ABSTRACT

This curriculum guide for English as a Second Language (ESL) Level VI is the sixth of six in a Guam Community College ESL project series. The other five guides, a companion teacher's guide and pre- and post-tests are available separately (see note). The entire project centers around the Peabody Kits P, Level P, Level 1, Level 2, Level 3, and the Articulation Kit. Level VI expands trade and technical knowledge into specific fields: Construction Trades, Mechanical, Electro-Mechanical, Engineering, and Business. It continues reading readiness begun in Level V and contains the beginning writing segment of the ESL program. Aimed at a trade and technical, adult-based learning experience, the 40 lessons are structured for the adult learner and adult-learner interest with emphasis on Guam and island living. Each lesson lists materials (coded to the Peabody kits), objective, and method and has three parts. Drill A reviews the previous lesson materials, Drill B develops and expands new vocabulary and presents stated objectives, and Drill C continues B or adds additional exercises. After the first 20 lessons, the lessons reach back 20 lessons to develop the more important items from that lesson. Written with an absent or remote student in mind, the lessons are intended to be taped by the professor with pauses for student responses. (YLB)

INTRODUCTION

Level VI begins with a new set of lesson numbers and pages. The general format established in preceding levels will be continued.

This level will continue to develop basic trade and technical terms for Construction Trades, Mechanical, Electro-Mechanical, Engineering, and Business. These areas were begun in more systematic development in Level V.

The lessons will be grouped in three's of each of the five before mentioned topics with a repeat of Electro-Mechanical in Lessons 16-18 and Business in Lessons 36-38.

Reading readiness will be continued through the first ten lessons.

Writing, in the formation of letters of the alphabet only, will be done in Lessons 11-36. Writing numbers 1-10 will be done in the last four lessons of this level.

Show N8.

Demonstration:

Instructor Says: This is number 8.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: It is made with two circles.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: At the top make a small circle to the left.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: the two circles come together.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: There, you made the number 8.

Pause for Response:

Repeat the above twelve lines of dialogue two more times for reinforcement.

Show N9.

Instructor Says: This is number 9.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: Begin to the right at the middle.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: Circle to the left, up and around,

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: Down to the line and curve up to the left.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: There, you made the number 9.

Pause for Response:

Repeat the above ten lines of dialogue two more times for reinforcement.

Show N10.

Instructor Says: This is number 10.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: Begin at the top left and make a straight line to the line.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: This is like the number 1.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: To the right at the top make a circle to the left.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: This is a zero.

Pause for Response:

Instructor Says: There, you made the number 10.

Pause for Response:

Repeat the above twelve lines of dialogue two more times for reinforcement.

Repeat the above demonstration lines of dialogue for reinforcement.

DO NOT DO the Repeat lines.
