ABSTRACT

This document is the 16th issue of an annual series of bibliographic work in New Zealand. The first section, "Bibliographical Work in Progress at June 1995," is compiled from a questionnaire mailed to bibliographers who are listed in the 1993 and 1994 issues and who have not since published; and to educational, government, medical, special, and large public libraries in New Zealand. Entries from the 1994 issue for which details have not been re-confirmed are marked. The second section, "Bibliographies Published Since June 1994," is compiled from the following: submissions from librarians and bibliographers, entries in the "New Zealand National Bibliography" (July 1994-June 1995) and "Index New Zealand" (July 1994-June 1995), library accessions lists, and bibliographies received by the University of Waikato Library, as well as a few titles published prior to June 1994 which have not been listed in earlier issues. Entries are listed only once and arranged under the following broad section headings: general bibliographies, special classes of material, and librarianship; philosophy and religion; social sciences; biological and medical sciences; agriculture, forestry and fisheries; engineering, domestic, and applied sciences; arts; recreation and sport; language and literature; geography, history, and area studies; and personal bibliography. A subject and author index is also included. (AEF)

INTRODUCTION

This sixteenth issue of *Bibliographical Work in New Zealand* is divided into two sections. The first, *Bibliographical Work in Progress* at June 1995, is compiled from a questionnaire mailed to all bibliographers listed in *Bibliographical Work in New Zealand 1993* and *1994* who have not since published, and to educational, government, medical, special and large public libraries in New Zealand. Not all bibliographers to whom questionnaires were sent replied. Since it is assumed that their work is still in progress, entries from the 1994 issue have been repeated in this issue, but marked with a \approx symbol to indicate that the details have not been re-confirmed. Entries from the 1993 issue have not, however, been re-listed unless an updated return has been received.

The second section, *Bibliographies Published Since June 1994*, is compiled from submissions from librarians and bibliographers, from entries in the *New Zealand National Bibliography* July 1994 – June 1995 and *Index New Zealand* July 1994 – June 1995, from library accessions lists, and from bibliographies received by the University of Waikato Library. A few titles published prior to June 1994 which have not been listed in earlier issues of *BWINZ* have also been included.

Entries in both these sections are arranged under broad subject headings. Each item is, however, listed once only, and since some items could fall under several headings, the user may need to scan several sections, or consult the Subject Index, to locate bibliographies of interest.

I am very grateful to all who replied, and especially to the many librarians who forwarded the questionnaires to bibliographers within their respective institutions or otherwise provided information and assistance.

Bibliographical Work in New Zealand 1995 has been produced using VISOR, an information storage and retrieval program developed at the University of Waikato, and has been printed from copy produced by an APPLE LaserWriter laser printer using the T_EX typesetting package. The assistance of Rex Croft from the University's Computer Services Department is gratefully acknowledged.

I should appreciate receiving notification of any errors in or omissions from this bibliography.

Progress: Proceeding.

Scope: To include all nineteenth century titles: bibliographical information, ownership

Progress: Data collection is underway. Form of publication is unknown. Held as a computer
file, updated irregularly.
5. Industrial Research Ltd. Library Network Services (P.O. Box 31-310, Lower Hutt)
SIRIS: Scientific and Industrial Research Information System.
Scope: A computerized abstracting and indexing database (76,000 records) of New
Zealand scientific information, with emphasis on DSIR-generated material. Database
contact: Geoffrey Bethell.
Progress: Held as a computer file, accessible as SciTec Index (STIX) via the National
Library of New Zealand's Kiwinet service. Updated weekly.
6. Innes, Stephen (New Zealand and Pacific Collection, University of Auckland Library)
South Pacific official publications: a bibliography.
Scope: Official publications from the South Pacific area in serial form. Covers Vanuatu,
Fiji, New Caledonia, Western Samoa, American Samoa, and Tonga.
Progress: Held as a computer file, updated irregularly. Work is now underway to complete
the remaining countries, including publications of the former colonial powers. The Cook
Islands, French Polynesia, and Solomon Islands are the next priorities.

7. Murphy, Nigel Ralph (12 Roy Street, Newtown, Wellington)
 The Chinese in New Zealand: an annotated bibliography.
Scope: A comprehensive listing of any published, manuscript and audio-visual material on the Chinese in New Zealand, in English and Chinese. Includes listings of Chinese New Zealand newspapers and periodicals, and references in *NZPD* and *AJHR*. A large part of the bibliography consists of newspaper articles. These are also included.
Progress: About 2,000 items have been collected so far, being input to a computer file. Unlikely to be completed in the near future. Possibly to be published by the Alexander Turnbull Library when completed.
8. National Library of New Zealand. Indexing Services.
 INNZ: Index New Zealand.
Scope: Journal articles, newspapers, theses, reports, monographs, and conference papers about New Zealand and the South Pacific. Over 300 New Zealand journals and 6 daily newspapers are indexed, covering the social sciences, arts, recreation and sport, language and literature, geography, history, economics and business, computing applications, agriculture and fisheries, philosophy and religion, and librarianship.
Progress: Held as a computer file updated daily, accessible via the National Library of New Zealand's Kiwinet service. Also published in microfiche format and on CD-ROM.
9. New Zealand Early Imprints Project Committee (c/o Alexander Turnbull Library)
 Early Imprints Project: a union list of all books, British and foreign, printed before 1801, held in New Zealand libraries.
Progress: Copies of the records of all New Zealand holdings have been sent to the British Library. Approximately 10,000 New Zealand holdings of English books 1475-1800 have been added to the expanded ESTC (English Short Title Catalogue) database, which is now available on RLIN (USA) and BLAISE (UK), and in New Zealand via the Internet. Records for New Zealand holdings of non-English imprints have been forwarded to the ESTC Centre in North America, and will eventually be added to the proposed master-database of all pre-1801 imprints worldwide. Publication of a short-title list of the Wellington area holdings is planned.

 Newspaper index.
Scope: An index of major New Zealand and Pacific stories from four New Zealand newspapers.
Progress: Implemented as a computer file from January 1990, updated daily. Available for online searching via the National Library's Kiwinet service as NINX.
- ≈11. Parliamentary Library, Wellington. Database Section.
 Profile index.
Scope: Abstracts of some books and official publications, and of articles from a wide range of periodicals, selected for the Library's current information service to MPs.
Progress: Held as a computer file, updated weekly. Not currently available to non-Parliamentary users.
12. Rogers, Frank (43 Gordon Road, Plimmerton 6006)
 Archifacts Index 1974-1993.
Progress: Final text of index completed, preparing preliminaries. Held as a computer file. To be published by the Archives and Records Association of New Zealand as either a special number or as an issue of *Archifacts*.
13. University of Auckland. Library. Information Services Department.
 University of Auckland theses: theses deposited in the University of Auckland Library.
Scope: All higher degree theses deposited in the libraries of the University of Auckland.
Progress: Held as a computer file. An annual printed list, published by the University of Auckland 1991-

14. University of Otago. Library.
 Union list of higher degree theses in New Zealand libraries. Supplement no. 10, 1993-1994.
Scope: Successful doctoral and masters degree theses presented at New Zealand universities, and higher degree theses presented at overseas universities relating to New Zealand and the Pacific.
Progress: In progress. To be published by the New Zealand Library and Information Association.
15. University of Waikato. Library. New Zealand Collection Librarians.
 Index to *Te Ao Hou*, *Te Maori* and *Te Kaunihera Maori*.
Scope: All items except those of only general interest are indexed. Obituaries and book reviews are included, unless these are not specifically of Maori relevance. Editors: Marie Ward and Kay Young.
Progress: Proceeding. To be published by the University of Waikato Library, possibly in 1996. Held as a computer file of nearly 4000 records, regularly updated.
16. University of Waikato. Library. New Zealand Collection Librarians.
 Maori bibliography.
Scope: A subject index to information on Maori topics appearing in books and selected periodicals. The index grew from the need to provide better access than is afforded by subject catalogues. It is especially strong on Maori history and culture. Editor: Ani Pahuru.
Progress: A computer file of more than 2000 records, which is regularly updated. Available for searching via the Library's Online Catalogue on the Internet. Publication is not intended.

17. Lineham, Peter J. (History Dept, Massey University)
 Religious history of New Zealand: a bibliography. 5th edition.
Scope: New Zealand religious history and contemporary phenomena.
Progress: About half the entries of the 4th edition (1993) have been revised. Probably initially to be published on the World Wide Web. Held as a computer file, updated as new material comes to hand.
18. Young, Grant (Library Services, Royal New Zealand Foundation for the Blind, Private Bag 99-941, Newmarket)
 Queer saints in Aotearoa: a select annotated bibliography of material relating to gay Christian history in New Zealand.
Progress: Nearing completion.

Social Sciences

19. Barton, Bill (Dept of Mathematics, University of Auckland)
 Bibliography of mathematics in Maori education.
Scope: All work relating to mathematics or mathematical themes in Maori education.
Progress: Held as a computer file, updated six-monthly. To be published in *Mathematics in Maori education* by the Department of Mathematics, University of Auckland in 1995.

20. Bush, Graham W.A. (Dept of Political Studies, University of Auckland)
Auckland.
Scope: The perspective is on local government, administration and politics.
Progress: A continuing project, supplemented by the bibliography in G.W.A. Bush, *Advance in order* (Auckland City Council, 1991). Held as a computer file, updated continuously. Printouts are available on request from the compiler. Publication of a substantial selection of references will be included in the second edition of *Local government and politics in New Zealand*, to be published by the Auckland University Press near the end of 1995.
- ≈21. Sylvia Ashton-Warner Library, Auckland College of Education (Private Bag 92-601, Symonds Street, Auckland 1035)
EDUC Pacific: a New Zealand and South Pacific education index.
Scope: Material of educational interest on the theory and practice of education at all levels pertaining to New Zealand and the South Pacific region, excluding Australia. Includes both material published in New Zealand and/or the South Pacific, and material about New Zealand and/or South Pacific education published in overseas sources, with all items recorded held by the Sylvia Ashton-Warner Library.
Progress: Held as a computer file, continuously updated. The file was established in 1992, but does include some pre-1992 material.
22. Wolcke, Rainer (University of Auckland Library)
New Zealand treaty list.
Scope: All multi- and bilateral treaties, conventions, etc. to which New Zealand is or has been a party.
Progress: Proceeding, but little progress. Held as a computer file. Form of publication is uncertain.

Biological and Medical Sciences

- ≈23. Barrell, Graham K. (Animal and Veterinary Sciences Group, Lincoln University)
Himalayan thar.
Scope: All aspects of the biology of the Himalayan thar.
Progress: Incomplete set of references held, but most New Zealand and recent literature is included. Updated annually. Publication is not proposed at this stage.
- ≈24. Barrell, Graham K. (Animal and Veterinary Sciences Group, Lincoln University)
Nilgai antelope.
Scope: All aspects of the biology of the Nilgai antelope.
Progress: An author listing, held as a computer file, regularly updated. Publication is not proposed at this stage.
25. Brejaart, R. (416 Coast Road, Te Puru, R.D. 5, Thames)
The kea (*Nestor notabilis* Gould): a bibliography.
Scope: An annotated bibliography of published and unpublished information on the kea.
Progress: Nearly completed. Held as a computer file. To be published in 1995.

26. Brooker, Jeanette H. (13 Oak Avenue, Paremata, Porirua)
Occupational overuse injury (OOS/RSI): a bibliographical guide for sufferers.
Scope: A comprehensive annotated bibliography of all literature relating to occupational overuse injuries available in New Zealand, excluding material that is medically technical in content. It will also include a separate section of selected texts on different treatments that occupational overuse sufferers find beneficial. The final section will consist of selected texts on wellness and overcoming the injury. Also to be included is a list of support groups throughout New Zealand and other useful contact names and addresses.
Progress: Data collection beginning. Form of publication is unknown at this stage.
- ≈27. Buxton, R.P. (Landcare Research New Zealand, P.O. Box 69, Lincoln)
Ecological bibliography of the New Zealand flora.
Scope: All references on the ecology of terrestrial vegetation in New Zealand.
Progress: 2800 entries, not yet complete. Held as a computer file, in abeyance. No present proposal to publish.
28. Davies, Alexander S. (Dept of Physiology and Anatomy, Massey University)
A bibliography of sheep and goat anatomy.
Scope: Planned to include all the world literature.
Progress: Considerably edited and expanded version of first edition published in 1990 (see *BWINZ 1990* item 151). Held as a computer file of over 5000 indexed references, updated continuously. Selected Pro-cite files, or hard copy, are available on request from the author. There has been no progress recently.
29. Hurley, D.E. (27 Clark Street, Khandallah, Wellington)
Bibliography of crustacea Amphipoda to 1969.
Progress: Typeset and proofed. To be published by the New Zealand Oceanographic Institute, but date of publication is unknown.
30. Laird, Marshall ("Awawhare", Pahi Road, R.D. 1, Paparoa 1240)
A source book for New Zealand natural history.
Scope: A synthesis of relevant scientific literature, and other material of natural history interest "buried" in books, articles etc. of more general nature in magazines, newspapers and ephemera, as well as formally published in the regular scientific literature; also unpublished material from ships' logs, etc. The object is to fill a major gap, namely, the lack of any general bibliography covering the New Zealand flora, fauna, and related aspects of palaeontology. The book will feature a comprehensive introductory essay, and will be exhaustively indexed, with cross-referencing to all existing specialized bibliographies concerning the botany, zoology and palaeontology of New Zealand, whether printed or computerized. The numerous illustrations will emphasize little-known photographs, paintings and sketches.
Progress: Part-time assembling of the data (both within New Zealand and abroad) began in Winter 1984. Currently seeking a publisher.
31. Paul, L.J. (NIWA, P.O. Box 14-901, Kilbirne, Wellington)
Ozone depletion and ultraviolet light effects on aquatic organisms, ecosystems, and aquaculture: titles and abstracts from a literature search: 1993-94 update.
Progress: On hold.
32. Warham, John (Zoology Dept, University of Canterbury)
A bibliography of the Procellariiformes.
Scope: A keyworded listing of publications on tube-nosed birds (Order: Procellariiformes) from Aristotle to the present. The work is set out in the format of *Zoological Record*.
Progress: Proceeding. About 11,000 citations have been entered to a computer file.

Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries

33. New Zealand Institute of Crop and Food Research (Private Bag 92-169, Auckland)
 FISHTEC: seafood technology bibliography.
Scope: All publications relating to seafood technology, handling, processing, safety and marketing. Curator: G.C. Fletcher.
Progress: Held as a computer file, updated daily, accessible on request. About 10,500 references.
34. New Zealand Meat Research and Development Council (P.O. Box 1975, Wellington) and Dalton, D.C. (Waikato Polytechnic)
 Sheep production in New Zealand, 1940-1985.
Scope: All aspects of sheep production in New Zealand: growth, reproduction, wool, nutrition, diseases.
Progress: A computer file available on request to the New Zealand Meat Research and Development Council.
35. Paul, L.J. (NIWA, P.O. Box 14-901, Kilbirnie, Wellington)
 A bibliography of New Zealand marine fishes, 1769-1990.
Scope: Covers all retrievable references on marine fishes which have been collected or studied in New Zealand, including overseas work which mentions New Zealand material or localities. Originally intended to stop at 1983, is now being continued to the symbolic year 1990. Comprises three sections: about 3,000 titles by author; a systematic section cross-referenced by scientific and common name to 1990 (1984-1990 primary scientific literature only); and a subject index which does include the extensive 1984-1990 grey literature.
Progress: Nearing completion, with work proceeding on the 1984-1990 additions. Most of the bibliography is held in word processor files. To be published in printed form, and also added to a fisheries computerised information system.

Engineering, Domestic and Applied Sciences

36. Building Research Association of New Zealand (BRANZ). Library (Private Bag 50-908, Porirua)
 BRANZ Library database.
Scope: Provides access to books, pamphlets, series, reprints, periodicals, standards, conference papers and BRANZ publications held by the BRANZ Library, including *Build* magazine. Contains extensive coverage of building technology. A list of recent acquisitions is published monthly as *Selected Building References*. Items are available for loan.
Progress: Ongoing. The database contains over 35,000 items. Held as a computer file, updated daily.

37. Chesterman, Sandra (34A Rawene Road, Birkenhead, Auckland 10)
Bibliography of New Zealand women artists.
Scope: Includes brief biographical details and bibliography for each New Zealand woman artist, both historical and contemporary.
Progress: Held as a computer file. To be published in 1997.
38. Dingwall, Richard, Robertson, Lois and Entwisle, Rosemary (c/o Hocken Library, University of Otago)
Index to *Art(s) in New Zealand*.
Scope: A nominal and subject index to *Art in New Zealand* and *Arts in New Zealand*, 1928-1946.
Progress: Indexing has been completed. To be published as a special issue of the *Bulletin of New Zealand Art History* in 1996.
39. Foreman, David (Serials Department, University of Waikato Library)
Film reviews: an index of recent reviews from periodicals in the University of Waikato Central Library.
Scope: An index of reviews since September 1992.
Progress: Ongoing, updated fortnightly. Held as a computer file. Latest updated version may be e-mailed or posted to interested parties. Publication is not considered.
- ≈40. Freed, Dorothy W. (48 Standen Street, Karori, Wellington 5), McKeown-Green, Philippa (Music Librarian, Auckland City Libraries) and Annabell, Angela (5 Darwin Lane, Remuera, Auckland 5)
RILM abstracts of music literature.
Scope: A list, with abstracts, of periodical articles and books about music published in New Zealand, and theses about music accepted by New Zealand universities, for the past year. Annual contribution to *RILM Abstracts (Répertoire international pour la littérature de la musique)*.
Progress: Held as a computer file, updated four times a year. Published annually in *RILM Abstracts* and available for searching online.
41. Graham, Ruth (Nola Millar Library, New Zealand Drama School, P.O. Box 6690, Wellington)
Bibliography on Nola Millar, 1913-1974.
Scope: The bibliography is the first stage of a project to establish a collection of material on the life and work of Nola Millar, and in particular her involvement in the theatre, and as a librarian at the Alexander Turnbull and Victoria University of Wellington Libraries, with a view to a biography being written at some later date.
Progress: Information is still being collected, and being entered into a computer file. As yet there are no plans for publication.
42. Polglase, Helen (c/o 14 Bernard Street, Hamilton)
A selective bibliography of New Zealand cello compositions.
Scope: Includes compositions that have the cello in a prominent, leading or solo role.
Progress: Draft completed. To be updated and published by the author in 1997, and copies deposited with major libraries.

 Outdoor recreation research in New Zealand. Volume 2: A bibliography.
Scope: Covers New Zealand research on outdoor recreation in natural settings, but not sport or urban-based outdoor recreation.
Progress: Held as a computer file. To be published in book format by the Department of Conservation and Lincoln University in late 1995.

Scope: A fully annotated bibliography. Continues *BWINZ 1993* item 179.
Progress: Held as a computer file, updated regularly.

Scope: A fully annotated bibliography. Continues Ruth Prawer Jhabvala: a checklist of primary and secondary sources. *Journal of Commonwealth Literature* v.20 no.1, 1985, p.171-203.
Progress: Held as a computer file, updated regularly.
- ≈46. Easting, Robert (Dept of English, Victoria University of Wellington), with Rogerson, Margaret and Speed, Diane (Dept of English, University of Sydney)
 Saints' legends.
