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## ABSTRACT

This publication summarızes data gathered by Alaska's State Department of Education on school operations, faciiıties, programs, students, and personnel in each of Alaska's school districts. For each of the 55 districts that existed in 1989, the information is grouped into six subject headings: background, operating revenues and expenditures, funding community summary, student characteristics, staff ratios and statistics, and staff and student demographıcs. The background data include the district's size, population, unemployment, and percentage of adults with a high school diploma. The operating revenues and expenditures are financial characteristics about each district's general operations. The funding community summaries show the number of buildings in a district, grade levels served, and enrollment. Student characteristics include numbers of students enrolled in the followins programs: gifted/talented, special needs, migrant, bilingual, Chapter 1. and vocational education. Staff ratios and statistics show numbers of teachers, instructional aldes, and administrators in a district. The section also includes average salaries, average age, student ratios, and average years of experience for each group. The demographics section gives characteristics of teachers, aides, administrators, students, and high school graduates, broken down into gender and ethnic groups. All the data gathered for the publication are from school district reports or from state and federal sources. This document also contains state totals, a glossary of terms, and a listing of Alaska's school district offices and superintendents. (TES)

# Profies of Alaska's Public School Districts

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## INTRÚDUCTION

The Alaska Legislature in its Fiscal Year 89 authorization. directed the State Department of Education to prepare annual profiles on each school district. In its directive the Legiciature wrote:

It is the intent of the Legislature that the Deprirtment of Education will implement a data management sy'stem including but not limited to profiles of school districts which include data on school operations, faclities, programs, siudents and personnel.

In compliance, the Department assembled this publication which will be updates annually. This information is intended to add to the statewide knowledge base and understanding of education in Alaska.

The summary of data in this publication represents only a small portion of the statistics contained in the Department's computerized data management system. The District Profile Data Base is a compendium of information gathered from numerous sources. For example, the financial data is gathered rrom the audited financial reports submitted by school districts in November following each school year. The staff and student data is gathered from elirollment and staff reports submitted by each school distict annually, in compliance with state and federai requirements. Other background data, such as empioyment statistics and population, are gathered from official state and federal government sources.

The data in this publication are displayed under six major subject headings within each district:

-Background<br>-Operating Revenues and Expenditures<br>-Funding Community Summary<br>-Student Characteristics<br>-Staff Ratios and Statistics<br>-Staff and Student Demographics

The reader should note that the Aleutian East School District is not included in these profiles as it was not an established school district in FY 89. It will be included in next year's report. Corresperdirigly. Sand Point arıd King Cove are included as separate districts in these profiles, which was their status in FY 89 prior to being included in the new Aleutiar, Euzt School District.

## CONTENT

The Profile format is a two page display of data on each of fifty-five districts grouped into six subject headings:
-Background
-Operating Revenues and Expenditures
-Funding Community Sumınaıy
-Siudent Characteristics
-Stall Ratios and Statistics
-Staff and Student Demographics
Preceding the district profiles is a display of state averages and totals in a similar format.

Below is a sample of the format used to report each district's profile. On succeeding pages sections of the profile are enlarged and annotated to facilitate the reader's understanding of the profiles.


## BACKGROUND

The background area at the top of the first page provides backgrouna on each of the school districts. Some items, such as square miles, originate with state sources while others, such as population, oriyinate with the Federal Bureau of the Census.


In those instances where data were not available at the district level, such as unemployment statistics, per capita income, and adulls with a high srhool diploma, the policy has been to use percentages and averages from the region of the state in which the school district is located.

## OPERATING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES

Centrally displayed on the first page ot each district's profile is the 1988-89 audited financial data.

A. The figures displayed are 1988-1989 audited Operati ig Revenues and Operating Expenditures only. These data depict the financial characteristics of each district's general operations and show the costs to operate schools in the district. Audited data are available six months after the close of each school year. The 1989-1990 data will be available in the fall of 1990 and will form the basis oi next year's report.
B. The totals do not include federal supplemental grant funds or restricted use funds such as the Migrant Program, Chapter I, or Handicapped Program funds, because these funds are supplemental to a district's normal operations and are restricted in their use.
C. Those districts reporting revenue fund "translers" have had those sums included in the "Dther (State)" revenue category.
D. City and borough district "Tuition" totals areincluded as "Other (State)" revenue.
E. The " $\$$ per ADM" column represents Average Daily Membership in grades K - 12 only. Districts that included expenditures for pre-elementary or other students outsides these grades are not being given credit in the ADM for the numbers of those students. Therefore, expenditures per student in those districts are slightly inflated.

A detailec' description of each of the Revenue and Expenditure categories, can be found in the glossa:y following the profile series, beginning on page 123.

## FUNLING COMMUNITY SUMMARY

Funding Communities are financial reporting agencies set up under the Alaska Administrative Code as part of the Public School Foundation Program.


In this section of the report, district operated correspondence study programs are listed as separate Funding Communities, so that their enrollments could be shown accurately. However, according to state law, Centralized Correspond nnce Programs are assigned to the attendance center with the highest Average Daily Membership. Accordingly, the total count of funding communities appearing in the "Background" section does not include the correspondence programs.

## STUDENT CH\&.RACTERISTICS

Student data are reported in several different ways.

A. The Average Daily Membership number at the top of the second page of the profile may differ from the total enrollment listed in the previous Funding Community Jummary section. Average Daily Membership (ADM) is based on an average of counts taken each day over a prescribed twenty day period while enrollment is a single day count.
B. Poverty level data are not universally available for all districts. Most poverty data is obtained from the number of students who qualfied for the Federal Government's free and reduced luncin program. When a Districı did not participate, a poverty estimate was obtained, if available, from the Department of Education Chapter I records.
C. The item "Special Nzeas" is a total of those studenis reported by the districts in three classifications: "Resources", "Sell Contained", or "Intensive".
D. Vocational Education is offered only in grades nine throingh twelve and consequently, is shown as a percentage of the enrollment for those four grades only.

## STAFF RATIOS AND STATISTICS

Centrally displayed on the second page are ratios ar.d stalistics relating to the district and scinool staff.

A. Staff totals are cisplayed as Full Time Equivalents (FTE). Often a slaff member will work part time in some positions which result in some FTE numbers appearing as fractions, even in such areas as sex and ethnicity.
B. The definition of "full time" may vary from district to district, particularly for Instructional Aides. For example, some districts detine a work day as a five and a half hour day while others deline a work day as an eight hour day.

## STAFF AND STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS


A. The combination of student and staff demographics includes a category "Not identified" which refers to the unavailability of ethnic information for these individuals.
B. The student demographics shownhyre, under the column "Student Enrollment" are head counts, while the "Total" is Full Time Equivalents. Therefore there may be slight variations in totals.
C. The term "District Administrators and Specialists" includes Superintendents and A.ssistant Superiniendents, as well as other staff such as counselors and librarians who provide support services.

Beginning on page 123 is a glossary of terms lis ted in alphabetical order. Thereader is encouraged to reler to this glossary for additional explanation of data elements included in these profiles.

## METHODOLOGY

All data gathered for this publication were either submitted to the Department of E'ucation in official reports from the school districts, or in the case of background information, taken from reporis published by official State and Federal sources. Therefore, this data base is a compendium of data originally gathered elsewhere and brought together for this display.

Columns containing parcentages aave been computed from the figures provided to the Department by the school cistricts, but may not total $100 \%$ due to rounding.

Not every district participates in every program displayed here. Therefore, some districts have areas of blank dala fieids, which indicates elther the district does not participate in the program or did not report the particular data.

## GLOSSARY OF TERMS

## Adminhotrative Expendifures

This category includes such hems as sqlaries for support slaff, communications, some employee benelits and travel.

## Adulte with High School Diploma

The U.S.Bureau of Census publishes this data as "\% of persons 25 and over compleling lour years High School or more", from the 1980 Census. The Stale Department ol Labor's mostrecent estimpies indicate that Alaska's statewide high school completion rete may now be as high as $90.5 \%$.

## All Teachers

This term relers to a summary of those certiled teachers in remedial or consulting roles to meet special needs ol students, linerant teachers rivisiting feachers and regutar classroom teachers. Information reported is based upon full time equivalents.

## Area Cost Dhferential

A ratio adjusting for the differing costs of operation between the various school districts, as coclified in $1987 \mathrm{ir}, \mathrm{A} \mathrm{S}$ 14.17.051.

## Aftendance Cenfers

Attendance Centers are defined in Alaska Education Regufations as "a school operaled by a district, serving one or more grade levels of students..." (4 AAC 09.105).

## Bllingualsicultural Students

The number ol students who are determined by a district to be billnguad as required by Alaska Slate Regulation 4 AAC 34.050 and reported to the Department of Education in early November of each year.

## Bullding Administratore

Generally the Principals and Assistant Principals. This category also includes a pro-rata portion of those staff categorized as Head Teachers. Their numbers are reported to the Deperiment of Education in the Siafi Accounting Report due to the Depertment of Education by October 15 of each year.

## Chapter I Prog. 3m Studente

Students enrolled in a program to meet the needs of economically deprived and underachieving children, of il neglected or delinquent chictren. Their numbers are reported by individual districts by the end ol each fiscal year.

## Claseroom Teachers

A regular, certified classroom instructor with attendant duties as described in the instructions lor the Stafl Accounting Report due to Department ol Education Irom each District by October 15 ol each year. Inlormarion reported is based upon full time equivalents.

## District Administrators and Speciallots

School district officials and special services personnel such as counselors and itbrarians, involved in operating and supporting the schools. These data are reported to the Department of Education hy October 15 ol each year in the Siaff Accounting Report.

## Electlon District

The Stale ol Alaska is divided into fourieen Senste election districts and fwenty-seven House election disthids creating seats lor lerty Stato Representalives erid Iwenty State Senators.

## Foundation Revenues

Those revenues accruing to the school district frem the State Government and based on a lormula which guarantees each district $\$ 60,000$ per instructional unti, taking into consideration Federal sources, local contributions and area cost cifferentials. instructional Units are delined In Alaska Stalutes 14.17.041-47. These dala are available from District audis as submitted to the Department in early November of each year.

## Funding Communilies

Each school district is divided into lunding communities, which are financial reporting entities as defined by Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) Titte 409.005 which gives consideration to centralizalion and to age and grade levels involved In this report, district operated correspondence study programs are listed as separate Funding Communities although according to state law they are assigned to the attendance cenler with the highest Average Daily Membership. The tolal count of tunding communities appearing in the Background section does not inchude the correspondence programs.

## Gifted/Tatented Siudents

Those studenis identified as exceptional, as defined in AS 14.30.350, and warranting special advanced insiruction, as required in 4 AAC 52.140 and reported for Foundation funding.

## Governance

Alaska is comprised of a mixture ol governing bodies, all of which aflect the school districts There are eleven Organized Boroughs, three Unilied Home Rule Municipalities, one hundred forty. seven Incorporated Communilies and iwenty-one Reglonal Education Attendance Areas.

## High School Graduafes

Those students receiving a High School Diploma or a certificale ol completion during the school year.

## Inatructional Aldes

These are classitied personnel in teaching assistance roles, and these numbers include those positions lunded by supplemental grants and restricted use funds. They are reported to the Department of Education in the Classitied Staff Report due on October 15 of each year.

## Insfruclional Expendifurea

Instructional Expendilures include those expenditures for: Regular Instruction, Vocational Education, Correspondence Study, Special Education, GMed and Talenied Educalion and Bilingual-Bicultural Education. This calegory excludes categorical furnts restricted in use.

## Instructional Unifs

This basic unit ol measure upon which the Stale School Foundation Program funding is based is calculaled Irom student Average Daily Membership identilied for grade lavels K through 12, with additional weighling for vocational, special education, gifeditatented and billingual programs, according to AS 14.17.041-47.

## Local Sourcea Revenue

The city and borough school districts are, under State law, required to contribule the lesser amount ol: (1) the equivalent of tunds gererated by a four mill lax levy based on the full and true value of the taxable real and personal property in the school district; or (2) 35 percent of a school district's basic need from the preceding school year. These data aie available from the District auctits submitted by individual districls to the Department in November e! sacil year.

## MIgrant Educallon Students

Studenis whose education has been disruDted by physical displacement, as defined by federal program regulations. Districts report to the State Program Director each fiscal year.

## Nallve Corporallons

There are twelve privalə Regional Nalive Corporations. They were created in 1971 by the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act.

## Gperationa and Malntenance Expenses

Operations and Maintenance ol Plant expenses includes such items as electric, janitorial services, painling and repairs.

## Other Expendifures

Those expenditures not classified in the above mentioned accounts which included Community Services, Fund Translers and Pupil Activities.

## Oiher (Federal) Reveriue

That Federal Revenue other than PL 874 revenue, such as indirect cost revenue for adrninistration of granis, as described in the Chart of Accounts and reported by the districts, in their annual audit to the Slate Department of Educalion in earty November of each year.

## Other (State) Revenue

State : evenues which cannol be classified in the nine other state revenue categories as described in the Chart oi Accounts and include suchilems as legislative grants, etc. These data arereported by the districts in their annual audits received by the Department of Education in early November of each year.

Por Caplfa Income
The U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis esimates per capita income data in April, using U S. Census Bureau population estimates lor the population component and income data from the Intemal Revenue Service and other wage and salary inlormation sources, such as the Current Population Survey and economic models. Census area per cepila income levels have been applied to the school district level where necessary. Current information ls a derivative of 1980 census data.

Percent of ADM
Percent ol Average Daily Membership is derived by dividing the Full Time Equivalent student numbers for that calegory of service by the Average Dally Membership.

## PL-874 Revenue

Federal Law PL.-674, Impact Aid to Education, provides federal funds to schoot districts for children of parents living and/or working on federal property as an "in lieu of local tax revenue". Including land conveyed to Native Corporations under the Alaska Native Claims Settiement Act. Undit Federal law the State may deduct aportion of these revenues from the State's aid to school districts so long as the Siate insures equality in funding to all students across the state. These data are available from the District's auclit submitted by each indivichal district to the Department in November of each year.

## Populatton

The Stale Department oi Labor generates population estimates annually in Seplember, based upon the 1980 U.S.Census, and modified by such sources as school enrollments, internal Revenue Service, migration data, Vital Statistics and Alaska Permanem Fund data.

## Poverty Level Students

The number of students who quatfied for the lederal toee and reduced hunch program, as reported to the State Department of Education in November. Because not all districts choose to participate in the program. a poverty estimate oblained from Departrient of Education Chapter I records is used, when availabie, for non-participants, and in some cases supplemented by best estimates supplied by the disirict.

## Pupll staff Ratlo

This number is compuled by dividing the student Average Daily Membership by the number of Full Time Equivalent positions in each category, as reported to the Department in the Siaff Accounting Report.
