ABSTRACT

This 1984-85 statistical survey of libraries at four-year colleges and universities, two-year colleges, law libraries, and miscellaneous academic institutions in the Pacific Northwest provides relevant data for comparison and inventory purposes. A total of 98 institutions responded to the questionnaire, which was administered by the Pacific Northwest Library Association (PNLA). Although the current questionnaire follows past practice in order to provide comparable data, some changes have been implemented. Questions dealing with online interlibrary loan capability were omitted and several questions relating to usage were added; i.e., circulation figures, reference transactions, gate counts, bibliographic instruction statistics, database transactions, and hours of service. Divided by type of institution, data tables include but are not limited to the following topics: (1) rank by collection size; (2) volumes held as of June 1985; (3) volumes per full time student; (4) growth rate; (5) total microform units; (6) audiovisual units (broken into categories); (7) government documents; (8) number of items borrowed; (9) current serials; (10) total library operating expenses; (11) professional staff; (12) non-professional, non-student staff; (13) number of male/female professional staff; (14) number of hours in professional work week; (15) beginning professional salaries; and (16) director's salaries. The survey instrument, instructions for completing the questionnaire, and an index to respondents are included. (THC).

INTRODUCTION

This compilation of academic library statistics for the Pacific Northwest is the result of the fourth biennial survey. First published in PNLA Quarterly in the summer of 1980 (with U.S. and B.C. university library statistics for 1978-79, and B.C. 2-year college library statistics for 1976-77), the statistics have since been published separately in April, 1982 and April, 1984. Serials librarians will appreciate that, while the editors have changed, the title has remained the same.

The PNLA Academic Division, reconstituted as the Academic Interest Group in the fall of 1985 (due to a change in PNLA's constitution), has been steadfastly working with other groups involved in collecting academic library statistics with a view to reducing the number of questionnaires which gather the same data in different formats. Most recent efforts have centered on developing an ACRL questionnaire which would meet the needs of academic libraries in the Pacific Northwest for timely data. Unfortunately, as of the summer of 1985, these efforts had not borne fruit, and the PNLA Academic Division members present at the annual business meeting agreed to continue the biennial survey.

The current questionnaire follows past practice in order to provide comparable data. However, some changes have been implemented, based on a draft ACRL survey. Omitted in this latest survey were questions dealing with online interlibrary loan capability. Several questions relating to usage were added:

circulation figures, reference transactions, gate counts, bibliographic instruction statistics, database transactions, and hours of service. Surprisingly, most libraries were able to provide figures for these new categories.

The return rate is down this year. While 126 returns were received for the 1978-79 survey, 141 for 1980-81, and 129 for 1982-83, only 98 returns were received for the current year. Of these, two were received too late for data entry, and one was a blank response from a library which had ceased operations in the summer of 1985.

Over the life of these surveys, institutions have come and gone. Some skip a year but resurface in a later survey, thus making direct comparisons from year to year problematical. This year's data show a number of new (to our publication) Oregon libraries, for example.

There are a number of caveats for the reader. Firstly, and this has been a problem since the survey's inception, some libraries report volume holdings, and others report titles. This means that some statistics are not directly comparable. It is, therefore, important to check the footnotes. Physical holdings (volumes) are given unless noted as bibliographic in the footnotes.

The Canadian dollar has been converted to U.S. dollars by our usual method, taking the average noon exchange rate each month, July, 1984 through June, 1985, as published in the Bank of Canada Review. This year the average was \$1.3387583 U.S. per Canadian dollar, so the Canadian dollar was converted to U.S.

dollars at .7469608. . Due to the devalued Canadian dollar, Canadian salaries and expenditures will appear lower than usual.

Many Canadian libraries use March 31, rather than June 30, as the end of the fiscal year. This is indicated in the footnotes where it appears on the questionnaires. Some libraries have changed other dates to match regular reporting dates.

A number of additional tables have been added this year. In checking the data, it was clear that certain figures, if left in the calculations, would skew the data in an unwarranted fashion. For example, several libraries reported professional work weeks in excess of 40 hours. It is likely that these figures were determined by multiplying the number of librarians by a 40-hour work week. Other libraries may have had an unusual year in a given category, and the resultant out-of-line figures would significantly alter otherwise normal patterns. Thus, it was decided to exclude certain figures from averages, and these are so indicated in footnotes to the tables.

1. Very few libraries reported the average student hourly wage. The average hourly wage for the 19 libraries reporting this category is \$3.67.
2. The average number of hours in the professional work week is 37.73. Universities (38.62) and law/miscellaneous libraries (38.86) tend to average longer hours than two-year colleges (36.43). Canadian institutions in all categories have shorter work weeks than their U.S. counterparts (35.35 versus 38.59).
3. The average number of bibliographic instruction sessions conducted for 1984-85 was 130. The average number of students receiving instruction was 1,384. Two-year colleges (180 sessions average) are more heavily involved in BI than are universities (102 sessions average) or law school and miscellaneous libraries (55 sessions average).
4. The percentage of male and female directors is virtually the same as four years ago at 65% and 35%, respectively, and there has been little change in the overall sexual composition of the professional positions:

5. Table 8 gives the average percentage of catalog records in machine-readable form for those libraries reporting a percentage higher than zero. An additional 14 libraries reported 0%, and if figured into the average, would bring the percentage down from 66% to 56%.

COLLECTIONS
