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ABSTRACT

The 23 tables and associated figures in this document summarize the annual student semester credit hour (SSCH) production for all of Arkansas' public higher education in 1994-1995. Several tables include these enrollment data in terms of full-time equivalencies (FTEs), calculated by dividing undergraduate SSCH by 30 or graduate SSCH by 24. While the more detailed tables provide the most recent year's statistics, many data are presented in a 3- to 5-year context. The 1994-1995 total credit hour production for Arkansas' 33 public institutions was 2,195,444, a decrease of 2 percent from the previous year. This drop is reflective of changes in the undergraduate programs. Productivity is approximately the same as in 1991-1992. By contrast, credit-hour production at the graduate level was 1 percent above last year's total and significantly higher than in 1991-1992. The first section includes five tables showing such trends as annual student semester credit hours by program classification. The next section presents tables showing aggregated credit hour data for all public four-year and two-year institutions and data for each state university and community college. The final section has six tables summarizing data by program category. (KG)

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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The following tables and figures summarize the annual student semester credit hour (SSCH) production for all of Arkansas' public higher education in 1994-95. Several tables include these enrollment data in terms of full-time equivalencies (FTEs), calculated by dividing undergraduate SSCH by 30 or graduate SSCH by 24. While the more detailed tables provide the most recent year's statistics, many data are presented in a three to five year context.

The 1994-95 total credit hour production for Arkansas' 33 public institutions was 2,195,444, a decrease of 2% from the previous year. Because more than 90% of the total SSCH is produced at the baccalaureate level and lower, this drop is reflective of changes in the undergraduate programs. It should be noted, however, that productivity is approximately the same as in 1991-92. By contrast, credit hour production at the graduate level was 1% above last year's total and significantly higher than that in 1991-92 (+10.1%).

Among the report's other highlights are the following points:

- The proportion of SSCH production generated by the four- and two-year institutions has remained essentially the same when compared with 1991-92 data: 75% by the universities and 25% by the colleges.
- Collectively, undergraduate SSCH for the four-year institutions decreased by 2.1% from the prior year while graduate SSCH was up 1%. The most significant gain over the four years was by the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, while the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff led the growth in graduate SSCH at 58.1%. Southern Arkansas University experienced the greatest decline in undergraduate SSCH (-12.3%) for the same period, and Henderson State University dropped by 6.2% in graduate SSCH.
- Credit hour production at two-year colleges grew by 3.0% last year, while the 1994-95 SSCH was 36.8% greater than in 1991/92. The most notable gains from the prior year were by Pines and Cossatot Technical Colleges at 50.9% and 33% respectively. Approximately half of the two-year colleges registered SSCH levels that were lower than the previous year.
- When reviewing SSCH by CIP categories for the four-year institutions, Social Sciences and History accounted for the largest proportion of the 1994-95 undergraduate hours (13.4%), followed by Education (11.1%), Business Management and Administration Services (10.4%), and English Language and Literature/Letters

(10.3%). At the graduate level, two categories account for approximately one-fourth of the SSCH each: Education and Health Professions and Related Sciences.

- Nearly half of the 1994-95 credit hour generation by two-year institutions was in Business Management and Administration Services (13.7%), English Language and Literature/Letters (11.7%), Basic Skills (11.5%), and Health Professions and Related Sciences (10.1%).
- For occupational CIP categories, SSCH by the two-year colleges outpaced that for the universities by nearly 2:1. In both two- and four-year institutions, Business Management and Administration Services generated the greatest number of credit hours.
- The University of Central Arkansas produced the greatest number of credit hours in Education at the undergraduate level, while the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, ranked first in graduate-level hours produced in Education.

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



Figure 3. Disciplines With Largest SSCH Production, 1994 - 95



