**ABSTRACT**

The guide provides information about the availability of approximately 275 magazines in media suitable for use by persons unable to read or handle conventional print materials. The alphabetical listing (by title) includes information on magazine title, frequency on issue, special medium or media in which it is available, source or sources from which it may be obtained, subscription price (if applicable), and a brief description of the contents. A subject index breaks materials into such topic areas as the arts, business and consumerism, children's magazines, literature, hobbies, current affairs, religion, professions, and science and technologies. Separate indexes are provided for magazines available in braille, cassette, disc, large-type, and moon-type. (CL)

## Introduction

This reference circular provides information about the availability of magazines in media suitable for use by persons who are unable to read or handle conventional print materials. Media covered are: braille, cassette, disc, large type, and Moon type. The information included was provided by magazine producers. As new or revised information about magazines in special media becomes available it will be included in future editions of this circular.

Each entry in Section I, Alphabetical List of Magazines provides the following information:

- Magazine title
- Frequency of issue
- Special medium or media in which it is available
- Source or sources from which it can be obtained
- Subscription price, if applicable
- Brief description of the magazine's contents

The term "Direct" or "Loan" appears in entries for magazines that are available to eligible persons on free subscription or free loan through a cooperating network of libraries for the blind and physically handicapped in the United States. Persons eligible for this free library service must be unable to read or handle conventional print materials because of visual or physical impairment and must be residents of the United States or American citizens living abroad. Complete information about eligibility and listings of available books and magazines may be obtained from the nearest network library or from the National Library Service for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, Library of Congress, Washington, DC 20542.

IF AN ENTRY DOES NOT CONTAIN THE TERM "DIRECT" OR "LOAN" THE MAGAZINE MUST BE ORDERED DIRECTLY FROM THE SOURCE INDICATED, NOT FROM A NETWORK LIBRARY FOR THE BLIND AND PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED. FULL ADDRESSES OF NON-NETWORK SOURCES APPEAR IN SECTION VIII. SUBSCRIPTION PRICES SHOULD BE VERIFIED WITH THE SOURCES PRIOR TO ORDERING, AS THEY ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.
