ABSTRACT

Statistical information is presented regarding high school graduates in Tennessee. Data are presented in a state summary table that includes numbers of schools and of graduates, number of students continuing education, and the percentage of students continuing education. The state table is followed by tables for the 95 counties presented alphabetically. The information is based on a survey of public and accredited private schools that enroll high school students. Over 7% of graduates attended private schools. Of this group, approximately 95.7% expected to continue their education, while approximately 61.7% of public school graduates expected to continue. The overall percentage of 1992 graduates expecting to continue their educations, 64.3%, is 3 1% higher than that of 1991. More urban than rural students expected to continue. Dropout figures as counted by many schools might include students who transferred to other schools. Population figures noted are preliminary 1990 census estimates. An appendix lists the 1991 labor force estimates by county. (SLD)

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this publication is to provide statistical information regarding high school graduates to planners, educators, and employers in Tennessee. The data in High School Graduates are presented in a state summary table followed by county tables presented alphabetically.

The study is based on a survey of public and accredited private schools in Tennessee that have high school students enrolled. Each table lists the number of schools and response rates as well as the number of graduates, their education and work plans, and the number of dropouts. An appendix has been included giving 1991 labor force estimates by county.

A special thanks is extended to school administrators and counselors who took time to answer this survey. Their cooperation will benefit the educators, employers, and planners across the state who will use this publication.

HIGHLIGHTS

Tennessee's 1991-92 graduating class attended the state's 358 public and accredited private high schools. There are four state special schools (see page 9), such as those schools for blind and deaf persons. Schools for emotionally and mentally handicapped persons and the Department of Youth Development schools were not included in the survey.

Over seven percent (7.5 percent) of the 1992 graduates attended accredited private schools. In general, a far higher percentage of graduates from private schools (95.7 percent) intend to continue their education than graduates from public schools (61.7 percent). More graduates from city schools than graduates from county schools indicated that they will continue their education (71.2 percent and 59.3 percent respectively). The overall percentage of 1992 graduates continuing their education (64.3 percent) is 3.1 percent higher than the results of the 1991 survey.

A 97.2 percent response rate was achieved in this year's High School Survey. The figures are not absolute measures; they represent the intentions of the 1991-92 graduates. All data in this publication are preliminary accounts.

Graduates who did not fit into the categories of continuing their education, entering the labor force, or entering the armed forces are listed in the category of "other." Sub-categories may not add to total graduates because of persons falling into more than one category.

N/A represents "not applicable" and is used where no such schools existed.

Dropouts are students who have left school before obtaining their high school diploma and do not plan to continue their education at the present time. Although the survey requested the number of dropouts, many schools subtracted the number of students at the end of the year from the number at the beginning of the year. This methodology could include students who transferred to or from another school and could give inaccurate data.

State and county population figures noted in the tables are preliminary 1990 census population estimates from the Bureau of the Census.
