
ABSTRACT

A Directory of services for the handicapped in Ohio college and university libraries is the result of a 1975 survey. Alphabetically arranged entries provide the name, address, and telephone number of each institution as well as the name of a person to contact for more information. Special services provided by each library are identified. These may include provisions for obtaining materials for the visually and physically handicapped as well as specialized reference services. Also listed are the institutions' items of special equipment--electric, large-print, and shield typewriters; opticons; braille writers; magnifiers; tape recorders. Information on accessibility is also provided. (LS)

To the users of this directory:

In May 1975, Mrs. Eunice Lovejoy, Library Development Consultant, sent a questionnaire to the 115 librarians of the post secondary educational institutions listed in the 1975 *Directory of Ohio Libraries*. They were asked to identify the special services and equipment they provide students who, because of a handicap, are unable to use conventional library materials, and to indicate what features of the library building make it accessible to the student on crutches or in a wheelchair. Forty libraries responded initially. Ms. Diana Cohen, Assistant to the State Librarian, sent a follow-up letter to each of the librarians who had not replied and followed that with a phone call. This directory is a compilation of the information which was collected. Because the situation is constantly changing as more and more students with handicaps enter what is being called the "main-stream," we would appreciate it if librarians would notify us of any changes in their services.

Services depend upon accessibility, and in this regard, the following statement in the 1976 publication of the Ohio Board of Regents, *Services for Physically Handicapped Students*, is worth consideration by librarians and others concerned with library service:

Access for physically handicapped persons means having the same entrance or approaches to institutions of learning as do other students. Lack of access becomes by definition a barrier. Barriers are obvious deterrents to success. The most obvious deterrents have been physical and attitudinal barriers. These physical barriers include narrow doorways, steps, buildings without elevators, drinking fountains that are too high, narrow telephone booths, inaccessible toilets and dorm facilities. Attitudinal barriers include misconceptions about the capabilities of handicapped persons, rigid medical and physical requirements, inflexible curricula and testing, and inadequate special support services.

Library resources and services are indisputably an important part of higher education, and this directory indicates that Ohio academic libraries are becoming more accessible; but that more needs to be done. The student who does not have access to this resource is doubly handicapped.

We hope that rehabilitation counselors, guidance counselors, and others who advise students as they make college choices, will find this directory a useful source of information. We are anxious to work with college and university librarians who feel that more needs to be done, and encourage them to contact Mrs. Eunice Lovejoy, Library Development Consultant, Services to the Handicapped, The State Library of Ohio, 65 South Front Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

How to use this directory

Information is arranged alphabetically by name of the college with two exceptions: (1) Where the name begins with "University of" or "College of," it is listed under the place; e.g., The University of Akron is listed as "Akron, The University of"; and (2) Branch campuses are listed under the name of the central university; e.g., Ashtabula Campus Library is listed under Kent State University. The format for each library is as follows:

Special Services represents the librarians' responses to the following questions: What provisions do you make for getting materials in braille or tape for the blind, visually handicapped or physically handicapped student who cannot use print? What special reference service do you provide to these students? (Because most librarians indicated that they provide reference service as needed, we have not included that response.)

Special Equipment represents librarians' responses to the following: What adapted equipment is available for their use: e.g., large print typewriter, electric typewriter, shield typewriter, opticon, braille writer, magnifier, tape recorders?

Accessibility indicates the features of the library which permit persons in wheelchairs or on crutches to use it. The following checklist was included in the questionnaire, and the directory information represents items which were checked "yes":

- Is there at least one building entrance at ground level?
- Are doors 32 inches wide and do they open easily (with less than 10 pounds pressure)?
- Are there level thresholds to building and rooms?
- Do you have a sloping ramp to building entrance (with grade less than 8%)?
- Is there safe and accessible parking close to the building (8 foot space with 2 feet between spaces)?
- Are there level walks with no curbs at crossways from parking area to library building?
- Does the student have access to an elevator?
- Are restrooms with wide stalls and grab bars provided for wheelchair users?
- Are there handrails on all stairways, extending 18 inches beyond the top and bottom step?
- Are there non-slip floors?
- Are there lower fountains and public telephone for wheelchair users. (height for accessibility 30-36 inches)?
