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ABSTRACT

The school-year and annual dropout counts for high schools in the Austin (Texas) Independent School District are summarized for the past 7 years, 1983-84 through 1989-90, and for grades 7 and 8 for the past 6 years. Also reported are the current status of entering ninth graders of 1983-84 through 1989-90, and of the entering seventh graders of 1984-85 through 1989-90. Overall, the 1989-90 annual high school dropout rate (10%) was the lowest in 7 years, with Hispanics (14%) and Whites (6.3%) having the lowest rates for the period, and Blacks having the highest rate (12.8%) for the last 7 years. The junior high school dropout rate (5.5%) was the lowest in the past 6 years for every ethnic group except American Indians. As of October 1990, 25.4% of the students who entered the ninth grade for the first time in 1986-87 had dropped out. This rate for the class of 1990 was lower than that of the four preceding classes. Four-year dropout rates for the 1986-87 entering cohort were lowest for Whites at 20% and highest for American Indians at 36.4%, with 20.2% for Asians, 28.1% for Blacks, and 33.1% for Hispanics. The 1988-89 cohort of first-time seventh graders had the lowest dropout rate (7.0%) of the four cohorts being tracked. Forty-seven figures provide specific dropout information. 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DEFINITIONS

1) Dropout:

A student is reported as a dropout for a school year if the individual is absent for a period of 30 or more consecutive school days without approved excuse or documented transfer, or fails to reenroll by September 15 of the following school year without completion of a high school program.

2) Cross-sectional rates:

Percentage of all students in a given grade span who drop out within a specified time frame.

a) School-year rate:

The percentage of students who drop out of school during the school year; e.g., from September 1, 1989 to June 1, 1990.

b) Annual rate:

The percentage of students who drop out of school during a single year; e.g., from September 1, 1989 to September 1, 1990.

3) Longitudinal rate:

The percentage of students who drop out of school from a single group (cohort) when followed over a period of several years; e.g., a dropout rate as based on the percentage of students who enter grade 9 in 1984-85 but drop out prior to graduating from grade 12.

4) Cohort:

A single group; e.g., all students who entered 7th grade for the first time in 1989-90.

1989-90 DROPOUT REPORT

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

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The Office of Research and Evaluation (ORE) annually summarizes AISD's dropout statistics for grades 7-12. This report contains the school-year and annual dropout counts for high school for the past seven years, 1983-84 through 1989-90, and for grades 7-8 for the past six years, 1984-85 through 1989-90. Also reported are the current statuses of the entering ninth graders of 1983-84 through 1989-90, and of the entering seventh graders of 1984-85 through 1989-90.

- Overall the 1989-90 high school annual dropout rate (10.0%) is the lowest in seven years. Hispanics (14.0%) and Whites (6.3%) had the lowest rates in seven years. However, Blacks had the highest rate (12.8%) in the last seven years.
- The 1989-90 7th-8th grade annual dropout rate (5.5%) is the lowest in the last six years. This year's rate was the lowest for each ethnic group, except American Indian.
- The group who entered ninth grade for the first time in 1986-87 has now been followed for four complete years. As of October, 1990, 25.4% of this group has dropped out. The 25.4% four-year rate for the class of '90 is the lowest of the last four classes.
- The four-year dropout rate for American Indians from the 1986-87 cohort is 36.4%, for Hispanics 33.1%, for Blacks 28.1%, for Asians 20.2%, and for Whites 20.0%.
- Four cohorts of first-time seventh graders have been tracked. The 1988-89 cohort's two-year dropout rate (7.0%) is the lowest of the four cohorts being tracked.

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INTRODUCTION

WHAT IS AISD'S DROPOUT RATE?

There may be no question more frequently asked about AISD by students, newspaper and television reporters, university professors, staff from outside agencies, researchers, and the general public than this one: "What is AISD's dropout rate?" This is a question for which there are several different--and correct--answers, depending on the context the inquirer has in mind.

Some high school examples may help clarify these differences.

- If someone wants to know how many high school students drop out during a school year, then that number is typically around 10-12% and is called the school year dropout rate.
- If someone wants to know how many students drop out during the standard four years of high school, then that number is typically around 25 to 30% and is called the longitudinal rate.
- Because educators and the public ask their questions about dropout rates in many different ways, there are many more than these two definitions of dropout rate.

The Office of Research and Evaluation (ORE) calculates a school-year dropout rate, an annual rate, and a longitudinal rate for grades 9-12 and for grades 7-8. These rates are calculated overall and for each ethnic group. The school-year dropout rate is the rate for students who dropped out during the nine-month school year from September to June. The annual rate is the rate for those students who dropped out during the entire twelve-month period from September to September. The annual rate adds in the summer dropouts but also subtracts those school-year dropouts who transferred, graduated, or returned to school at the end of summer.

The longitudinal rate is probably the rate that most inquirers have in mind when they ask for a dropout rate. It is the rate of students who drop out over their high school career. It is calculated by tracking the students individually from the time they first enter ninth (or seventh) grade over a period of years. Although it may not be immediately apparent, the sum of the annual rates is not equal to the longitudinal rate. The cross-sectional annual rate is calculated across multiple grades. The longitudinal rate is calculated for a single grade across time.

The Office of Research and Evaluation has been monitoring AISD's dropout situation and publishing an annual report since 1983-84. During that time the methods, time frames, cohort definitions, or some combination of these factors has changed annually as we have learned more about the complexities of counting dropouts. Although our numbers have steadily gained accuracy and meaning as a result, we have paid a price in year-to-year comparability, a fact which has been frustrating to us and to the community at large. We think it has been worth it, and that we now have a counting and reporting system that will serve us well for the foreseeable future, although state requirements resulting from House Bill 1010 may cause further changes. (For a full discussion of the issues which must be considered in counting dropouts and the evolution of AISD'S approach see "Counting Dropouts, It's Enough to Make You Want to Quit Too!," ORE Pub. No. 86.39.)

This report provides a brief historical perspective of our dropout reporting as well as dropout rates for six school years, 1983-84 through 1989-90. This is the fourth year to calculate annual dropout numbers as of October 1, in order to include summer dropouts, summer transfers, and summer graduates. For the purposes of comparison this report also includes the school-year dropout numbers as of July 1, as they have been calculated for the previous six years.

This is also the fourth year to calculate the high school longitudinal dropout rate based on a cohort of each year's entering ninth graders. With this method, retainees--a group particularly likely to drop out--are not counted in more than one cohort of ninth graders. No student is counted in more than one group. (For a full discussion of this issue see "1986-87 Dropout Report" Pub. No. 87.M01.)

DEFINITION AND METHOD

The definition of a dropout has not changed. A dropout is a student who has withdrawn from AISD and whose records have not been requested by another school or district.

In July, 1986, a longitudinal computerized database (the Secondary Student Longitudinal File, or SSLF) was constructed that enables us to answer questions about the enrollment status of any group of students at any point in time, beginning with the 1983-84 school year for high school students and the 1985-86 school year for seventh and eighth graders.

Our method for assigning dropout status codes is as follows:

- Each year's cohort includes all students enrolled in an AISD high school at any time during the school year.
- Any student who withdraws from AISD is first considered a dropout.
- If the student's records are requested by a district, school, or other institution offering a high school diploma, the student is judged to be pursuing an education and his/her classification is changed from "dropout" to "transfer."
- In the fall following each school year, a dropout status is assigned to each student on the file. Possible statuses are:
 - Currently enrolled as of September 15.
 - School-year dropout (withdrew during a school year, with no records request by the end of the first six weeks).
 - School-year transfer (withdrew, records requested).
 - Graduated.
 - Died (while a student, not after dropping out).
 - Summer dropout (completed a school year, but did not enroll in the fall by September 15, and no records requested by the end of the first six weeks).
 - Summer transfer (completed a school year, did not enroll in fall, records requested.)
- The annual dropout rate is calculated by dividing the total number of dropouts (school year plus summer) by the total enrollment. This can be done for any subgroup of interest.

COUNTING 7th-8th GRADE DROPOUTS

ORE has reported annual dropout rates for grades 7-8 for several years, but we have always urged that they be interpreted very cautiously because we doubted their accuracy. The problem is that junior high schools do not always request transcripts for their incoming students, probably because graduation credits are not an issue at that level. Hence, the number of students in grades 7-8 counted as transfers may be lower than the actual number of transfers, possibly resulting in an unreliably high dropout rate.

During 1986-87 steps were taken to assess the extent of this problem and to increase the accuracy of the 7th-8th grade numbers. After the extent of the problem was assessed, the first step taken was to emphasize to the schools that a written request for any records, not just a transcript, constituted valid evidence that the student was enrolled and should be reported to ORE. The second step was to supply the junior high schools (and now middle schools) with postcards to give to students who withdrew. The student was to be told to give the card to an official at the school in which he or she enrolled. The official was to indicate that the student had enrolled, sign and date the card, and mail it to the student's former school. It was hoped that this would reduce the "false dropout" rate. (For a full discussion of this issue see the 1986-87 Dropout Report Pub. No. 87.M01.)

DOCUMENTATION OF STUDENT TRANSFER OUT OF DISTRICT

Until 1988-89 an official transcript request was the only accepted evidence that a high school student was attending a school outside the district. An official transcript request or a written request for any records was evidence that a grade 7 or 8 student was attending a school outside the District.

During the 1988-89 school year, under Texas Education Agency (TEA) guidelines, two additional methods of documenting a student's transfer out of the District were approved. The new methods are:

1. A parent's signed statement of intent to enroll the student outside of the District.
2. Confirmation of the student's transfer out of the District obtained by an AISD school official.

Two new forms were developed in response to the guidelines, and the previously used postcard was revised. (For further information see Documentation of Student Transfer Outside of District, ORE Publication Letter 88.K.)

The total amount of documentation received by ORE for student transfers has increased considerably during the last two years compared with the previous year. The increase was most noticeable for the summer transfers.

Of the total pieces of documentation received during 1988-89, there were 1,712 student transfers documented by methods other than official transcript requests. These represent gains in the number of students for whom we can document transfer and students for whom we may not have been able to obtain documentation in previous years. There were an additional 420 students who had an official transcript request plus additional documentation. It is quite likely that the official request for transfer came as a result of the use of the other methods of documenting transfer.

There were 3,962 (unduplicated count) documentations of student transfer out of AISD. Of those, 2,250 were requests for official transfers. In addition there were 1,712 documentations other than official transfer request.

HIGH SCHOOL DROPOUT RATES

SCHOOL-YEAR DROPOUT RATES

Although the numbers available in July are necessarily incomplete and inadequate, to give a sense of the trend across time, Figure 2 shows the school-year dropout rate for the 1989-90 school year using the old July cutoff date for transcript requests, compared to the six previous years. By this measure the school-year rate was the lowest since 1983-84.

A lower rate among Whites accounted for most of the decline from 1988-89 to 1989-90. The rate for Blacks increased 21% from 10.2% to 12.9%. The rate for American Indians was about half of any rate in the previous six years.

As of July of the Following Summer



ANNUAL DROPOUT RATES

Figure 3 shows the high school annual dropout rates by ethnicity as of October of the following year for the past seven school years. While the overall rate in 1989-90 was the lowest since 1983-84, Blacks had the highest rate in seven years. The overall high school annual dropout rate in 1989-90 was the lowest of the last seven years.

For the first time the annual rate was lower than the school-year rate. The decline in the number of summer dropouts from 743 to 608, a decrease of 18.2%, accounted for most of the decrease in the annual rate.

Figure 4a shows the dropout rates for 1988-89 high school students, broken down by ethnicity, sex, grade, and by time of dropping out. Note that from the October perspective, the number of school-year dropouts declined 556 students from 1,787 to 1,231 (reflecting returners and late records requests), but that another 743 left during the summer.

Since the number leaving during the summer (743) was more than the number of September returns and transfers (556), the annual rate (11.2%) was higher than the school-year rate of 10.2%.

Figure 4b shows the dropout rates for 1989-90 high school students, broken down by ethnicity, sex, grade, and by time of dropping out. Note that from the October perspective, the number of school-year dropouts declined 624 students from 1,764 to 1,140 (reflecting returners and late records requests), but that another 608 left during the summer.

Since the number leaving during the summer (608) was less than the number of September returns and transfers (624), the annual rate (10.0%) was lower than the school-year rate of 10.1%.

Figure 4c displays further information about the dropouts. The majority of dropouts in grades 9-12 were not LEP (89.6%), not special education (82.0%) and not low income (63.3%). If the dropouts were LEP students, they were more likely to be served LEP (6.4%) than LEP denials (4.0%). If the dropouts were special education students, they were more likely to receive services three or more hours a day (14.8%) than less than three hours (2.2%).

Figure 4d displays the proportion of groups that dropped out. Students that were LEP dropped out at a rate that was about twice that for nonLEP students. Special education students were about twice as likely to drop out if receiving services three or more hours a day than if receiving services less than three hours a day. Low income students dropped out at a rate about twice that of students who were not low income.




Figures 4e and 4f display the 1989-90 school-year and annual dropout rates by grade level and by ethnicity. Inspection reveals that the decrease in 1989-90 from the school-year rate to the annual rate came as a result of more returns or transfers and fewer summer dropouts. The Asians, eleventh and twelfth grades, lost more students over the summer than returned or transferred.

THE LONGITUDINAL DROPOUT RATES

We now have four cohorts beginning with 1983-84 who entered ninth grade and have been followed for four complete years.

Of the 4,767 students in the cohort who entered ninth grade during the 1983-84 school year: 2,637 (55.3%) have graduated from AISD, 852 (17.9%) have transferred to other districts and not returned, 5 (0.1%) are still enrolled as of the fall of 1990, 8 (.2%) students have died, and 1,265 (26.5%) have dropped out.

Of the 5,193 students in the cohort who entered ninth grade during the 1984-85 school year: 2,629 (50.6%) have graduated from AISD, 907 (17.5%) have transferred to other districts and not returned, 34 (0.7%) are still enrolled as of the fall of 1990, 7 (.1%) students have died, and 1,616 (31.1%) have dropped out.

Figure 5a shows the dropout rates for these groups in some detail, as well as that of the first-time ninth graders from 1985-86 through 1989-90. The patterns for each ethnic group are also shown separately.

As the figure shows, about 39.5% of the Hispanic first-time ninth graders from 1983-84 have dropped out so far, compared to 41.7% of American Indians, 31.3% of Blacks, 19.8% of Whites, and 18.3% of Asians.

Figures 5b through 5o display by chart and bar graph the enrollment, graduation, death, transfer, and dropout rates as of July for successive years for each cohort of first-time ninth graders. This is the second year for a complete look at each cohort. See Attachment A for a display by chart and bar graph of the enrollment, graduation, death, transfer, and dropout rates as of October for successive years for each cohort of first-time ninth graders.

Figures 6 and 7 show grades 7-8 dropout results for 1989-90. Figure 6 compares previous years' school-year rates with the 1989-90 rate as it appeared in July. As with the high school rates, the July rate is given only for the purpose of comparison with previous years.

As Figure 6 shows, for the third year in a row, there was a decrease compared to the previous year. This may be the result of improved reporting procedures discussed earlier in the report. The 1989-90 rate is the lowest since we began tracking seventh and eighth graders.



ANNUAL DROPOUT RATES

Figure 7 shows the annual dropout rates by ethnicity as of October of the following year for six school years. The overall grade 7-8 annual dropout rate for 1989-90 was the lowest in the last six years. Not only was the overall rate the lowest, the annual rate for each ethnic group, except American Indians, was the lowest in five years.

Figures 8a and 8b show the 7th-8th grade dropout rate for 1988-89 and 1989-90 students with summer included, broken down by ethnicity, sex, grade, and by time of dropping out. In 1989-90, as was also true at high school, the school-year dropout rate as of October is lower than it appeared in July, as students returned in the fall or had their records requested after July. See Figures 4a, 4b, 8a, and 8b.

The annual rates for 1988-89 and 1989-90 were higher than the school-year rates as the number of summer transfers and September returns was more than offset by the number of summer dropouts. This was true for each ethnic group and each grade.

Summer dropouts accounted for 57.8% of all dropouts at the 7th and 8th grades. This contrasts with high school where summer dropouts were 34.8% of the annual dropouts. Eighth graders represented 65% of dropouts for grades seven and eight. The majority (162, 87.6%) of eighth-grade summer dropouts were promoted but did not enroll in high school by September 15, 1990.

Figure 8c displays further information about the dropouts. The majority of dropouts in grades 7-8 were not LEP (87.2%), not special education (84.5%) and were low income (62.9%). Of the dropouts who were LEP students, there were four times as many served LEP students as LEP denials. Of the dropouts served by special education, three fourths were served three or more hours a day.

Figure 8d displays the proportion of groups that dropped out. LEP students dropped out at a higher rate than nonLEP students. Special education students served three or more hours a day had a higher dropout rate than nonspecial education students. However, special education students served less than three hours a day had a lower dropout rate than nonspecial education students., Low income students were twice as likely to dropout out as students who were not low income.




Figures 8e and 8f display the 1989-90 school-year and annual dropout rates by grade level and by ethnicity. Inspection reveals that the increase in 1989-90 from the school-year to the annual rate came from all ethnic groups and from grades 7-8.

LONGITUDINAL DROPOUT RATES

In 1985-86 junior high schools were added to the longitudinal data collection system. We now have five years' longitudinal data to report for 7th-8th grade students.

As Figure 9a shows, for first-time seventh graders of 1985-86, the overall dropout rate is 21.4% as of October, 1990; it is 30.6% for Hispanics, 27.3% for American Indians, 22.3% for Blacks, 15.6% for Whites, and 10.5% for Asians. Longitudinal dropout rates of cohorts of first-time seventh graders are now reported annually.

Figures 9b through 9k display by chart and bar graph the enrollment, graduation, death, transfer, and dropout rates as of July for successive years for each cohort of first-time ninth graders. This is the second year for a complete look at each cohort. See Attachment B for a display by chart and bar graph of the enrollment, graduation, death, transfer, and dropout rates as of October for successive years for each cohort of first-time ninth graders.





PUBLIC EDUCATION INFORMATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (PEIMS)

This is the second year of the new mandatory statewide data collection system. Dropout numbers are part of that data submission. On the following pages are the calculations of the dropout rate from the PEIMS data submission and the numbers submitted to PEIMS for AISD. PEIMS uses a different cutoff date for reenrollment in the fall after a student has dropped out the previous school year and also uses a later date for transcript requests to be received; therefore, the PEIMS dropout numbers will vary from those given earlier in this report.

There were 2,639 dropouts reported for 1987-88. This year, 1989-90, there are 2,019 dropouts. There has been a decline of 336 dropouts or a 14.3% decrease from last year.
