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ABSTRACT

In 1971, the History, Government, and Geography Service of the Division of Secondary Education, Virginia State Department of Education, conducted a survey of social studies programs, kindergarten through grade twelve, in the fifty states. The responses from forty-one of the fifty states are presented in alphabetical order. For each grade level in each state social studies program, a title or description of course offering, the number of semesters, and requiring agency are listed. A general comment on each state program is accompanied by a note on course requirements in state history. (Author/KSM)

Comments

Arkansas does not have a state requiring agency as such, but the state free text-book program usually is the determining factor for grades 1 - 8 because the text-book program covers those grades. The state committee selects a multiple list of six textbooks and the local school may select from the list for a period of six years. Local schools select textbooks and course offerings for grades 9 - 12. The State Board of Education requires that three units of social studies be offered in order to be accredited.

Arkansas requires that a course in Arkansas History be offered in secondary schools, grades 7 - 12, but students are not required to take the course.

Comments

Two units of high school credit in the above studies are required for graduation. One of these credits must be earned in United States History in the 11th grade and required by the State Board of Education. The other unit may be selected from any of the course offerings. While not a state requirement, a course in Advanced Government should be available for all students in the 12th grade.

. COURSE REQUIREMENTS IN STATE HISTORY

Kentucky History and Geography are companion courses in the 7th grade. In most Kentucky schools, these two courses constitute the entire 7th grade social studies curriculum. In addition, the state television network has a semester course which supplements and enriches the classroom activities. The program is in color and takes students across the state for exploration of a variety of topics.

MICHIGAN

MONTANA

Montana School Law requires that courses in conservation education, geography, government (civics), American History, and Montana History be taught. The current Standards for Accreditation of Montana Elementary Schools does not specify course titles for social studies. The current Standards for Accreditation of Montana High Schools requires that courses in American History (1 unit) and American Government (1/2 unit) be taught. Also, the Standards for Accreditation of Montana High Schools indicate that ". . . a two unit course in American History and American Democracy which includes a study of government may be used to meet the American History and Government requirements."

COURSE REQUIREMENTS IN STATE HISTORY

A course in Montana History is required but not at any specific grade level; however, the course is usually taught in the 7th or 8th grade. In some Montana high schools a course in Montana History is offered as an elective.

NEBRASKA SCHOOL LAWS, 1969 - 1970

79-213. An informed, loyal, and patriotic citizenry is necessary to a strong, stable, and prosperous America. Such a citizenry necessitates that every member thereof be fully acquainted with the nation's history, that he be in full accord with our form of government, and fully aware of the liberties, opportunities, and advantages of which we are possessed and the sacrifices and struggles of those through whose efforts these benefits were gained. Since youth is the time most susceptible to the acceptance of principles and doctrines that will influence men throughout their lives, it is one of the first duties of our educational system to so conduct its activities, choose its textbooks, and arrange its curriculum in such a way that the love of liberty, democracy, and America will be instilled in the heart and mind of the youth of the state.

(1) Every school board shall at the beginning of each school year, appoint from its members a committee of three, to be known as the committee on Americanism, whose duties shall be: (a) To carefully examine, inspect, and approve all textbooks used in the teaching of American history and civil government in the school. Such textbooks shall adequately stress the services of the men who achieved our national independence, establish our constitutional government, and preserve our union and shall be so written as to develop a pride and respect for our institutions and not be a mere recital of events and dates. (b) Assure themselves as to the character of all teachers employed, and their knowledge and acceptance of the American form of government. (c) Take all such other steps as will assure the carrying out of the provisions of this section. (d) Beginning with the school term in 1971, all American history courses approved for grade levels as provided in this section, shall include and adequately stress (i) contributions of all ethnic groups to the development and growth of America into a great nation, (ii) contribution to art, music, education, medicine, literature, science, politics, and government, and (iii) the war services in all wars of this nation.

The State of New Jersey offers no prescribed guidelines for a K through 12 social studies sequence. The direction of the social studies curriculum in New Jersey is in the hands of local districts. The State Social Studies Consultant, however, does approve of individual courses that are offered, but does not attempt to dictate a course sequence on the secondary level. State law also requires two years of American History in the secondary school and Civics during the early school years.

New Jersey State Law concerning the teaching of social studies in New Jersey school

18A:35-1. Course in history of the United States in high school. The superintendent of schools in each school district shall prepare and recommend to the board of education of the district, and the board of education shall adopt a suitable two-year course of study in the history of the United States to be given to each student during the last four years of high school.

18A:35-2. Nature and purpose of United States history course. Such course of study shall include instruction in

(1) The principles and ideals of the American form of representative government as expressed in the Declaration of Independence and the constitution of the United States and particularly in the Bill of Rights; and

(2) The history of the origin and growth of the social, economic and cultural development of the United States, of American family life and of the high standard of living and other privileges enjoyed by the citizens of the United States; and

(3) Such other events in the history of the United States as will tend to instill, into every girl and boy, a determination to preserve these principles and ideals as those of citizens of the United States and an appreciation of their solemn duty and obligation to exercise the privilege of the ballot, upon their reaching voting age, to the end that said principles and ideals may be so preserved.

18A:35-3. Course in civics, geography and history of New Jersey. Each board of education shall adopt a course of study in community civics, the geography, history and civics of New Jersey, and the privileges and responsibilities of citizenship as they relate to community and national welfare, which course shall be taken by all pupils in the public elementary schools in the grade or grades in which it is given, with the object of producing the highest type of patriotic citizenship.

Level 3 (Grades 5 and 6)

Introduction to United States history. Depth study of the Western Hemisphere (Canada and Latin America) with continuing emphasis on student understanding of varying ways of life.

Level 4 (Grades 7, 8, and 9)

Depth study of selected areas of the Eastern Hemisphere (Africa, Middle East, Asia, Australia, and Pacific Ocean).
Government Studies (Civics) - local, state, national, international.
Study of careers might be incorporated in schools having no other provision for career orientation.
Old world backgrounds to the American Revolutionary period.
