**ABSTRACT** 

A survey was conducted throughout Montgomery Community College to gather information regarding the time spent by various units on the completion of reports for external agencies. Data were obtained for the actual reports filed between July 1, 1975 and April 1, 1976, and for the last three months of the fiscal year an estimate based on previous experience was made. Using a cost per manhour of \$8.00 as an average for the time spent by deans, administrators, clerks, and typists, it was calculated that in fiscal 1975-76, the college would spend at least \$131,048 or 16,381 manhours filling out reports for external agencies. This amount is roughly equal to eight full-time employees working all year on external reporting. External agencies requiring reporting included state agencies and boards, various federal agencies, national professional associations, accrediting agencies, and other postsecondary institutions. In the four attachments to this document, the costs of external reporting are summarized and are broken down by department : or office, and the reports prepared for external agencies are itemized. For each report, the requesting agency, college office, manhours, and costs are listed. (JDS)

Cost of External Reports

In response to a request by the Board of Trustees, a study of the cost to the College of complying with requests for information from Governmental and other external agencies was conducted. Each office within the College known to be involved in reporting to external agencies was surveyed.

The attached compilation of the data produced by the survey and an analysis of the findings, both of which were prepared by the Dean of Institutional Research and Analysis, are forwarded for the information of the members of the Board.

Should the Board wish, this report will be placed on an agenda at a regular Board meeting for discussion.

### COST OF EXTERNAL REPORTS Fiscal Year 1975-1976

At the request of the Board of Trustees, a survey was conducted throughout the College to gather information regarding the time spent; by various units on the completion of reports for external agencies.

Data were obtained for the actual reports filed between July 1, 1975 and April 1, 1976, and for the last three months of the fiscal year an estimate based on past years' experience was made. While some of the offices also reported time spent in the administration of programs related to the various reports, this information is not included here. The cost of a manhour of time was set at \$8.00 as an average, which takes into account the time of deans and other administrators, as well as secretaries and typists. No attempt was made to compute the exact cost, using each participating individual's hourly rate.

In fiscal year 1975-76, the College will spend at least \$131,048, or 16,381 man-hours on filling out report forms for external agencies.

This is equal to about eight full-time employees working all year just on reports for these agencies.

Reports for the Maryland state agencies, such as the State Board for Community Colleges and the Maryland Council on Higher Education, require the most time. Many of the reports sent, to the state agency actually originate with the Federal Government. The time spent on these state reports is equal to about five persons working full-time for one year.

The reports which are sent directly to the Federal Government require the equivalent of one person working a full year. While the Montgomery County government requires enough reports to keep one person

busy for more than nine and a half months, the reports to non-governmental agencies and institutions require almost 14 months of work.

Many reports are monthly or quarterly, while annual reports tend to have August, September, October, and November deadlines; thus, the impact of external reporting falls during the busiest time of the year.

There is almost no office or department within the College which is not involved in some aspect of reporting to an external agency. The amount of reporting is related to the size of the campus, with Rockville devoting about five times as much manpower to external reports as does. Takoma Park. However, the Financial Aid program at Rockville accounts for the majority of the difference. The Rockville Campus spends the equivalent of one person working almost a year on reports, while the Takoma Park Campus offices devote the equivalent of about two and one—third months.

The major reporting effort falls on Central Administration, as much college-wide information is requested. Due to the various fire, safety, and building code regulations, the unit devoting the greatest amount of time to gathering and reporting data is the Operations and Maintenance Office. Data Systems expends the equivalent of one person working almost 7.4 months and the Office of Institutional Research and Analysis expends 7.2 man-months each year on external reports. Other central offices with major reporting responsibilities include Facilities, Personnel, and Finance.

In summary, this first attempt to document cost of external reports has revealed that about eight man-years are devoted to this effort.


