ABSTRACT

This enrollment summary provides collegewide and campus-specific data for Miami-Dade Community College (Florida) for 1981-82 through 1985-86. All data are for unduplicated headcounts by the three major variables of credit/non-credit enrollments, semester credits, and credit load. These major variables are matched against factors of ethnicity, degree types, full-/part-time status, age, and residency. Among the trends highlighted in this profile are the following: (1) the declining trend in student enrollment has reversed itself, albeit modestly (0.7%); (2) credit equivalents have increased by 37.8% over the previous 5 years; (3) nearly 50% of the credit equivalent increases in 1985-86 were due to foundation and grant activities on North Campus; (4) over 5 years, occupational credits declined by 18.7%, while occupational credit equivalents exceeded the 5-year peak of 1981-82; (5) steep declines in college preparatory credits were attributable to the removal of English as a Second Language credits in 1982-83; (6) the semester credit to credit-equivalent ratio in 1985-86 was 92.7:7.3 of credits generated college-wide; (7) Black non-Hispanic enrollments decreased 2.3% over the 5-year period; and (8) Hispanic student enrollments rose to 49.2% of the total student population in 1985-86 and carried the heaviest average credit load. Highlights of the Annual Student Profile for the Academic Year 1986-86

- * The declining trend in student enrollment has reversed itself, albeit modestly (0.7%).
- * The 13,915 semester credit increases are attributable primarily to enrollment increases on South Campus and average credit load increases on Wolfson Campus.
- * Credit equivalents have increased by 37.8% over the previous five years.
- * Nearly 50% of the credit equivalent increases in 1985-86 were due to foundation and grant activities on North Campus.
- * Over five years, occupational credits have declined by 18.7% while occupational credit equivalents have exceeded the five year peak of 1981-82.
- * Steep declines in college preparatory credits are attributable to the removal of ESL credits in 1982-83; the sharp drop in college preparatory credits in 1983-84 resulted from declines in first-time-in-college enrollment.
- * The semester credit to credit equivalent ratio in 1985-86 is 92.7: 7.3 of credits generated college-wide.
- * Black non-Hispanic enrollments decreased 2.3% from 1984-85. Over a five year period, this group declined by 13.0% in enrollment.
- * White non-Hispanic enrollment is gradually declining with each passing year. The present average credit load of this group is 2.5 mean credits below that of the total college.
- * Hispanic student enrollments have risen to 49.2% of the total student population and this group carries the heaviest average credit load (15.7).
- * College-wide data show a substantial proportion of enrollment increases from the new transfer (K) enrollment status code.
- * The youngest age categories (14-20, 21-25) continue to carry the heaviest credit load and to generate the most semester credits (70%)
- * New freshmen (code J) enrollments declined by 2.6% in 1985-86 and by 19.4% over a five year period.
- * Full-time students within a semester of graduation (assuming a 60 credit hour degree) comprise 44.6% of full-time enrollments.

ANNUAL STUDENT PROFILE
SUMMARY DATA ON UNDUPLICATED ENROLLMENT
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 1985-86

Introduction

The Annual Student Profile which provides enrollment statistics for the academic year is, for the second successive year, arranged by college-wide and campus specific data by five years and two years comparisons. All data are for unduplicated headcounts by the three major variables of credit/non-credit enrollment, semester credits, and credit load. These major variables are matched against factors of ethnicity, student declaration of degree types, full-time/part-time status, age, and residency. Semester credits have again replaced FTEs. Trends, patterns, relationships, and marked deviations have been noted.

Five-Year Summaries by College-Wide and Campuses

Tables 1-5 cover five year comparisons by campus and college-wide. Table 1 and Figures 1-4 present the productivity elements of credit enrollments (headcounts), semester credits, and average credit load for 1981-82 through 1985-86. College-wide, while enrollments have declined by 4.3% over the past five years, semester credits have dropped by the absolute number 84,705 and the average credit load has decreased by 0.6. However, viewed from a two year perspective, enrollments are up somewhat (0.7%). This latter increase is accounted for principally by growth on South Campus enrollments equaling its peak in the recent past (1981-82). The increase of 13,915 semester credits over the past two years is primarily generated by South Campus enrollment increases and secondly by Wolfson Campus average credit load increases. Of most significance is the reversal of the five year pattern of decline for these productivity factors.

Figure 1 pictorializes the direction of semester credits over five years. North Campus' (+) dramatic deviation from other campuses is made instantaneously evident. Figure 2 depicts the linear similitude between enrollment and semester credit.




Figure 3: Average Credit Load for the Past Five Years

Variations among campuses of average credit load are marked (Figure 3). When campus data are collapsed into college-wide summations, the variability is largely attenuated.

Table 2 is the non-credit counterpart of the credit data in Table 1. Non-credit enrollments were 61,757 in 1985-86. This is an increase of 37.8% over five years. Credit equivalents have increased by 20,035 over the past year. A dramatic rise of credit equivalents (which accounts for nearly 50% of these credits college-wide) occurred on North Campus. Activities on North which generated these credit equivalents were numerous. These activities fall into the two broad categories of the Haitian Caribbean Foundation support of compensatory education and job performance based occupational grants. Figure 4 shows increasing credit equivalents after a period of decreases. North Campus credit equivalents rose substantially over the last year.

Enrollments by gender is the topic of Table 3. Gender proportions are relatively unchanged across time at a ratio of 44 : 56, male to female. Medical Campus continues to persist in the predominance of females (3/4 of the student population) and North Campus is characteristically most gender balanced. Gender ratios within campuses remain stable over the years.

The proportionate decline in absolute numbers of full-time students is steeper than that of part-time students (Table 4). For every one full-time enrollment in 1985-86, there were 7.9 part-time enrollments. This ratio contrasts sharply with the Fall Term ratio due to definitional impositions which in practice, means that Fall Term full-time students who do not re-matriculate in the Winter Term are reclassified as part-time for purposes of this analysis on an annual basis.

Table 5 and Figure 5 show that new freshmen enrollments (code J) continue to decline, -2.6% compared to 1984-85 and -19.4% over a five year period. This declining enrollment along with more stringent graduation requirements suggest fewer numbers of graduates in the years to come. North Campus "Js" decreased by 26.7% across five years as compared to a 15%-16% decline on the other campuses.

Tables 6-14 deal with college-wide summaries. Table 6 shows credit and non-credit equivalents by discipline. There is relative credit stability for the Advanced and Professional discipline. Occupational credits have declined by 18.7% (-57,519 credits) in the five years summarized while occupational non-credits in 1985-86 (28,821.9) have slightly exceeded their 1981-82 peak. The placement of standards---the high school diploma and the Basic Skills Assessments---are impacting occupational credit enrollments. Business and industry course activities are largely responsible for the non-credit increases in the occupational discipline. Unlike previous years, Adult Basic and Secondary have been separated from college preparatory. The dramatic drop (as footnoted) in college preparatory in 1982-83 was attributed to the removal of ESL courses from this category. The sharp 1983-84 decrease was due to the decline in numbers of first-time-in-college students. A detailed research report on college preparatory credits will be issued soon. The Haitian (Caribbean) Employment Language Program (HELP) grant can be seen in the 1981-82 data for the Adult Basic and Secondary category. This grant extended into part of the succeeding year.

The highest enrollments and greatest numbers of semester credits are typically generated in the Fall Term of any given academic year (Table 7). As headcounts increase appreciably, so would semester credits show a pattern of increases. Over the past three years, credit equivalents for the Winter Term exceeded those of the Fall Term. For the short terms, Spring Term generates approximately 62% of the credits as compared to the Summer Term across years. Semester credits accounted for 92.7% of total credits generated in 1985-86.

Table 8 and Figure 6 show that in spite of the college-wide increase in number of students and average credit load in 1985-86, Black non-Hispanic enrollments have decreased by 2.3%. Over a five year period, this same group declined by 13.0% in enrollments. White non-Hispanic enrollments have decreased slightly in 1985-86 along with the average credit load and this latter factor is below total college average credit load by 2.5 mean credits. Enrollments have risen to 49.2% of the total college population among Hispanics, but the average credit load has diminished by

0.9 across five years. Nearly 100% of the increase in the 1985-86 enrollments was attributed to this latter group, discounting the minor ethnic categories.

Beyond the two years shown in Table 9, patterns of characteristics persist with respect to factors depicted. The younger age groups carry the heaviest credit load and, concomitantly, are most likely to be full-time enrollments. A progressive inverse relationship exists between size of average credit load and age category---the older the student, the lighter the average credit load. The two youngest age categories generated 70% of the total semester credits in 1985-86, down from 71% in 1984-85. Females comprise 56.4% of the student population and generate 54.7% of the semester credits, a roughly 1:1 gender to semester credit percentage relationship.

The average credit load of the major ethnic groups (Table 10) for 1985-86 are as follows: Hispanic (15.7), Black non-Hispanic (15.0) and White non-Hispanic (11.9). Student declaration of degree type (Table 11) reveals educational intent. Overall 51% declared the A.A. degree, 27.2% Non-degree, and 20% A.S. degree intent. The non-degree declaration has stabilized at around 27% across five years college-wide. Within the three ethnic groups considered, Hispanics are most A.A. degree oriented (58%); Whites are split between A.A. and Non-degree (43.2%/40.8%); Blacks more than others are spread across A.A. and A.S. (43.3% and 30.8% respectively).

Table 12 details the headcount changes by enrollment status. There is a 2.6% decline in new freshmen students for 1985-86. This decline was partially offset by a 0.4 increase in average credit load which translates to a slight 0.27% credit loss for code "J". Another mitigating factor in the "J" enrollment drops is its confinement to part-time students. Full-time "Js" increased by 6.9% (N=163) over the comparison year. Transfer students increased by 9.5% (N=633). Part-time new transfer students were largely responsible for the college enrollment trend reversal.

Full-time students within a semester of graduation as defined by generic cumulative credits earned comprise 44.6% of full-time enrollments (Table 13). Not considering full/part-time status, there were 18,678

students in the potential graduation pool of 48 or more credits earned in 1985-86. The proportions of students who are Dade County residents (Table 14) have increased to 88.5%. Out-of-State and Visa enrollments are dropping.

Campus based details on the succeeding tables are left to the reader to scrutinize.



Relationship of Semester Credits to Headcounts, College-Wide



Figure 4: Credit Equivalents by Campus for the Past Five Years





Figure 6: Enrollment Among Major Ethnic Groups for Past Five Years


