ABSTRACT

Based on initial questionnaires, plus followup contacts and interviews, this survey documents for the first time the holdings, rates of growth, and information resources available at 72 of Kentucky's scientific and technical libraries. Included are library book collections that emphasize the business, economic, biological, physical, medical, and engineering sciences. The study embraces a wide range of publicly and privately owned libraries, from million-volume university collections to industrial libraries holding only a few hundred specialized titles. Excluded from this study are small hospital libraries, college libraries without a separately administered science collection and public libraries (with the exception of the Louisville Free Public Library). Tables of summary data and a list of cooperative arrangements between these libraries are followed by individual profiles of each library, providing address, subject coverage and special collections, net holdings, loan policy, and hours of operation. There are three indexes to the profiles: institution name, librarian, and subject area.

## I. INTRODUCTION

Scientific and Technical Libraries in Kentucky is the result of a survey conducted under the joint aegis of the public and private task forces of the Kentucky Science and Technology Commission. This study documents for the first time the holdings, rates of growth, and information resources available at seventy-two of Kentucky's scientific and technical libraries. Included are library book collections that emphasize the business, economic, biological, physical, medical, and engineering sciences. The study embraces a wide range of publicly and privately owned libraries, from million-volume university collections to industrial libraries holding only a few hundred specialized titles. Excluded from this study are small hospital libraries, college libraries without a separately administered science collection, and public libraries (with the exception of the Louisville Free Public Library).

An initial sample list of eighty-five libraries was compiled from the American Library Directory, the Directory of Kentucky Libraries, and Technical Serials in Kentucky. Letters and questionnaires (see appendix) were mailed to each library. On the basis of the responses, the sample size was reduced to seventy-two libraries. Additional information was gathered through follow-up letters, telephone calls, and personal interviews.

The variety of libraries surveyed created a statistical problem. In general, accurate data was readily obtained from the smaller specialized libraries. Data from the larger libraries without a separately administered science and technology section was less accurate, since the science and technology materials were scattered throughout the general collection.

### III. COOPERATIVE ARRANGEMENTS AMONG SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL LIBRARIES IN KENTUCKY

- A. Kentuckiana Metroversity, Inc. is a consortium consisting of six institutions of higher learning in the Louisville Metropolitan area: Bellarmine College, Indiana University Southeast, Louisville Presbyterian Seminary, Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Spalding College, and the University of Louisville. Students enrolled in member institutions have the advantage of more comprehensive course offerings, enriched cultural programs, and borrowing privileges with all Metroversity libraries.
- B. The Greater Louisville Technical Referral Center is an organization which facilitates interlibrary loan cooperation among Louisville-area libraries. Libraries seeking material via interlibrary loan contact the Center, which in turn refers them to the Kentucky library which houses the material they seek. The Center is financed by state funds and the University of Louisville.
- C. The second edition of the Kentucky Union List of Serials will be available on microfiche in the fall of 1973. It will list the serial holdings of most Kentucky libraries, including the college and departmental libraries of the University of Kentucky. The holdings of the U.K. King (Main) Library will be excluded from this edition. The project is funded by the Kentucky Department of Libraries. - D. Technical Serials in Kentucky is a 1968 compilation of the serial holdings of thirty-five scientific and technical libraries in Kentucky. This listing will be merged with the Kentucky Union List of Serials (2 ed.) in late 1973.
- E. The Kentucky-Ohio-Michigan Regional Medical Library Program is part of a national interlibrary loan cooperative created and financed by the National Institutes of Health. The ten resource libraries within KOMRML pool their resources via interlibrary loan to provide medical information to all health professionals, hospitals, clinics, etc., within the three-state region. The medical libraries at the University of Louisville and the University of Kentucky are the Kentucky-based resource libraries. KOMRML publishes an eight-volume union list of serials.
- F. The Kentucky Department of Mental Health Central Office Library is the center of the Mental Health Library System. Members include staff libraries at nine Kentucky hospitals. Their holdings are centrally cataloged and members draw upon each other's resources whenever possible.
- G. The Center for Research Libraries is a non-profit organization operated and maintained by sixty-six member and associate-member institutions, including the University of Kentucky. The Center was created in 1949 for the purpose of increasing library materials available for research. Member institutions have access to the Center's nearly three-million volumes of research materials via interlibrary loan. The Center is located in Chicago, Illinois.


