## ABSTRACT

The six major sections which comprise this report are designed to provide members of the State School Library Media Supervisors Association with material pertinent to national information services. The first section offers an overview of the Educational Resources Information Center (ERIC), discussing its history, objectives, organization and products and giving a roster of the individual clearinghouses. A list of state dissemination liaison representatives is offered, followed by a directory of the 510 organizations which have standing orders to receive the monthly collections of microfiche which the ERIC Document Reproduction Service distributes. The fourth section contains a bibliography of Putting Research into Educational Practice (PREP) reports, while the fifth names information centers established in various states to assist local agencies in locating educational information. The final portion of the report identifies the Research and Development Centers and Educational Laboratories funded by the National Institute of Education to develop and implement educational innovations. INFORMATION SERVICES

The attached packet of material is designed to provide members of the State School Library/Media Supervisors Association with background information pertinent to National information services. Much of it is specifically related to the National Institute of Education (NIE). (Director, Tom Glennan)

With the passage by Congress and the signature by the President of the 1972 Education Amendments Bill, the National Center for Educational Communication and its dissemination functions are transferred to the new National Institute of Education (NIE). NIE and the Office of Education comprise the Division of Education headed by an Assistant Secretary for Education, in the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare. As the major Federal agency for educational research and development, NIE is responsible for the R & D activities previously administered by OE and will work to bring about coordination of educational research among the Federal agencies. NIE will conduct in-house and contracted research, both basic and applied, and will disseminate the results of that research to educational systems at all levels throughout the nation. Its basic aims are . . . . . \*to bring about those scientific inquiries into the learning process which will best promote equal educational opportunity for all Americans ... \*to identify reforms which will alleviate the problems of American education ... \*to advance the practice of education, as an art, a science and a profession ... \*to build an effective educational research and development.

(ERIC User Notes, August 1972)

The NIE Dissemination Task Force administers the Educational Resources Information Center (ERIC) and distributes the PREP Reports (Putting Research into Educational Practice). Before the transfer from OE the dissemination objectives were:

1. Development of a national communication system to support State and local linkage centers, college and university libraries, and commercial marketing services.
2. Provide interpretative summaries that distill and synthesize information about exemplary practices on priority issues. Disseminate and facilitate use of the resulting condensed knowledge through a variety of distribution means.

NIE also currently administers the "Research and Development Centers" the "Educational Laboratories", and other related programs. Earlier statements of purpose have been assumed still to apply:

1. The basic objective of the . . . Research and Development Centers is to create improved educational programs and practices through systematic long-term programs of research and development . . . .
2. Educational Laboratories are primarily engaged in educational development; that is, the precise formulation, field testing, and refinement of curriculum materials, teaching procedures, and organizational arrangements for adoption by local school systems. . . .
3. The National Program for Early Childhood Education was established to contribute to the improvement of early childhood education practice by carrying out those activities which will result in new knowledge about young children and by developing materials and practices which can be used by those individuals and agencies with responsibility for the education of young children . . . .
4. (NIE) also administers a planning and management systems development program carried on by the National Center for Higher Education Management Systems.

## EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES INFORMATION CENTERS

### I. History

Since June 1964, the U. S. Office of Education has maintained the Educational Resources Information Center (ERIC), a national information system which disseminates educational research results, research-related materials, and other research information. Through a network of specialized centers, or clearinghouses, each of which is responsible for a particular educational area, information is acquired, evaluated, abstracted, indexed, and listed in Research in Education (RIE). This reference publication provides access to report literature in the field of education. RIE has been unable to incorporate a proper awareness of the vast amount of literature published in periodicals and journals. This inadequate coverage has indicated the need for a second publication devoted exclusively to the periodical literature, drawing upon the subject expertise of the ERIC clearinghouses and vocabulary of descriptor headings developed for the indexing of educational literature. Current Index to Journals in Education was thus created in 1969 to serve the information needs of the practicing educator, reference librarian, and educational researcher.

### II. Three Major ERIC Objectives

- A. First Objective: to guarantee accessibility to current significant educational reports from all U.S. sources. (There are some foreign language sources but they are not reported regularly.)
- B. Second Objective: to generate interpretive summaries and annotated bibliographies on critical educational issues and to disseminate these widely.
- C. Third Objective: to help infuse new information into educational planning systems.

### III. Organization of ERIC: a hybrid system, i.e., it is both centralized and decentralized.

#### A. Five Components

1. Headquarters staff in the National Institute of Education, Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Washington D.C. It is responsible for 1) policy 2) system design 3) management 4) coordination and 5) evaluation.
2. Clearinghouses. (decentralized, subject-focused) Staffed by subject specialists. Acquire documents to augment reports acquired by the central staff from government agencies and large producers.

3. Leasco Corporation. A business firm that converts inputs from clearinghouses to magnetic tapes which are sent to the Government Printing Offices for printing and sale to Research in Education, ERIC's monthly report announcement journal.
4. Eric Document Reproduction Service (EDRS). Sells full texts of documents cited in RIE.
5. CCM Information Corporation. Publishes Current Index to Journals in Education (CIJE).

#### IV. Products of ERIC

- A. RIE: announcement journal for reports abstracted; Subject-Author-Title indexes; 1,000 reports per month; annual and semi-annual cumulative indexes. Current subscriptions from Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402. Back issues available from CCM Information Corporation, 866 3rd Avenue, New York, New York 10022.
- B. CIJE: announcement journal to periodical citations; covers 530 English language journals; annotated; Subject-Author indexes. CCM Information Corporation (see address above).
- C. Thesaurus of ERIC Descriptors: "Source of all Subject headings used for indexing and for retrieval of documents and journal articles in the ERIC collection." CCM Information Corporation (see address above).
- D. ERICTERMS: "matches the controlled indexing vocabulary of the ERIC Thesaurus to the ERIC accession numbers that have been indexed by each term." (gives count of entries under each subject heading) Leasco Systems and Research Corporation, 4833 Rugby Avenue, Suite 303, Bethesda, Maryland 20014.
- E. ERIC Document Reproductions: (microfiche or hard-cover) ERIC Document Reproduction Service, Post Office Drawer 0, Bethesda, Maryland 20014.
- F. ERIC TAPES: ERIC Master Data Base in machine readable form on magnetic tape. Leasco Systems and Research Corporation (see address above.)

#### V. Explanation for Clearinghouse chart

The information found on the following chart was, for the most part, taken from the newsletters printed by the individual clearinghouse. Some clearinghouses were very explicit, giving precise criteria for the inclusion of articles in RIE. Others said nothing. Each clearinghouse did, however, state in at least a sentence or two its scope and purpose. Also, dates for address changes, personnel changes, and even founding dates for particular clearinghouses were not always to be found. The following chart should, however, give at least a general idea of the activities of each ERIC clearinghouse.

## VI. Current Index to Journals in Education - Coverage

CIJE currently covers 530 publications. The majority of these publications represent the core periodical literature in the field of education. The other publications indexed in CIJE represent coverage devoted to peripheral literature relating to the field of education. This unique feature assures access to important articles published in those periodicals which fall outside the scope of education-oriented literature.

All articles listed in CIJE are indexed by one of the 18 ERIC Clearinghouses or the ERIC Facility. Citations to journals in a particular issue of CIJE represent the titles received by the various processing centers during the month previous to publication. The Thesaurus of ERIC Descriptors is used for assigning descriptive terms listed in the Subject Index.
