ABSTRACT

This bibliography contains 126 entries of written materials available from the National Agricultural Library's (NAL) AGRICOLA database pertaining to agricultural or rural leadership. Each entry includes bibliographical information and the NAL call number, while some also include abstracts. All the listed materials, including books, reports, studies, and so forth, are in English. Cited materials include information on leadership development, leadership guides, rural extension, social issues, rural government, and community development. The document also gives ordering information and an author index. All the listed citations were entered in the database between January 1979 and December 1988.
