
ABSTRACT

Intended for use by institutions in developing countries as a source of information for locating available resources on which to draw for training and planning activities in distance education, this directory provides information on the types of instructional materials that are being used by 34 institutions of higher education in Australia, India, Pakistan, New Zealand, Sri Lanka, and Thailand. The information was compiled through the use of proformas sent to a number of institutions in 11 countries. The institutions that responded are listed by country in alphabetical order and the instructional materials are listed together with the appropriate subjects or courses of study. Instructional media most commonly used are printed correspondence, audiocassette tapes, and videocassettes, but some of the programs also use telephone tutorials, study guides, filmstrips, computer managed instruction or videodisc. Information on instructional materials includes the language(s) they are available in; the person to contact for further information; and, in some cases, the prices of materials and suitability of courses for other institutions. The proforma that was used to collect the information is appended. (DJR)

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INTRODUCTION

This short directory contains some basic information on the types of instructional materials that are being used by 34 institutions of higher education in Australia, India, Pakistan, New Zealand, Sri Lanka and Thailand. A proforma was sent to a number of institutions in eleven countries through their respective National Commissions for Unesco. Information compiled in this publication is based on the returned proformas and other materials that were contributed at the same time. A few of the proformas, however, could not be used as these were incomplete or the data were not made available in a meaningful way for the present purpose. In other cases, no responses were received from the institutions.

It may be observed that a wide variety of courses are being offered and materials used in distance teaching modes. In many cases these form complex combinations, making it all the more difficult to present the data in a comparative framework. A simple approach, however, has been adopted in that generally the instructional materials have been listed together with the subjects or courses of study. The institutions have been listed by country in alphabetical order.

It is evident that printed correspondence materials in one form or the other are the most commonly used instructional materials. In the industrialized countries like Australia and New Zealand which also have a long history of distance teaching, there is also an extensive use of audio cassette tapes. This relatively simple and inexpensive device also constitutes an important component of the media used by the distance teaching universities in Pakistan, Sri Lanka and Thailand. The popularity of other means such as video cassette, telephone tutorial seems to be on the increase. The role of radio and television is minimal in formal instruction with the exception of the three universities in Pakistan and Thailand which make substantial use of both radio and television.

The directory does not list all the institutions in this vast region nor does it give a complete account of how various media are being used in distance teaching. What it contains may be regarded as exemplars. It is hoped that the directory will be particularly useful for institutions in the developing countries as a source of information for locating available resources on which to draw for training and planning activities.
