating classes and subclasses are omitted in this edition.



The change-over from the Dewey Decimal classification to the Library of Congress (LC) classification system has proved so successful for adult subject materials in Inglewood — in branch libraries as well as the main library — that it seemed only logical to devise a similar system for children's materials.

In developing our adaptation of LC for children's books, we thought in these terms: (1) a classification system adapted from the standard LC would prepare children to use adult materials by means of a gradual transition; (2) we could plan a system that would more closely reflect the subject matter of children's books; (3) the LC adaptation would be easier for children to understand and use than the expanded Dewey Decimal classification; (4) the classification system could be easily expanded as required; and (5) a mandatory re-evaluation of children's subject materials would result. This last concept is especially challenging—we would be analyzing children's books in a different context and relationship. Subjects, in some cases, will be grouped with subjects other than those with which they were related in the Dewey Decimal classification.

We considered these requirements: (1) retaining as close a relationship as practicably possible to the original LC classification system; (2) developing a uniform system using a one or two letter classification and reducing numbers to a minimum; (3) using the first three letters of the author's last name (main entry) in place of an author number; and (4) devising a clear-cut classification and reducing the possibility of "choice" between various classes and subclasses.

The classification system is supplemented by a comprehensive alphabetical list of index headings. Index headings are also arranged by classification so as to illustrate subject groupings of each subclass. There is also a section on suggestions and recommendations for spine labels and special collections.

The new classification will be reviewed periodically as (1) new books indicating new subject areas or relationships are added, (2) comments and recommendations are received by those using children's books classified in the LC adaptation, and (3) comments are received from those interested in this aspect of librarianship who review this publication. Comments and recommendations are earnestly solicited.



#### CHANGES AND MODIFICATIONS TO THE LIBRARY OF CONGRESS CLASSIFICATION

All the major LC subclasses have been used if at all practicable; that is, if sufficient children's subject materials are available — or the possibility exists that new materials will be published — to justify the retention of a subclass. Examples of some LC subclasses not applicable to children's books are CD (Archives) and RX (Homeopathy).

Some subclasses were incorporated with other subclasses because they were not generally applicable — BJ (Ethics) was placed with B (Philosophy). Some important subclasses were better placed with other subclasses — BH (Esthetics) was placed with N (Fine arts — general). In some cases, several subclasses were assembled under one subclass — JF (Politics and government — general (except United States) was devised to include former subdivisions such as JN (Europe) and JQ (Asia).

New letter subclasses were developed for three original LC classifications which had numbers instead of two-letter subdivisions: E (America — general), F (Latin America — general), and Z (Books and libraries).

Use of a mixed letter-number notation was necessary when additional detail was required. Examples are EZ (Western United States - local history and topography), EZ5 (Pacific States), EZ56 (Alaska) and DS (Asia - general), DS6 (Far East), and DS62 (China).

Some revision was required in parts of the original LC classification which reflect nineteenth century political alignments such as Austria-Hungary. A new class X (Sports and recreation) was developed because of the large number of children's books in this area.

Every effort has been made to analyze subjects in terms of putting them in one place rather than having variations appearing in different subclasses. Pollution (air, water, noise, solid waste, etc.) is placed in the new subclass ST (Pollution). Another new subclass developed is HY (Addiction) which assembles a variety of subjects formerly scattered.



#### NUMBER OF CLASSES AND S'3CLASSES

A total of 359 subclasses have been developed (1). This includes 217 one-letter or two-letter subclasses (60 percent of the total), 56 one-number subclasses, and 86 two-number subclasses. (0f the 86 two-number subclasses, 68 are used for states and Canadian provinces (class E) and 18 for Asia and Africa (class D)).

All subclasses, of course, do not carry the same weight. That is, there are major differences in the "imber of children's books in each subclass. There are more children's books, for example, classified in QT (Mammals) than in RT (Nursing) or CS (Cenealogy). Most of the subclasses are taken from the original LC classification. To a great extent, this accounts for the variation in subject coverage. As previously noted, some of the original LC subclasses with little applicable material were not used, or in some instances were combined with other subclasses.

Indicated below are the 22 classes and the number of subclasses in each class.

The classification of children's books is shown on the spine labels on the backs of the books and also on the public catalog cards. The classification and the author letters make up the "call number." Author letters show the first three letters of the author's last name. This is necessary because there are usually several books with the same classification and we need to arrange these books in author order within the classification.

The "Dix" in the first example stands for Dixon and "Tin" stands for Tinker in the second example.

Books are arranged on the shelf alphabetically by classification letter or letter-number combination. For example, books in the Social Sciences would be arranged in the following order: H, HB, HE, HE2, HE3, HF, HM, etc.



This alphabetical list of index headings is designed as an aid to the classifier. It is intended to be used with the classification system as a "supplement." It can be used initially in determining a classification.

The headings in the index have been assembled to cover, as completely as considered necessary, the subject contents of children's books.

### GENERAL VS. SPECIFIC HEADINGS

General headings are included to cover broad subjects. In determining a classification from the index, it is important to be as specific as possible. A general heading may not be the one to consider if the content of the book is such that it should be classified under a subdivision of a general heading. A book on the general subject of harbors, for example, would be in TA (Civil engineering) but a book on San Francisco harbor would be in EZ55 (California). Another example would be that a book on insects in general would be classified QM (Invertebrates), whereas a book on insects as carriers of disease would be included in RC (Physical disorders), and a book on insect pests in agriculture would be included in S (Agriculture — general).

### DIVISIONS OF MAJOR SUBJECTS

In compiling the index it was necessary to assess the amount of detail required in various subject areas and make determinations. These include the following:

- 1) Major geographical areas, countries, and states are listed but cities and natural features omitted. However, some important natural features, such as rivers that cover a broad geographical area, are included.
- 2) Individual names of many animals are included because of the volume of children's materials. Their inclusion also appears necessary as some animals may be in different subclasses. Domestic animals, such as cattle, for example, are in SF (Animal culture), but can be included in QT (Mammals) if the book to be classified deals with cattle on an anatomical or other zoological basis.
- 3) Examples of invertebrates and reptiles are shown but fish and birds are not individually listed.
- 4) Flowers, trees, and plants in general are not individually listed.
- 5) Individual musical instruments are not listed.
- 6) Historical events or battles are not listed unless subclasses are assigned.



#### MIS' I LLANEOUS

Additional miscellaneous information not readily discernible from either the classification system or the index is noted below:

United States government departments are classified by function (e.g., Department of Transportation in HE (<u>Transportation and communication</u>), State Department in JX (<u>International organizations and law</u>)), etc.

Religious leaders are placed in CV (Individual biography).

Individual harbors, ports, dams, canals, etc., are placed in their geographical area. Thus the Panama Canal would be in FK (Central America) but a general book on canals would be in TA (Civil engineering).

Individual territories of the United States are placed in their geographic area. Guam would be in DU (South Pacific — general), Puerto Rico in FL (West Indies), but a book covering a number of United States territories located in various geographical areas would be in EZ6 (Territories and possessions).

Museums are classified by type, such as art museums in N (Fine arts and handicrafts), science and technology museums in Q (Science), and vintage car museums in TL (Motor vehicles). Museums in general would be placed in H (Social sciences — general).

Wars between nations are placed in their historical period (e.g., The Franco-Prussian War in D4 (Modern histor: (1500-1900)). Wars involving the United States, however, are placed in their historical period in the class (e.g., The Spanish-American War in  $\mathbb{N}Q$  (United States (1865-1900)).

Career books are assembled under LB (<u>Vocational guidance</u>) rather than by their respective vocations.

#### SPINE LABELS AND SPECIAL COLLECTIONS

In this section suggestions and recommendations are made for spine labels and special collections. This information has been included in order to present a more complete picture of a children's book collection and will be of interest to technical processes personnel and those children's librarians working directly with the public.

### AUTHOR LETTERS

As indicated in the introduction, it is recommended that the first three letters of the author's name (or main entry) be placed under the classification. A spine label with bulletin type is recommended.

With biographies or autobiographies, the three letters should indicate the last name of the biographee.

It is recommended that the author's last name and first name initial be indicated on the spine label.

Labels from library suppliers showing symbols for mysteries, science fiction, romance, sea stories, dog stories, horse stories, sports, etc. can also be considered.















#### PICTURE BOOKS

Picture books, another category of easy books, but without a controlled vocabulary, could be considered in a separate collection. An author arrangement is suggested. A label denoting "picture book" can be used. Author's last initial only is sufficient.

## FOREIGN LANGUAGE BOOKS

The subclass PZ has been assigned for books in foreign languages. A suggested method would be to subdivide by language using the first two letters of the language (Fr, French; Ge, German; etc.)

It is recommended that a special label be used on children's books. Recommended is a white label (as with adult) with a red stripe at the top. This is especially important if the adult subject collection is classified by the Library of Congress system.

A suggested practice is to place the tops of labels two inches from the base of the book spine.


## FILING ORDER

Books are arranged in this order: (1) one letter, (2) one letter and onenumber, (3) two letters, (4) two letters and one number, and (5) two letters and two numbers (D, D2, DS, DS2, DS22, etc.). This is the order in which they appear in the section "Index headings arranged by classification."



### EASY BOOKS

It is recommended that an easy book collection be used. This could be pre-school through the third grade and include books that the child can read and also have read to him. For books with controlled vocabulary, these could be divided into three groups — Easy 1, Easy 2, and Easy 3 — representing grades one to toree. The spine label include the first letter of the author's last name.



For subject books, "Easy" only is recommended with the spine tabels showing classification and the first three letters of the author's name.
