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ABSTRACT

In October 1992, Western Nebraska Community College (WNCC) surveyed all 173 students who had graduated between June 1991 and July 1992 to determine their current educational and employment status and their perceptions of WNCC. Completed surveys were received from 130 graduates, for a response rate of 75%. Study findings included the following: (1) 55% were employed, 33% were continuing their education, 8% were attending school and working, and 2% were seeking employment; (2) 69% believed they had achieved their educational objectives at WNCC, while another 23% had partially achieved their objectives; (3) 90% felt that their WNCC experiences had improved the quality of their lives; (4) 81% indicated that they would recommend WNCC to friends and family; (5) of the 6 unemployed graduates, only 2 were actually seeking employment; (6) among the 43 graduates continuing their education, 72% were attending school in Nebraska; (7) 69% of these students were satisfied or very satisfied with the transfer process; (8) of the 71 employed graduates, 82% were working full-time and 87% were working in a related field, earning an average wage of \$7.54 per hour; (9) 66% of employed graduates expressed satisfaction with their current job; (10) among the 10 graduates who were working and studying, 6 were continuing their studies in-state; (11) 50% of these graduates were employed full-time and 70% were working in a related field earning an average hourly wage of \$8.03; and (12) 80% of these graduates were satisfied with their current job. Findings for the two WNCC campuses, the survey instruments, and a list of graduates employers are included. (KP)

Analysis of 1991-1992 WNCC Graduates

Summary

A follow-up survey was conducted of all 173 WNCC students who graduated between June 1, 1991 and July 31, 1992. The 130 completed surveys (response rate 75%) were analyzed and the results are summarized as follows:

■ Graduate Placement

■ Graduates' Academic Perception of WNCC

- ▶ The majority of graduates surveyed in this study (69%) believed that they completely achieved their educational objectives at WNCC, while another 23% perceived they partially achieved their objectives.
- ▶ Approximately 90% of the graduates perceived that their WNCC experiences had improved the quality of their lives.
- ▶ Eighty-one percent of the graduates would recommend their family and acquaintances attend WNCC.

■ Analysis of Graduates' Status

▶ *Unemployed Graduates*

- Of the 6 unemployed graduates, only 2 are seeking employment; the rest of them are unavailable for work due to personal and family factors.

▶ *Transferred Graduates*

- Among the 43 graduates who are continuing their college studies, 72% are going to school in Nebraska and 26% are attending out-of-state institutions.

- Almost three-fourths of them appeared to be very satisfied or satisfied with the transfer process.


▶ *Employed Graduates*

- Of the 71 employed graduates, 82% of them are working full-time and the majority of them (87%) are working in a related field, earning an average wage of \$7.54 per hour.
- The majority of employed graduates (66%) expressed satisfaction with their current job. Another 20% had no opinion.


▶ *Working and Studying Graduates*

- Six out of 10 graduates in this category are continuing their studies at in-state institutions.
- The majority of them (90%) appeared to be satisfied with the transfer process.
- Among the 10 graduates in this group, half of them are employed full-time and 70% of them are working in a related field earning an average hourly wage of \$8.03.
- Eighty percent of them are satisfied with their current job.






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Analysis of 1991-1992 WNCC Graduates

Graduate follow-up surveys were sent out in October of 1992 by Student Support Services Staff to all 173 WNCC students who graduated between June 1, 1991 and July 31, 1992. Sixty-one surveys (35%) were returned and 69 nonrespondents (40%) were followed up by telephone interview, which brought the total return rate to 75%. It is noted that a few telephone interviews were conducted through relatives of the students since those students had moved out of the area.

The data gathered from the returned surveys and telephone interviews (75% response rate) were analyzed and are presented in the following three sections. Data regarding graduate award broken down by campus are summarized in Table 1.



Placement Data of 1991-1992 WNCC Graduates

Out of 130 graduates who responded to the follow-up survey, 71 of them (55%) are currently employed, 43 graduates (33%) are continuing their studies, 10 graduates (8%) are continuing their studies while working, and only 6 graduates (5%) are unemployed. Among those 6 unemployed graduates, only two of them are actively seeking employment. The rest of them are unavailable for employment due to personal and family reasons such as pregnancy, moving, etc.

Section II

Graduates' Academic Perceptions of WNCC

Graduates' Academic Perceptions of WNCC

Graduates surveyed in this follow-up study were asked to respond to several questions regarding their academic perception of WNCC. A copy of the follow-up survey is presented in Appendix A. The analysis of the graduates' responses is as follows:

Q: *Did you achieve your educational objective at WNCC?*

Of the 130 graduates who responded to the follow-up survey, the majority (69%) indicated that they completely achieved their educational objectives at WNCC. Almost another one-fourth (23%) also believed they achieved some of their educational objectives at WNCC. There is only one graduate who responded No. The brief explanation was given as "Sorry Program". A few students (8%) chose not to respond to the question.

Q: Do you feel your WNCC experiences have improved the quality of your life, regardless of the financial benefit?

The majority of graduates (90%) who responded to the survey appeared to agree that their WNCC experiences had improved the quality of their lives, while very few of the other graduates (3%) disagreed. About 4% were not quite certain whether their WNCC experiences did improve the quality of their lives, and very few students (2%) chose not to express their opinion in this regard.

Q: Would you recommend attending WNCC to your family and acquaintances?

The majority of graduates in this survey study (81%) would recommend that their family members and acquaintances attend WNCC, a few graduates (7%) were not quite sure, and a small number (4%) said No. The reason why not was not elicited in this survey.

Section III

Analysis of 1991-1992 Graduates by Status

Analysis of 1991-1992 Graduates by Status

After the graduates who participated in this study identified their current status (Unemployed, Continuing College Study, Currently Employed, or Working While Attending College), they were asked a few questions to further elaborate about their status (see Appendix A, Section II, and Section III). The responses of graduates in each of the groups were then analyzed and are presented in the following sections:

Analysis of Unemployed Graduates (N=6)

Of the six unemployed graduates who responded to the follow-up survey (5%), three of them graduated from the Scottsbluff Campus and the other three from Sidney. Their responses regarding their unemployed status are as follows:

Almost three-fourths (74%) of the transferred graduates appeared to be very satisfied or satisfied with the transfer process. A few (16%) did not give opinions or responses and about 9% expressed dissatisfaction. It is noted that the percentage of unsatisfied transferred graduates (9%) decreased from the previous year (12%).

Analysis of Employed Graduates (N=71)

The employed graduates responded to several questions asked in the survey as follows:

Q: *Which of the following best describes your current employment situation?*

The majority of employed graduates (66%) in this study appeared to be highly satisfied or satisfied with their current job. A few of them (20%) did not give an opinion or a response. It is interesting that among those 6 employed graduates who expressed dissatisfaction with their current jobs, only two of them are working in non-related jobs and most of them earn a decent wage (\$5.00-8.00). Further analysis of these six employed graduates showed that all of them believe they achieved their educational objectives at WNCC and all but one also believe that their WNCC experiences have improved the quality of their lives. It appeared, therefore, that their dissatisfaction toward their jobs has nothing to do with their preparation and experiences at WNCC.
