ABSTRACT

A guide to educational research and reference materials is presented for use at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, library. The materials covered include guides, overviews, dictionaries and encyclopedias, bibliographies, periodical indexes and abstracts, book reviews, unpublished research, tests and measurement tools, research reviews, dissertations and theses, statistics, directories, government publications, and biographical works. For each item complete bibliographic information is provided, along with the call number and a brief annotation. The Library of Congress classification scheme for education and an author-title index are appended. (LS)

## INTRODUCTION

This guide is intended to increase the ability of those engaged in educational research to locate specific information or sources of data.

### Purpose and scope:

- (1) To provide a framework for organizing basic educational research materials. Sources providing similar types of information are grouped together in one of thirteen categories appearing in the left column of each page, thus offering guidance in search methodology for the beginning researcher.
- (2) Many reference works in specialized areas of education, or in languages other than English, will not be found here. Only the most useful reference tools for educational research found in the UTK libraries have been included.
- (3) Location of materials in UTK libraries is indicated by Library of Congress call number and the following designations:

Main.....Main Library  
UGL.....Undergraduate Library  
Reference.....Reference Department

- (4) Annotations, appearing in the right column of each page, describe the character, scope, and usefulness of each title.

Hopefully this guide will serve to remove some roadblocks to educational research, but maximum utilization of the library's research power may necessitate additional assistance. Such guidance is available from the Reference Librarians in both the Main and Undergraduate libraries.
