INTRODUCTION

This bibliography was prepared for a series of courses entitled Ontario 2000 - Alternative Futures offered by the Department of Man-Environment Studies during 1971-72. It contains references to both forecasting techniques and to some of the issues likely to be important over the next few decades. Each reference has been put under a broad general category. The categories however, are not exclusive and should a reference not be able to be located under one category a search should be made under related categories. An asterisk (*) indicates the "descriptor field". After these descriptors are further refined, they will be of use when the bibliography is being "computerized". Descriptors were derived from the title of the book or article, the "tracings" on the subject card in the Library Subject Catalogue and in some cases the Table of Contents of the book. It was decided to include descriptors for two reasons: (1) They can be used to scan many references quickly. (2) To some extent they can help one to locate other

books on the same topic by searching under these subject headings in the Subject Catalogue.

A word of thanks to Margaret Huggins, Lois MacVichie and Linda Connolly for their not-quite-infinite (let's be realistic) patience. Finally, I will take complete responsibility for all errors!
