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ABSTRACT

Presented is a bibliography on mainstreaming of handicapped children with over 500 citations. Entries are listed in alphabetical order by author and usually include such information as title, source, publication date, and page numbers. Also provided is an index which lists authors included in the bibliography under the following topics: administration, art, attitudes/behavior/social acceptance/achievement, background/history/general, dated March 1976 and later, dated 1968 and earlier, efficacy of placement, elementary, emotionally disturbed/behavior problems, hearing impaired, labels/labeling, learning disability, literature, mentally retarded, parents, physical education, physically handicapped, placement/class management/individualized instruction, policy/laws/courts, preschool, project reports/models, resource rooms, secondary, social studies, speech handicapped, teacher associations/unions, trainable mentally retarded, training systems/models, visually impaired, and vocational.
