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ABSTRACT

A study was conducted to evaluate student and student employer satisfaction with the services provided by the South Seattle Community College (SSCC) Cosmetology Department. Specifically, the study gathered data related to four outcomes: that students receive an educational experience allowing them to meet their goals; that former and current students be satisfied with facilities, equipment, and the quality of instruction; that employers be satisfied with graduates; and that customers of the Department's Beauty Center be satisfied with services. Findings for the first outcome indicated that 77% of employed former students were working in cosmetology or a related field and 100% passed a state licensing test within their first two attempts. Responses related to the second outcome indicated that over 50% of former students were satisfied to a high extent with facilities; 59% reported that the number of teachers was inadequate; and 86% of the current students were satisfied with the content of instruction, while 46% were least satisfied with their ability to apply their skills. Findings regarding outcome three indicated that employers rated SSCC graduates highest in skin care, haircutting, hairstyling, and business practices, and lowest in haircolor and permanent waving. Findings related to the fourth criterion indicated that 95% of respondents have recommended the Beauty Center to others. (Survey instruments are appended.) (MAB)

Executive Summary**

Major Findings related to Criteria

Outcome 1. Students will receive a quality educational experience which will allow them to meet their stated goals.

Criteria 1:

70% of those students whose stated goal is employment will report employment in the field.

80% of those who take the certification/licensing exam will pass.

80% of the students in the program will meet their stated goals.

Findings for Outcome 1:

- 77% of those employed are currently employed in cosmetology or a related field.
- Almost all of the former students (89%) reported taking the licensing exam after they finished the Cosmetology program.
- Of those who took the exam, 92% passed the first time, and the other 8% passed the second time.
- 93% of the respondents indicated that they intended to earn a certificate when they entered, and 89% did complete the program.

Outcome 2. Former students and current students will be satisfied with the facilities and equipment, and the quality of instruction.

Criteria 2:

75% of the respondents to the Former Student Survey and the Current Student Survey will report satisfaction with the facilities and equipment in the program.

75% will report satisfaction with the quality of instruction.

Findings for Outcome 2 for Former Students:

- For six of the seven questions regarding the instructional facilities, over 50% of the former students in Cosmetology rated the facilities as high or very high.
- The only area rated inadequate by the Cosmetology former students was the number of teachers. Only 19% of the former students agreed to a high extent that the number of teachers was adequate; 22% agreed to some extent; and 59% (about 2 out of 3) reported that the number of teachers was inadequate.
- Over the last five years, students have become increasingly more dissatisfied with the number of teachers available in the Cosmetology lab. The percent of students agreeing that the number of teachers was adequate fell from 43% in 1989 and 1990, to 20% in 1991 and 1992, to zero in 1993. For the former students who left in 1993, 90% (9 out of 10), considered the number of teachers inadequate for educational purposes. In the last year, the situation in the lab has worsened, due to increases in the number of students and the number of clients.
- Over 60% of the former students agreed that they were satisfied, to a high extent, with their degree or certificate. Over 50% were satisfied, to a high extent, with the quality of instruction and the quality of their education.

Findings for Outcome 2 for Current Students:

- Over 70% of the current students in the Cosmetology program were satisfied with the supplies available and the equipment. Over 60% were satisfied with the cleanliness of the lab area.
- Current students were most satisfied (86%) with the content of instruction, and least satisfied with their ability to apply the skills they were learning (46%).

Outcome 3. Employers will be satisfied with the graduates of the Cosmetology program.

Criteria 3:

75% of the employers will report that they are satisfied with the SSCC training received by their employees.

Findings for Outcome 3:

Eight salons who had hired SSCC graduates responded to the survey. These salons rated their employees on those skills which were applicable.

- SSCC graduates were rated highest by their employers (90% or more Very Satisfied or Satisfied) in four areas: skin care; haircutting; hairstyling; and business practices. SSCC graduates were rated lowest by their employers on haircolor (57% Satisfied) and permanent waving (71% Satisfied).

Industry representatives were also asked to rate various other employee characteristics besides cosmetology skills.

- All industries (100%) rated workplace values and teamwork as very important. Industries rated computer skills, inventory control, and previous work experience as least important (fewer than 40%) of the salons rating these skills as important.

Outcome 4. Customers of the Beauty Center will receive quality products and services in a cost effective manner.

Criteria 4:

80% of the customers of the Beauty Center will report a high degree of satisfaction with the products and services.

80% of the customers would recommend the retail facility to their friends.

Findings for Outcome 4:

- Over 80% of the customers were very satisfied with five of the eight characteristics of the Beauty Center.
- Customers were most satisfied with the friendliness of the staff (98% very satisfied) and the friendliness of the students (95% very satisfied). Over 80% of the customers were also very satisfied with the cleanliness of the lab area, the cost of services, the reception desk, and the service selection. Customers were least satisfied with the quality of the service (only 67% very satisfied).
- 95% of the respondents have recommended the Beauty Center to others, and all (100%) said they would recommend the Beauty Center to others.
