ABSTRACT

This academic year enrollment report from Johnson County Community College contains summary data for the three semesters comprising the 1994-95 academic year: summer, fall, and spring. The report is used to answer questions concerning credit hours generated during an academic year and to provide data about programs. Data tables included in the report provide academic year 1994-95 information on: (1) student credit hour enrollment, by enrollment status, student status, gender, student level, residence, ethnic category, and educational objective; (2) student headcount enrollment, by enrollment status, student status, gender, student level, residence, ethnic category, and educational objective; (3) student credit hours by age group and semester; (4) average student credit load by age group and semester; and (5) student credit hour enrollment by division/course prefix and semester for the arts, humanities and social sciences division; business, technology and computer instruction division; communications and academic enhancement division; science, health care and math division; physical education division; student development division; and continuing community education division. In addition, the following historical data are provided: student credit hour enrollment by division/course prefix and academic year 1990-91 to 1994-95; headcount enrollment by academic year and semester, 1969-70 to 1994-95; student credit hour enrollment by academic year and semester, 1969-70 to 1994-95; student credit hour enrollment by academic year and sex, 1969-70 to 1994-95; and student credit hour enrollment by academic year and enrollment status, 1969-70 to 1994-95. PREFACE

Two reports detailing Johnson County Community College enrollments are compiled by the Office of Institutional Research each year: the Fall Enrollment Report and the Academic Year Enrollment Report.

The Fall Enrollment Report contains detailed enrollment data for the fall semester. These data should be considered "typical" or benchmark data for reporting demographic information about students and answering such questions as: "How many students are enrolled at JCCC?" or, "What percentage of JCCC students attend full-time?"

The Academic Year Enrollment Report contains summary data for the three semesters that comprise the academic year: summer, fall and spring. This report is more appropriately used to answer questions concerning credit hours generated during an academic year. It also is designed to provide data about programs rather than about student characteristics.

These two reports complement one another and together contain the enrollment data required for most reporting and inquiry purposes.

DEFINITIONS

Enrollment Status

Full-Time Student: A student enrolled in 12 or more credit hours.

Part-Time Student: A student enrolled in less than 12 credit hours.

Headcount Enrollment: An unduplicated count of the number of individual students enrolled.

Student Level

Freshman: A student who had completed less than 26 credit hours at the beginning of the semester.

Sophomore: A student who had completed 26 to 64 credit hours at the beginning of the semester.

Special Student: A student who had completed more than 64 credit hours at the beginning of the semester.
