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ABSTRACT

The purpose of the study was to: (1) identify the agribusiness firms within Wisconsin's Vocational-Technical and Adult Education (VTAE) District One, (2) identify the occupations of those employed in the industry, (3) identify present and future employment need for identified skills along with training needs for those currently employed in agribusiness occupations, and (4) integrate the data for program planning. Job titles were defined in each of 26 agribusiness categories and a total of 1,428 firms in the categories were randomly sampled to determine the current number of employees, vacancies, expected employment increases, training required for the job, and potential extension courses in business, animal science, crops, soils, and agriculture engineering. An agribusiness directory of 38 pages was compiled, giving the agribusiness industry, name, address, and telephone number of each employer by type of business. Summaries of survey data showing employment and educational training needs are presented in 17 tables. The survey instrument and other project data are appended. (MF)

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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION.

The farming and agribusiness community in the United States is the largest single business employer. This industry is responsible for the feeding of over two hundred million Americans plus countless others in numerous countries around the world. Total sales of agricultural products abroad will bring in an estimated 22 billion dollars, far and away the largest single source of U. S. sales abroad.

Production per worker in U. S. agriculture is the envy of the world, having nearly tripled in the last twenty years. Figures show that output per man-hour in agriculture has increased three times as fast as per man-hour in the nonfarm sector.

Farmers are the nation's biggest private spenders, laying out billions of dollars for tractors, combines, trucks, fertilizer, seed, chemicals and countless other supplies. Investment per worker on U. S. farms is nearly \$100,000 vs. \$55,000 in manufacturing.

In Wisconsin, about 30 percent of all employees have occupations in agribusiness. Hence, Wisconsin's agriculture makes a vital contribution to the economic stability of this state.

Agriculture is very important within the boundaries served by VTAE District One. This includes all of five counties and portions of six other counties covering approximately 5,500 square miles in west central Wisconsin. The basically rural nature of the nearly quarter million people who reside in the area is illustrated by the fact that nearly

62 percent of these people reside on farms or in small towns and villages of less than 2,500 population.

The work force in the district engaged in agriculture consists of 21.5 percent which is the largest single industry within the district. It accounts for approximately 18,000 jobs.

Statistics indicated that YTAE District One has more (1) farms with over \$10,000 sales, (2) farm operators under 34 years of age, (3) overall farm population and (4) dairy cow numbers than any other district in the state. A farm population of 50,358 are farming 10,000+ farms with an average size of 216 acres. Fifty-eight hundred of these farms have over \$10,000 in sales. This farm population must be and is backed by a large and complex agribusiness work force.

These agribusinesses must provide services, processing and marketing functions in support of area farmers. This takes a large work force. A sizable number of these people employed in agribusiness firms are in need of continuing education. There is a need to study these continuing education needs for those presently employed in this essential business and industry. Available information on a district basis about the number and kind of agribusiness firms operating therein is lacking. There has been no concentrated effort taken to study their educational needs.

The main purpose of this study was to identify the agribusiness firms within the district and to determine the needs of their employees for continuing vocational and technical education.

Specific objectives of this research project were as follows:

1. Identify the agribusinesses within the district.

2. Identify the occupations (and job classifications) of those employed in this industry.

3. Identify a present and future employment need for identified skills and competencies, along with training needs for those currently employed in agribusiness occupations.

4. Integrate the data into information which will provide for program planning in this district and can be used as a guide for administrative decision making, budgeting, and program planning.

CHAPTER II

METHODOLOGY

A brief summary (Appendix A) of the project was written. This was presented to the agriculture staff in an effort to acquaint them with methodology. Staff members were asked for input regarding the successful carrying out of the project.

The first task of this project was to identify all the agribusiness firms, except farming, within the district. The following means were used to do this:

1. The agriculture staff was divided and assigned to look at the county assessor rolls in each of the eleven counties served by VTAE District One.
2. The yellow pages in telephone directories of the district's towns and villages were screened for agribusiness firms.
3. Letters (Appendix B) were sent to Wisconsin Power Equipment Retailers Association; Wisconsin Feed, Seed, and Farm Supply Association; Wisconsin Canners and Freezers Association; Wisconsin Federation of Cooperatives; Wisconsin Agribusiness Counsel, and others (Appendix B) asking them for agribusiness firms operating within the area served by VTAE District One.
4. A letter was sent to agriculture instructors of high schools in the district asking for assistance in identifying agribusiness firms.

5. Local papers were scanned for advertising that might identify agribusiness firms.

6. Agribusiness firms were identified in data obtained from Job Service.

The identified agribusiness firms were divided into the following 26 categories:

- 1 - Ag Services
- 2 - Artificial Insemination
- 3 - Auctioneers/Auction Markets
- 4 - Banks/Financing
- 5 - Building Contractors
- 6 - Building Materials
- 7 - Cheese/Cheese Factories
- 8 - Concrete
- 9 - Dairies/Creameries
- 10 - Dairy Equipment & Supplies
- 11 - Dairy Products
- 12 - Excavating/Excavating Equipment
- 13 - Farm Equipment (Implement)
- 14 - Farm Equipment (Non-Implement)
- 15 - Farm Supply.
- 16 - Feed/Seed
- 17 - Fertilizers
- 18 - Foods/Food Processing
- 19 - Forest Products
- 20 - Horticulture: Gardening, Landscaping, and Surveying
- 21 - Livestock
- 22 - Meats: Production, Manufacturing, and Distribution
- 23 - Rendering Companies
- 24 - Trucking
- 25 - Veterinary
- 26 - Miscellaneous

Once the above was completed, the firms in each category were compiled under the headings listed below. An alphabetical listing by city in the district was then made.

The listing of the agribusiness firms was compiled in this manner to facilitate its use at a later date. For example, if a course in animal nutrition is to be offered on a district-wide basis, a letter announcing this could be sent to all the firms listed under Feed/Seed (first column). Should plans be to offer the course in one area to a limited number of people, only the cities to be involved (second column) could be circled. Again, an announcement letter could be sent but only to those firms circled.

It should be noted that there is some duplication of agribusiness firms under some of the headings; i.e., Augusta Feed and Seed appears under Farm Supply, Feed/Seed and Fertilizers. This would indicate that this firm is involved in all three enterprises.

The survey instrument (Appendix C) was developed to get the maximum information in a minimum amount of interview time. Information sought from the survey instrument included:

1. Employment needs of the agribusiness firms for full-time people; i.e., number of full-time people employed now, number of vacancies now and expected changes in employment in next five years.
2. Minimum educational level desired for full-time employees.
3. Part-time and seasonal employees' needs along with months needed.
4. Follow-up of graduates from VTAE programs.
5. Suggested occupational extension courses to upgrade employees.
6. Suggestions for new full-time agriculture programs.

The survey instrument was administered through personal interview. Every third firm in the agribusiness directory was selected as a

business for a potential interview. If the interviewer determined the identified firm not to be representative, the option of interviewing the firm either just above or below was given.

The survey instruments were summarized upon completion of the personal interviews. File folders were made for each of the 26 agribusiness categories. The completed survey instruments were sorted into these files. A summary form (Appendix D) was also put into each file. Job titles common to each of the agribusiness categories were determined. Upon completion of this, final summarization took place.

CHAPTER III

FINDINGS

The total number of agribusiness firms identified in the 26 agribusiness categories was 1,428. As was indicated in the previous chapter, there was some duplication if a firm was involved in a number of agricultural enterprises. A complete listing of these firms is given in Table 1.

A total of 231 agribusiness firms were personally interviewed. This represents 16.18% of the 1,428 identified agribusiness firms within VTAE District One. This percentage would likely be over 20 percent if the duplication factor had not been involved. For example, again using Augusta Feed and Seed, the firm was reported under three categories due to its size. Yet the visit interview was counted as only one.

The percentage of firms interviewed in each category, Table 2, varied considerably. The reason for the low percentage in some categories was that (1) the firms were very small in nature and did not employ many people or (2) the people were self-employed. More emphasis was placed on firms employing greater numbers of people and areas where additional training might be needed.

Figures in Table 2 indicate a sizable number of jobs in the Banking/Finance, Building Contractors, Building Materials, Farm Equipment, Farm Supply, and Feed/Seed categories require technical

training. It would appear from the table this will be true five years from now, too.

Full-Time Employment Needs

The previous table summarized the employment needs by agribusiness categories. A selected number of these categories will be examined in greater detail in the following tables. Both the employment and educational training needs will be shown.

It should be noted that in all these tables the column "Number of Vacancies Trying to Fill Now" may appear low. This figure may be misleading as it was true only at that given time of the interview. The figure could change from day to day.

The greatest percentage of people employed by banks are tellers, loan officers, and clerical as shown in Table 3. It would appear that

there will be a continued strong demand for tellers and loan officers in the next five years. The jobs of management and clerical will have the most need for technical training.

A large number of job titles were identified in the Dairies category, Table 5. The bulk of the people employed by dairies appeared to be general laborers. Growth in this job title will be the greatest in the next five years. A number of people are also employed in management, machine operation, office-clerical, and truck driving. A limited number of firms interviewed required technical training for employment in the business.

A large number of farm equipment (implement) firms were interviewed as evidenced by the data in Table 6. These firms were in general quite optimistic about the future and anticipated continued growth. Many of the jobs in this area require technical training for gainful employment, particularly parts and service. The sales, service, and parts jobs make up the greatest percentage of the job force within an implement firm. Management and office-clerical were next in the numbers needed for operation of the firms. Employers see a sizable increase in the number of parts and service people needed in the next five years.

This agribusiness category listed farm equipment dealers involved in feeding, handling, grain drying equipment and the like. Quite a sizable number of the firms that were interviewed in the farm equipment (implement) category could have been listed in this category as well. Hence, the figures in Table 7 are not truly representative of the industry as a whole.

Much of the farm equipment mentioned in the previous paragraph does need to be assembled. This fact was verified in that 56 people, note Table 7, were employed as set-up people.

A total of 10 different job titles were identified in the farm supply agribusiness category. These are listed in Table 8. Note that there are a sizable number of people employed in many of the categories. Employers indicated that they expect increased sales in the next five years and will need additional people in the sales, delivery, petroleum, feed mill, fertilizer and office/clerical areas.

Technical training and work experience were listed by many employers as being essential in this agribusiness field. Observe in Table 8 that with the exception of the petroleum and plumbing-heating areas technical training was desirable for all job titles.

Many of the job titles that appeared in the farm supply table also appear in Table 9. Again some firms were listed under both agribusiness categories, although the data from the personal interview was included in only one table.

Feed mill personnel make up the greatest employment in this category. Feed and seed firms expect the most growth in this job area in the next five years. Other than for truck drivers, post-secondary training in the remaining job areas was requested by employers.

Employers requested a number of extension courses in the agricultural engineering areas as evidenced in Table 18. Diesel fuel systems is a course that ten employers thought would be useful to their employees. All of the potential extension courses identified in the ag engineering area are listed in Table 18.

CHAPTER IV

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

The main objective of this study was to identify agribusiness firms within VTAE District One and the need of their employees for continuing vocational and technical education.

A total of 1,428 firms were identified in 26 agribusiness categories. Job titles were defined within each of these categories. Agribusiness firms were randomly sampled to determine the current number of people employed, current vacancies and expected employment increases in the next five years. The amount of training and work experience for the job was also determined. Potential occupation extension courses were identified in business, animal science, crops, soils, and agriculture engineering.

The identification of the agribusiness firms in VTAE District One will be very useful in the future. This listing can be used for mailing research surveys on extension classes, seminars, or workshops. People identified within these firms may be potential advisory committee members, instructors, or company contacts for equipment, etc. The agribusiness firm might also serve as a training station should agriculture programs with internships be developed at VTAE District One. In addition, the possibility of jobs in these firms for VTAE District One should not be overlooked.

Agribusiness is big business in VTAE District One and this study has borne that out. There are a large number of agribusiness firms and a large number of people employed in these agribusiness firms. The study revealed that these firms have a number of vacancies on a continuing basis. In addition, many firms expect to expand in the next five years. Many of these jobs will require technical training. The study further indicated that many people will be in need of occupational extension courses for upgrading their skills and knowledge.

VTAE graduates employed in the surveyed agribusiness firms seemed to be quite pleased with the education they had received while in school. Likewise, employers spoke very highly of most all of the VTAE graduates that they had employed in their businesses.

In summary, employer receptiveness and response to the personal interviews was great. The project served a very important role in the improvement of public relations with these agribusiness firms. The data obtained from these employers will be most useful in the future planning of agriculture offerings at VTAE District One.




