ABSTRACT

This directory replaces the 1975 West Virginia Library Association listing of special libraries. It is divided into four sections: (1) alphabetical listing of libraries; (2) geographic listing by city or town; (3) alphabetical listing of librarians; and (4) keyword subject index. Entries provide information gathered from a statewide survey of librarians, including library name, address, telephone, subject matter of collection, bound volumes, subscriptions, services, and restrictions. Entries not updated for 1976 are noted. (KP)
