ABSTRACT

Faculty of the approximately 175 college programs that are preparing Mental Health or Human Service Technicians or Associates at the A.A. level have been acquiring experience in using a wide range of teaching materials. This document is an attempt to share this knowledge and make a listing of those teaching resources that have been found most valuable. The listing is divided into five alphabetized categories: (1) books; (2) journals, newsletters, and journal articles; (3) films and filmstrips; (4) consultants and general resources; and (5) miscellaneous. Items are indexed categorically as well as alphabetically by subject. Annotations of materials listed include general comments as well as brief summaries. The listing should be particularly useful to college training program directors in planning a balanced program for their students.

The resulting compilation contains unedited comments of users and does not necessarily reflect the views of the task force, the Southern Regional Education Board, or the National Institute of Mental Health. A sheet has been prepared for users to offer their own comments.

INTRODUCTION

For the past six or seven years the Mental Health Program of the Southern Regional Education Board has been involved in working with the community colleges of the South that are preparing Mental Health or Human Service Technicians or Associates at the Associate of Arts level. An earlier project with support from the National Institute of Mental Health worked on issues of overall program development in these college programs, while the present project deals primarily with faculty development.

One need of both programs and faculty that has become apparent is for a bibliographic listing of teaching materials that have been found to be helpful for training mental health workers at this level. These programs are all very new; the first one began in 1966. Virtually all of the faculty of these programs are persons whose basic training is in one or another of the established mental health disciplines (psychology, social work, counseling, nursing, etc.). They are pioneers in this new field of Mental Health Technology with only their own experience to use in selecting teaching materials and teaching methods. They are seeking information about teaching materials that might be most helpful for this level of student.

Across the nation faculty persons of the 175 or so college programs have been acquiring experience in using a wide range of teaching materials. It is time to share these results and to make a listing of those teaching resources that have been found most helpful.

A small Task Force was convened under the leadership of Dr. Jeanette Redford of the University of Alabama at Birmingham (formerly program director of the Mental Health Technology Program at Jefferson State Junior College in Birmingham) to work on the development of such a listing. The Task Force met 3 times from the fall of 1973 to the winter of 1974 to set their guidelines and do their work.

Very early the Task Force decided that this listing would:

1. include books, journal articles, films, audio and video tapes, programmed instructional materials, and whatever else has been found useful.

2. be selective of those materials that were commonly used and recommended (it would not be exhaustive of all possible materials).
3. be indexed so that the user could readily find the kinds of materials he needed.
4. have annotations about the content of the items and uses, special limitations, etc.

The Task Force members prepared lists of books, articles, films, tapes, etc. that they had used and sent these lists to a larger group of college program directors. They asked the larger group of directors to rate those listings and add any others that they used and recommended. This new list was then sent to an even larger group of experienced college Mental Health Technology program directors and the process was repeated.

The Listings

The listing as it is prepared here has included all items that were recommended by 5 or more college program directors. In addition it includes several items that were recommended only 2 or 3 times but in which the quality of the added comments indicated that it was clearly a useful item. Many items, especially older books or articles or those that were highly specific to a single discipline at a very technical level were considered and excluded. A few of the more technical references are still in this listing, but they are generally recommended for instructor (I) use rather than for student (S) use.

A characteristic of most of the Mental Health Technology programs is that they are a blend of didactic and experiential learning with strong emphasis on student experience as a way of learning skills and values. For this reason the listing includes programmed materials, simulations, games, etc. which can be used for experiential learning. The listings show whether an item was judged to be primarily useful for didactic (D) or experiential (E) learning.

The basic listing is divided into the following five alphabetized categories with a number assigned to each listing:

1. books (by author)
2. journals, newsletters and journal articles (by author)
3. films and filmstrips (by title)
4. consultants and general resources (including ordering information)
5. miscellaneous

Each listing gives some information about the material and comments of respondents, often including recommendations for use. Library of Congress numbers are included when available

The Indexes

The items are indexed in two ways. One is a categorical index in which the subjects are grouped according to what seemed to the task force to be a logical framework. This list of categories has deliberately been kept short so that the user may easily scan the entire list. We have made no attempt to give an exhaustive listing of all possible categories.

In the alphabetical subject index, the subjects have been arranged in alphabetical order together with the numbers of each of the books, articles, films, etc. which the task force judged to be concerned with that subject.

In order to find sources concerning skills, for example one would go to the categorical index where 17 skills areas are listed. After deciding that interviewing skills was the major area of interest, one would turn to the alphabetized subject index and find the numbers of all sources dealing with interviewing skills.

Uses

We strongly urge each college training program director to review these listings for those items which may offer his students a balanced program. This seems especially desirable since most faculty persons have their own biases toward various styles of learning, content, etc. based on their own discipline, experience and personality.

We do not offer this listing as an "approved" or "recommended" listing, but only as an aid based on the pooled experiences and judgements of several existing programs. There are undoubtedly other excellent materials. Both positive and negative comments by respondents were included, and these comments do not necessarily reflect the views of the task force or SREB.

One problem that we are fully aware of is how to present the new teaching materials that are only now coming available. We plan to find some way to up-date this listing at periodic intervals although the specific way in which this will be done is not now apparent. However, we do need the reactions and suggestions of the users of this listing in regard to content, format

and any other items. A page is enclosed at the end for use in making these suggestions. Please let us hear from you.
