

ABSTRACT

The listings are further categorized according to the title of the publication, the high school, and the city in which it is published.

HIGH SCHOOL PUBLICATIONS IN RHODE ISLAND

James Franklin founded the Rhode Island Gazette at Newport in 1732, but ventures of teenagers in journalism before 1861 remain unreported. Nor has there been much curiosity to learn about student publications.

A handwritten newspaper was published at Moses Brown School in Providence in 1861. The terms newspaper and magazine seem to have been used almost interchangeably for student publications before 1900.

"Unfortunately no collection of high school newspapers, magazines, year-books or the like exists in Rhode Island," Donald E. Leonard, executive secretary of Rhode Island Council of Teachers of English, wrote in 1966.

On another occasion he wrote, "In Providence and in most of the outlying areas in the state each high school publishes a yearbook. At least four high schools in Providence publish literary magazines--of limited circulation obviously."

"The Weekly Investigator was handwritten; masthead, two columns, two sheets folded to make eight pages," according to officials at Moses Brown School. "The contents dealt with school news and matters of general topical interest to the country."

In 1889 the Lyceum Phoenix, a debating society, took on the publication of a yearbook which they called The Phoenix Echo, an excellent publication. The first printed newspaper was the High School Budget published by Providence High School in 1877.
