ABSTRACT

Available in both print and braille, this directory describes the activities of the Volunteer Services Section of the Library of Congress Division for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, the Braille Book Bank, and Recording for the Blind. Its major section lists the names of 269 volunteer groups and individuals who transcribe and record books and other reading materials for blind and physically handicapped persons. The listing is alphabetical by state. Among the services offered are braille transcribing, large-type printing, tape recording, duplication, and binding. Specialties include music, mathematics, and languages. Separate sections list state special-education consultants, proofreaders certified by the Library of Congress, and procedures for clearing copyright permissions and reporting to catalogs. Introduction

The world of books encompasses classics of international renown and ephemeral pamphlets circulated locally, esoteric treatises on obscure subjects and collections of jokes or cartoons, technical manuals and practical everyday how-to-do-it instructions. A handicapped person should be, but often is not, free to read independently and at his own convenience, with the same choice of materials that his friends and associates have at a bookstore or public library. Through the dedicated efforts of volunteers who produce reading materials that otherwise would not be available to the handicapped person, he may attain a high degree of variety in his reading. Whether the volunteer transcribes or records an economic textbook for a college student, a series of Supreme Court decisions for a lawyer, a bestselling novel or a book of poems for the general reader, or a cookbook or a gardening book, the volunteer's contribution is one of special merit.

This directory, available both in print and in braille, lists the names of volunteer groups and some individuals who transcribe and record books and other reading materials for blind and physically handicapped persons. It has been compiled by the Volunteer Services Section of the Division for the Blind and Physically Handicapped of the Library of Congress from information obtained through a questionnaire mailed to organizations and groups known to perform these services. The present edition reflects an updating of information contained in the 1970 edition, as well as the addition of new information received since that time.

The listing is alphabetical by state, and each entry is assigned an index number. The services and specialties listed in the index refer to these assigned numbers. Among the services offered are braille transcribing, large-type printing, tape recording, duplication, and binding. Specialties include music, mathematics, and languages. Separate sections list state special-education consultants and proofreaders certified by the Library of Congress.

If you are active in producing reading materials for the blind and physically handicapped and your group has not been listed in this publication, please let us know of the omission so that the pertinent information can be included in future editions. Organizations and individuals listed are asked to keep us informed of changes in address, services performed, or personnel to whom inquiries should be directed.

Volunteer Services Section

The Volunteer Services Section recruits and trains volunteers to produce and process books in braille and on tape and coordinates their activities on a national basis. The section also sets and maintains standards of excellence in the work of such volunteers.

Volunteer braillists may be trained either through a correspondence course conducted by instructors in the section or by personal study with a qualified instructor in a local group. In either case, a manuscript must be submitted to the section's instructors for evaluation before the braillist can be certified as competent. Training and certification are also available in braille music notation.

Visually handicapped persons are trained as proofreaders of both literary and music braille.

Volunteers wishing to do tape recordings must pass an audition in which they are evaluated on the basis of quality of voice and presentation as well as clarity and accuracy of reading. They are also given instruction and advice on equipment, technical aspects, and formats for recording.

Although no instruction is offered in the production of large-type reading materials, guidance is frequently given in response to specific inquiries. The *NBA Manual for Large Type Transcribing*, a publication of the National Braille Association, Inc., is available on request from the Division for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, Library of Congress, Washington, D.C. 20542. It offers guidance in the use of equipment, typing procedures, formats, large note music, and other special requirements.

The corps of volunteers whose work is coordinated by the section is available to meet special and individual needs which cannot be met by production in volume through press braille, talking books, or commercially available large-print books. The section assigns books to individuals or groups and, on receipt of completed books, directs the proofreading, duplicating, binding, and other processing for the library collections. Volunteer groups and individuals also receive book assignments from local sources such as school systems and libraries.

The section develops and revises teaching manuals and guidelines for volunteers, keeps abreast of all code changes and passes them along to volunteers, and evaluates existing manuals for the teaching of all braille codes. The section

also determines the availability and performance of various systems of writing and recording equipment and experimental mechanical reading devices.

Braille proofreaders located throughout the country and tape reviewers located in the section contribute to the maintenance of standards of quality by correcting errors or having them corrected and by reporting to the volunteer brailleists and tapists on how their work might be improved. Special and recurring problem areas are discussed in articles appearing in the section's publication, *Volunteer News*.

Members of the staff are available for consultation and workshops at conferences of regional libraries, volunteer groups, and other professional organizations.

When advice or assistance is needed immediately or when a technical point must be discussed, volunteers are urged to use the WATS line of the division: 800/424-8567. Either give the operator the name of the person to whom you wish to speak or indicate the specific information required. Leave the number where you can be reached, and your call will be returned.

You are invited to visit the Division for the Blind and Physically Handicapped at 1291 Taylor Street NW., Washington, D.C., about five miles from the Library of Congress Main Building. On-site parking is available for visitors to the division; public transportation to and from the Taylor Street location is also convenient.

What This Directory Can Do for You

(1) You are a student who needs a tape-recorded book in French for a college course; you have inquired at your library for the blind and physically handicapped and the American Printing House for the Blind and have been informed that the title is not available:

Look under "French" in the listing of specialties; using the index numbers, locate a volunteer group that does tape recording and write to the chairman asking for assistance.

(2) You are chairman of a volunteer group which transcribes textbooks for students in your city. One textbook includes musical examples, and none of the members of your group knows braille music notation:

Look under "Music" in the listing of specialties; using the index numbers, locate a volunteer group near you that transcribes braille music and ask the assistance of that chairman.

(3) As chairman of a volunteer group concerned chiefly with braille transcribing, you wish to have your proofreading assignments done in the most expeditious manner:

Check the section "Proofreaders Certified by the Library of Congress," which is arranged by state. There you will be able to locate the proofreaders in your area and thus apportion your proofreading efficiently and avoid unnecessary shipping delays.

(4) You are elected president of the Lions Club and need a large-type copy of the constitution, annual report, and other basic documents of the organization, as well as the monthly reports of chairmen and officers:

In the listing of volunteers, look under your state and locate a group near you that does large-type transcription. Explain your situation to the group chairman and ask for assistance.

(5) You are a certified braille transcriber who has moved to a new city and would like to affiliate with a group:

In the alphabetic listing, look under your state and town to locate a group. If there is no group in your community and you want to continue brailleing, notify the Volunteer Services Section, which will either assign books to you for transcription or direct you to a cooperating library or another agency needing braille services.

(6) You are a government employee who needs to refer frequently to agency

manuals or regulations, or an insurance agent who sometimes needs to consult a rate book, and you need these materials in braille so that you can operate effectively and meet your obligations to your employer:

Check the alphabetic listing to locate a volunteer braille group in your state and city, and make your needs known to the chairman.

(7) You are a parent of a blind child, you and your family have just moved into a new state, and you need to know with whom to discuss the various services (some of which will be provided by volunteers) that your child will need when he enters the local school next year:

The "Special Education Consultants" section is arranged by state. There you will find the name and/or position title of the appropriate person and the address to which you should write to request an appointment.

(8) You are a librarian working for a regional, subregional, private, or public library. One of your readers needs a copy of *Macbeth* in large type. You have checked the book's availability through the American Printing House and through the Library of Congress interlibrary loan network and have discovered that the book has not been transcribed in large type (or is not immediately available):

In the alphabetic listing, look under "large type"; using the index numbers, locate a volunteer group, preferably one in your own area, that does large-type transcribing, and write to the chairman asking for assistance.

(9) You are a homemaker planning a special social function. You need a couple of gourmet recipes in braille:

Check the alphabetic listing to locate a braille group in your area. Your request for the recipes is a small one that can probably be met in a hurry.

These are just a few of the ways this directory may be used. Please let us know if there are any other features we could add to make it more valuable to you. Additions and corrections will be published in a later edition of the directory.

Braille Book Bank

The Braille Book Bank, 85 Godwin Avenue, Midland Park, N.J. 07432, is sponsored by the National Braille Association, Inc. The book bank was established as a nonprofit service organization to provide textbooks in braille to blind students above the high school level, at a cost as close as possible to that of the print book. Approximately 1,000 textbook titles are available in the fields of general literature, mathematics, the sciences, and foreign languages. New titles are added at the rate of about 100 per year; weeding of old titles occurs yearly.

The Braille Book Bank retains the volunteer-transcribed master copies, from which thermoform copies are made and sent out to fill the approximately 600 requests received in a typical year. A catalog, in either print or braille, of available titles may be obtained by sending \$1 to Braille Book Bank at the above address. Supplements to the catalog are provided periodically.

Recording for the Blind

Recording for the Blind, Inc. (RFB) is a national, nonprofit, volunteer-centered organization, entirely gift supported, which provides recorded educational books to anyone who cannot read normal printed material because of visual or physical handicaps. In addition to recording new books on request, RFB retains a master tape of every title it records and, through its Master Tape Library, can supply individual tape copies to any number of future borrowers.

RFB's recording and library services are offered free of charge to high school, college, and postgraduate students, as well as to adults who require educational material in the pursuit of their occupation. More than 4,000 carefully selected and supervised volunteers produce recorded texts at RFB's 26 recording centers scattered across the country. As of June 1, 1973, RFB's library contained 22,000 titles on open-real tape in all the principal languages. A new catalog of titles is issued every year in June; its price is \$2.

Let's Be Right About Copyright

Procedures for Clearing Copyright Permissions and Reporting to Catalogs

Publishers have been generous in granting free copyright clearances to transcribers of materials for blind and physically handicapped readers. In return for this exceptional courtesy on the part of publishers and authors who hold copyrights, transcribers are urged to acquaint themselves with proper procedures before undertaking a transcription. Group chairmen should keep abreast of the procedures to follow and of the latest copyright developments. Free sample copies of print books should not be requested from publishers, since they have already made their contribution to our readers through copyright permission. Books should be purchased by the reader, school system, agency, or library needing the transcription.

For purposes of copyright clearance and reporting, books fall into two categories: textbooks—those designed primarily for classroom use—and trade books—all other books, including fiction, nonfiction, and supplementary reading on reference materials.

Textbooks and the APH Central Catalog

The *Central Catalog of Volunteer-Produced Textbooks*, maintained in card-file form by the Instructional Materials Reference Center of the American Printing House for the Blind (IMRC/APH), is a vital source of information for all workers for the blind and physically handicapped who have a need for educational materials in braille, large-type, disc, and tape-recorded forms.

The catalog's purpose is threefold: (1) to coordinate the reporting efforts of the volunteers who produce textbooks for the blind and physically handicapped, (2) to provide reference services for those needing such materials, and (3) to provide permissions and record clearances from publishers through blanket agreements extended by them. These agreements were jointly negotiated with the publishers by the Library of Congress, Recording for the Blind, and the American Printing House for the Blind. Lists of publishers granting blanket permissions are available on request from the Instructional Materials

Reference Center, American Printing House for the Blind, 1839 Frankfort Avenue, Louisville, Ky. 40206.

If the publisher of the title which has been assigned *is* on the list, you need only report your intention to braille or record the title to the IMRC/APH. If the publisher of the textbook assigned *is not* on the list, you or your group chairman must write directly to the publisher for permission to make the transcription, provided it has been established that the book is not available elsewhere. When inquiring about a book, give the exact title, author, publisher, copyright date, school grade level, and medium desired.

All agreements with publishers have been made on the basis that permission records will be kept at the American Printing House or the Library of Congress *for every transcription made*. Therefore, it is imperative that no textbook be transcribed unless permission has been received. Textbooks not covered by blanket agreements must be cleared by the individual transcribing group through the appropriate publisher.

The Central Catalog's file of intention reports includes titles (textbooks and trade) which have been reported to the IMRC as being in process. When a completion notice (see sample opposite) is received, the intention report is removed and a completion card is made. Intention and completion forms are available in quantity from the American Printing House. If the title is a textbook, the completion card is filed under its subject heading in the Central Catalog. If the title is a trade book, the card is forwarded to the Library of Congress, Division for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, which maintains a listing of general books in its Union Catalog of *Volunteer-Produced Nontext-book Materials*. Completion cards on Catholic texts are sent to the Xavier Society for the Blind, 154 East 23d Street, New York, N.Y. 10010.

NOTE: If a transcription is made for an individual and is for *his use only* (not to be duplicated), the "fair use" principle applies and you may transcribe *one* copy of the book or any part of it without obtaining copyright clearance. Such transcriptions need not be reported.

If you are asked to do an anthology or books which include several acknowledgments for quoted material, you must write directly to each individual copyright holder concerned for clearance. Should *any one* of the copyright holders deny permission, you may not proceed with the transcription.

To summarize:

1. Never request free samples of print books from publishers.
2. Keep on hand up-to-date lists of blanket permissions available from APH.
3. File intention report with APH and await reply.
 - a. If the book *is* on the list of blanket permissions and *is not* available elsewhere, begin the transcription.
 - b. If the book *is not* on the list of blanket permissions and *is not* available elsewhere, then write directly to the publisher for copyright permission.
 - c. Be sure you have cleared *all* copyrights for anthologies and similar books.
4. File completion report with APH when transcription is finished.

Trade Books and the L.C. Union Catalog

All books assigned by the Division for the Blind and Physically Handicapped of the Library of Congress to a volunteer for transcription, whether in braille, large type, or tape, have been cleared through their respective copyright holders. Transcription of such books can begin immediately.

If nontextbook materials are requested by agencies, libraries, or groups other than the Library of Congress, volunteers should submit a Copyright Permission Request, form LC 73-128 (sample below), quantities of which can be obtained from the Selection Section, Division for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, Library of Congress, Washington, D.C. 20542. The request should be sent to the division via the regional library serving the area in which you reside.

Instructions for Completing and Submitting Form 73-128 (9/73)

Author—Include full names of all authors, editors, and others as listed on title page.

Title—List full title as it appears on title page.

Publisher—When publisher is a local agency or a small publishing house, fill in complete address. For reprint paperbound titles, please check the reverse of the title page for the original hardbound publisher, if available.

Edition—List date or number of edition.

Copyright Holder—Record name of copyright holder as listed on the back of the title page. Please note that DBPH does not clear copyright for anthologies, since publishers are reluctant to handle permissions for all the copyright holders involved.

Medium—Check appropriate block (braille, cassette, etc.).

Publication Date—Add date book was published.

LC Card Number—Most trade publications include the Library of Congress card number on the back of the title page, usually at the bottom. This number is important in obtaining bibliographic information for the Library of Congress union catalog of nontextbook materials for the blind and physically handicapped. Please indicate when the card number is not available.

Copyright Date—List date or dates of copyright as they appear on the reverse of the title page.

Organization and Address—Indicate complete name and address of transcribing library, agency, or group.

Date of Request—List date of your agency's request for copyright permission.

Permission Granted or Denied—To be completed by DBPH.

This four-part, self-duplicating form (no carbon paper required) is used both for copyright requests and for union catalog information. Submit the white (request) and yellow (intention) copies of this form to the Selection Section, Division for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, Library of Congress, Washington, D.C. 20542. The buff (completion) and pink (withdrawal) copies

should be retained temporarily for your files. When a response is received from the publisher, DBPH will return the white copy of the form after filling in the date permission was granted or denied (item 12). Publisher's notes concerning production of the book will be included in the blank area in the lower right-hand corner.

As soon as the title produced is ready for circulation, please forward the buff copy, Union Catalog—Completion Notice, directly to: National Collections, Division for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, Library of Congress, Washington, D.C. 20542. If at any time the requesting agency decides not to produce the materials, please advise us by returning the pink copy, Union Catalog Withdrawal Notice, to the Selection Section. This notice should also be sent to DBPH if the book has been lost or discarded.

To summarize:

1. Never request free samples of print books from publishers.
2. If the book has been assigned by DBPH, begin transcription immediately, since copyright permission has already been obtained.
3. Keep on hand a sufficient quantity of Copyright Permission Request forms, available from Selection Section, DBPH.
4. If the book *has not* been assigned by DBPH, submit white (request) and yellow (intention) copies of the form to the Selection Section and await reply.
 - a. If copyright permission *is* granted, begin the transcription.
 - b. If copyright permission *is not* granted or the book is available elsewhere, you will be so informed by DBPH.
5. Forward buff (completion) copy of the form to National Collections, DBPH, when transcription is ready for circulation.
6. Forward pink (withdrawal) copy to Selection Section, if necessary.

To keep information in the central and union catalogs current and accurate: ALWAYS ADVISE IMRC/APH or DBPH/LC IMMEDIATELY of any status changes in transcriptions (loss, discard, cancellation, moves, etc.).

In conclusion, it is essential that you report *all* transcriptions of textbooks to APH and of trade books to DBPH. If it is not clear whether the book is textbook or trade book, use your own judgement in categorizing it. There is continuing interchange between the two agencies responsible for the catalogs, and between them they will clear up doubtful matters.
