ABSTRACT

This enrollment summary provides collegewide and campus data for Miami-Dade Community College for the 5-year period from 1980-81 to 1984-85. Summary data are presented for three major variables: credit/non-credit enrollments, semester credits, and credit load. These variables are tabulated by enrollment elements of interest, such as ethnic membership, student declaration of degree type, age, full-/part-time status, and residency. Highlighted trends include the following: (1) all measures of productivity showed a steady decline over the past 5 years; i.e., student enrollments dropped 7.1%, semester credits dropped 11.4%, and average credit load decreased by 0.7 units; (2) dramatic increases in non-credit enrollments and credit equivalents were attributed to enhanced efforts in campus centers for business, industrial, and professional development; recruitment and expanded services; corporate contracts; and course marketing; (3) ratios of males to females remained unchanged across years at approximately 4.5:5.5 collegewide; (4) there was a greater decline in the number of full-time than part-time enrollments over the 5-year period; and (5) the number of new freshmen declined by 30.4% collegewide. 

SUMMARY DATA ON UNDUPLICATED ENROLLMENT
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 1984-85

Overview

The Annual Student Profile has been restructured so that tables containing five-year summaries and College-wide summaries precede campus specific data summaries. All tables in the Annual Student Profile contain enrollment data that represent unduplicated headcounts for the academic year 1984-85. These summary data present the three major variables--credit/non-credit enrollments, semester credits, and credit load by College-wide and across campuses. Major variables are tabulated by enrollment elements of interest such as ethnic membership, student declaration of degree type, age, full-time/part-time status, and residency. Comparisons in this profile are across the last two years or over the past five consecutive years. All data categories cover campus and College-wide comparisons. Because data are entirely annual and unduplicated, no further mention will be made of these components in the narrative. The only change within the tables themselves over previous years is the use of semester credits rather than FTEs.

Five-Year Summaries by College-wide and Campuses

Table 1 indicates the productivity factors of credit enrollment (headcount), semester hours, and credit load for 1981-1985. All of these measures of productivity show a pattern of steady decline over the past five years College-wide. Student enrollments dropped 7.1%, semester credits dropped 11.4%, and the average credit load dropped 0.7.

While South Campus grew somewhat and Medical Campus grew by 19.4% in enrollments from 1981-1985, North and Wolfson Campuses showed enrollment retrenchments (17.8% and 15.7% respectively). Two patterns of enrollments to semester credits emerge in Table 1. For both North and South Campuses, these two indicators move in the same direction. When enrollments rise, so do credits; when enrollments drop, so do credits drop. However, for the five-year period shown, when viewed year by year, Wolfson and Medical show irregular patterns of enrollments to semester credits. Wolfson had a drop

of 23.4% in credits. Medical credits are at its 1980-81 level. Students are taking a lower mean credit load in 1985 than in 1981 on all campuses except on South Campus.

Table 2 presents non-credit data. Non-credit contact hours are translated into semester credit equivalents. Non-credit courses occur in the College Preparatory and Occupational areas. Also offered for non-credit are the cluster of recreation and citizenship courses in the Community Instruction Services discipline. Increases of enrollments and credit equivalents are dramatic in 1984-85 College-wide. The greatest proportionate increase in both students (+33.3%) and credit equivalents (+36.8%) occurred at Wolfson Campus. Increases on campuses are attributed to increased efforts in campus centers for business, industrial, and professional development; recruitment and expanded services, corporate contracts; development of new curricula, marketing of courses, etc. The bulge in the 1981-82 data can be explained by the HELP grant awarded during that year.

Gender data are featured in Table 3. Ratios of males to females have remained unchanged across years at approximately 4.5:5.5 College-wide with small proportionate female increases each succeeding year. The mix of genders is still more balanced on North than on other campuses. Medical Campus has always had the greatest gender imbalance (approximately 1:4).

There has been a greater decline in the number of full-time than part-time enrollments over five years (Table 4). Proportionately in 1980, for each one full-time student, there were approximately 5+ part-time students. In 1985 the ratio has changed to 1:7+. Campus data show proportional changes in the same direction.

Over the prior five-year period, as shown in Table 5, the number of New Freshmen (Enrollment Code J) has declined by 6,286 (30.4%) College-wide. The largest proportionate declines can be traced to North and Wolfson Campuses (35.1% and 41.9% respectively). Drops in New Freshmen are eventually reflected in graduation rates.

COLLEGE-WIDE SUMMARIES

Tables 6-14 are College-wide summaries. Table 6 shows credit and non-credit semester credit equivalents by discipline. Over a five-year period, occupational credits have decreased in absolute numbers by 58,728 (-18.5%); developmental credits have also progressively decreased by 68,795 (-52%). Conversely, non-credit occupational semester credit equivalents increased by 21,655 (+50.7%). Non-credit developmental semester credit equivalents have likewise increased by 12,432 (+30.9%).

The five-year comparison of credit/non-credit enrollment and semester credit by end of term (Table 7) shows, characteristically, that both enrollments and semester credits for credit and non-credit courses are highest in the Fall and Winter terms. For the first time, in 1984-85, total headcount was highest in the Winter term. The change is attributed to the rise in non-credit enrollments, but the accompanying semester credit equivalents made little difference in boosting Winter term semester credit levels. Though the annual headcount enrollment is higher in 1984-85 as compared to 1980-81, the proportion of credit students is diminishing while the proportion of non-credit enrollment is increasing.

Ethnic average credit load is the topic of Table 8. Among the three primary ethnic groups, Hispanic average credit load is heaviest (15.5), followed by Black non-Hispanic (14.6) and lastly White non-Hispanic (12.0). Over the past several years, average credit load has been dropping. Declining White non-Hispanic and Black non-Hispanic enrollments continue to be evident. For the first time, Hispanic enrollments declined in 1984-85, albeit a small percentage over 1983-84 (0.7%). Enrollment proportions are now 48.8%, 32.8%, and 16.3% for Hispanics, Whites and Blacks respectively.

Table 9 shows that for 1984-85, the two youngest age groups (14-20 and 21-25) carried the heaviest average credit load (19.0 and 15.1), comprised 60.3% of the student population, and generated 71.0% of the credits. They were the most likely to be attending college full-time. There is an inverse relationship between age groups and average credit load--the greater the age, the lighter the credit load. In the 21-50 age groups, males carried a heavier average credit load than did females. Across years, the distribution of average credit load has maintained relative stability.

Among the ethnic groups commonly compared (Table 10), Hispanics carry the heaviest credit load (15.5), followed by Blacks (14.6), and lastly White non-Hispanics (12.0). All of these groups are carrying slightly lighter loads than in the 1983-84 academic year.

Student declarations of degree type (Table 11) are an indication of interest in a program. Coupled with actual program enrollments, they help to foreshadow upcoming program enrollments. Associate in Arts and Associate in Science declarations have decreased somewhat while non-degree declarations have risen by 4.1%. With the elimination of all but three planned certificate (P.C.) programs, P.C. declarations have dropped 29.8%.

Two major enrollment status categories--New Freshmen (J) and Continuing (L) in Table 12 show small declines in enrollments over the comparison year. Though modest, the increase of New Transfer (K) and Former M-DCC Students (M) was almost able to offset the enrollment slippage (-1.1%). The New Freshmen (J) average credit load increased by 0.4 credits.

Over fifty percent of students have 23 or fewer cumulative credits earned (Table 13). The majority of these are part-timers, and, of course, entering freshmen. Students in the 61+ cumulative credit categories amount to 19.4% of enrollments, or 12,284 in absolute numbers. Proportions of both part-time and full-time in the 61+ cumulative credits earned group have increased over 1983-84 by 2.2% (1,235 students). Enrollments by residency have remained virtually unchanged (Table 14).

NORTH CAMPUS SUMMARIES

North Campus Summaries

Tables 15-23 deal with North Campus data exclusively.

- ° North Campus non-credit semester credit equivalents for the occupational discipline (Table 15) are up by 37.1%. Developmental non-credit shows a 13.7% decline. The Advanced and Professional, and credit Occupational disciplines show steady declines across the five-year period. The non-credit occupational and developmental disciplines constitute 5.6% of the total North Campus credits as compared to 3.6% College-wide.
- ° Data proportions for semester credits by end of term (Table 16) mirror College-wide data with a pattern of decreasing credit enrollments. Over five years, semester credits have declined by 21.1% or 84,098 in absolute numbers.
- ° Table 17 shows that among the major ethnic categories, Hispanics carry the heaviest credit load (15.7), followed by Black non-Hispanics (15.1), and lastly, White non-Hispanics (12.0). The average credit load has declined across the past three years to 14.5. The younger the individual, the greater the average credit load is likely to be (Table 18). The age groups from 14-25 make up 60.8% of the students and generate 70.7% of the credits. Males in the age range of 21-35 carry a heavier credit load than do females. The heaviest load (20.2 credits) is taken by Hispanics in the 14-20 age range (Table 19).
- ° The Associate in Arts degree is declared by 46.1% of North Campus students (Table 20); the Associate in Science degree by 27.6%. There is a slight shift in proportions from A.A. and A.S. declarations among White non-Hispanics and Black non-Hispanics toward the non-degree category. In actual enrollments (Table 21), there is a downward drift in both full-time and part-time students. Overall, students are taking fewer semester credits resulting in a somewhat lower credit load.
- ° In 1984-85, 48.2% of enrollments are in the 0-23 cumulative credits earned category (Table 22). Twenty percent (3,987 students) are at 60+

credits, an increase over 1973-84. The part-time to full-time ratio is nearly 7:1. There are approximately equal numbers of full-time male students as there are females. Dade County residency proportions increased by 0.2% (Table 23).

SOUTH CAMPUS SUMMARIES

South Campus Summaries

Tables 24-32 are devoted to summaries of South Campus data.

- ° The Advanced and Professional discipline has grown by 15.3% since 1980-81 (Table 24). While occupational credit activity has declined, occupational non-credit activity has increased. The combined non-credit occupational and non-credit developmental amount to 2.0% of FTE funded semester credits in 1984-85. The Fall semester consistently draws larger enrollments than other semesters (Table 25). Annual credit and non-credit headcount has risen 8.5% and semester credits 2.3% since 1980-81. Table 26 shows that Hispanic average credit load is 16.0, Black non-Hispanic is 14.7 and White non-Hispanic is 12.5 in 1984-85; across a five-year period, neither the relative position within ethnicity nor across ethnicity has changed appreciably for credit load.
- ° The youngest age groups (14-25) in Table 27 carried the heaviest credit loads (14.6 and 19.0) in 1984-85. They numbered 19,214 students, constituted 71.0% of the population, and carried 81.1% of the semester credits. With each advancing age category, there is a decreasing load. Within the youngest age group, Hispanics carry the greatest credit load (Table 28).
- ° Student declaration of degree types resulted in 63.5% for A.A., 11.9% for A.S. and 23.3% for non-degree (Table 29). Continuing students (Enrollment Code L) are largely responsible for the slight enrollment increase in 1984-85 (Table 30). The full-time/part-time ratio of enrollments remains stable; for semester credits across years also, there has been a 1.8% shift of credits to part-time students. The largest number of full-time students lie in the 24-35 and 61+ cumulative credits earned categories, with females leading males in both credit ranges (Table 31). In 1984-85, 18.0% of students (4,865) had accumulated 61+ credits and were within graduation credit ranges. Residency (Table 32) remained relatively unchanged.

WOLFSON CAMPUS SUMMARIES

Wolfson Campus Summaries

Tables 33-41 deal exclusively with Wolfson Campus data.

- ° Advanced and Professional credits increased by 8.6% since 1980-81 (Table 33). There has been a phenomenal increase in the occupational non-credit area over the five-year period (91.3%). As stated in the narrative of the Five-Year Summary, much of this growth on Wolfson Campus is credited to the increased activity in marketing and in developing courses to meet assessed needs. Unlike North and South Campuses, Winter enrollments on Wolfson are likely to exceed Fall enrollments (Table 34). In 1980-81, non-credit headcount was 67.4% of credit headcount enrollment; in 1984-85, non-credit and credit headcounts were nearly equal. Semester credits have increased by 4.6% from the 1983-84 data. Table 35 shows that Hispanics constitute two-thirds of Wolfson enrollments and, of the major ethnic groups, carry the heaviest credit load (14.5). The Black non-Hispanic load closely follows at 14.0. White non-Hispanics are at a historical low credit load of 9.4.
- ° As is true on other campuses, the youngest age groups carry the greatest credit load and this load, generally, becomes progressively lighter in the older age groups (Table 36). Males, as a whole, carry a heavier credit load. A corollary to the above (Table 37) is the fact of young Hispanics having the heaviest load in the 14-20 age category (19.8) and Black non-Hispanics in the age range of 21-25 having the heaviest mean credit load (17.5).
- ° Degree type declarations (Table 38) indicate a shift to A.S. and non-degree. New Freshmen (Table 39), though smaller in number, are carrying a heavier load in 1984-85 than in 1983-84 (15.0 as opposed to 14.3). New Transfers have increased in absolute number, semester credits and average credit load. Former M-DCC students (Code M), while slightly fewer in number in 1984-85, are carrying a greater credit load. Freshmen in the 0-23 cumulative credit range (Table 40) comprise 59.5% of enrollments. Sophomores in the 61+ credits earned group make up 14.1

percent (N=1,629) of enrollments. More than 90% of Wolfson's population are Dade County residents.

Medical Campus Summaries

Tables 42-50 represent Medical Campus data.

- ° Medical Campus offers no non-credit courses except for the developmental discipline (Table 42). Advanced and Professional credits have declined by 12.8% over the past five years. Occupational credits have remained relatively stable. Both credit and non-credit developmental credits have risen substantially (94.2% and 35.6% respectively). Medical Campus has a unique term enrollment pattern (Table 43). Its student enrollments are roughly equal during Fall and Winter; Spring enrollments are typically more than two-thirds of a major term enrollment. Unlike the other campuses, headcount has been fairly stable across the last three years. Semester credits in 1984-85 are the lowest since 1980-81. Table 44 indicates similarity to other campuses with regard to Hispanic average credit load. As is true on all campuses, credit load is dropping. The high credit generation age range categories of 14-40 account for 89.6% of Medical Campus credits (Table 45). Credit load is highest on this campus in the 14-25 age range (18.6 and 20.2) among campuses (Table 46). Hispanics carried the heaviest load followed by White non-Hispanics, but Black non-Hispanic credit load was not much behind. The youngest Hispanics carried a 22.2 average credit load.

- ° Unlike other campuses, Medical Campus is strongly A.S. oriented (Table 47). Nearly one-half of enrollments are declared A.S. and 45.2% are non-degree. An increase in Continuing and Former students (Table 48) contributed to the campus headcount enrollment rise. However, total semester credits decreased. The number of students at low credit ranges (0-23 cumulative credits earned) decreased slightly while, the number in the 61+ category increased by 14.6% (Table 49). Residency status remained fairly constant across years (Table 50).
