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ABSTRACT

Focusing on the diversity of the University and Community College System of Nevada (UCCSN), these two reports present data as of fall 1995 on the ethnicity and gender of the System's students and staff. The Executive Summary first presents an overview of the report and findings. Data tables are then presented on the gender and ethnicity of students, including by campus and changes from 1985 to 1995, and of faculty and staff, including systemwide and by campus for 1991-95; system administrative staff for 1991-95; full-time faculty, executive/administrative/managerial, other professional, technical/paraprofessional, clerical/secretarial, skilled craft, and service/maintenance employees for 1995; part-time employees for 1995; and gender and ethnicity by job category for 1991-95. Finally, data are provided on new, full-time professional staff hired between July 1 and September 30, 1995 and tenure and promotions awarded for 1994-95. Highlighted findings include the following: (1) 56% of students in fall 1995 were female and 19% were minorities; (2) between 1985 and 1995, female enrollment increased 2% systemwide and minority enrollment increased 8%; (3) between 1991 and 1995, the proportion of female employees increased 3% while the proportion of minority employees decreased 1% systemwide; and (4) in 1995, 50% of all UCCSN employees were female and 13% were minorities. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Board of Regents of the University and Community College System of Nevada (UCCSN) has made a commitment to recognize and reflect the diversity of society within its institutions. In June 1995, the Board adopted UCCSN diversity goals that provide a long-range target for student enrollment and staff employment for all segments of the system. Five-year benchmarks to the year 2000 were also established so that progress could be measured against the stated targets.

As stated in Board policy that was re-affirmed in March 1996, the UCCSN is guided by the principle that there shall be no difference in the treatment of persons because of race, religion, color, age, sex, disability, or national origin, and that equal opportunity and access shall be available to all. Board policy recognizes the key role that institutions of higher education play in helping society overcome the effects of past exclusion and discrimination. Participation in higher education by members of minority groups, women, and other protected classes is a priority issue and increasing participation of these groups is a goal of the System.

In the employment of all personnel, the UCCSN recognizes that as a public agency it has a further commitment to support federal and state policies which seek to achieve equal opportunity in employment for members of minority groups, women, and the handicapped. This commitment is also reflected in System goals. Board policy further states that the affirmative action necessary to implement this includes active recruitment as well as programs designed to lead to qualification for both academic and classified positions.

Annually, information regarding the diversity of students enrolled and staff employed by the UCCSN is forwarded for Board review. This report reflects the 1995 composition of the workforce and the student body, the most recent data available, as well as ten-year comparisons (1985) and one-year comparisons (1994). An analysis of progress toward the five-year benchmarks established in 1995 is contained in a companion document.

UCCSN STUDENTS, FALL 1995

- ◆ Systemwide, the student body has become more diverse. 56% of students in Fall 1995 were female and 19% were identified as members of a minority group. This reflects the same proportion of female students and a 1% increase in minority students since 1994. Over the ten-year period between 1985 and 1995, female enrollment increased 2% systemwide and minority enrollment increased 8% systemwide.

5% (3,433) of total students enrolled Fall 1995 were Black, 7% (4,739) were Hispanic, 6% (3,716) were Asian, and 1% (998) were Native American students.

Between Fall 1994 and Fall 1995, Hispanic and Asian enrollments each increased 1% systemwide. Native American enrollments decreased 1% systemwide.

Asian and Native American students were represented in the UCCSN student body in approximately the same proportion as in the 1994-95 statewide high school graduating class, while Black and Hispanic students remained underrepresented systemwide.

- ◆ Between 1991 and 1995, the proportion of female employees increased 3% while the proportion of minority employees decreased 1% systemwide. The proportion of minority employees systemwide remained the same in 1995 as it was in 1994.

UCCSN TENURE AND PROMOTIONS, 1994-95

- ☞ During 1994-95, 98 faculty were awarded tenure. 36% of those awarded tenure were female and 13% were minority.
- ☞ During 1994-95, 85 faculty were promoted. 27% of those promoted were female and 12% were minority.

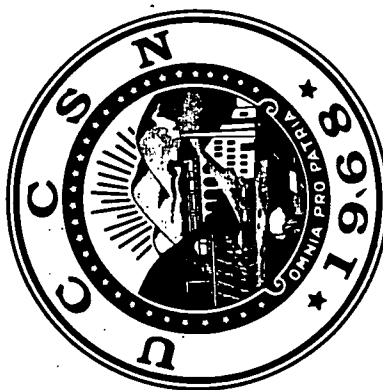

This report contains diversity statistics about students and employees of the University and Community College System of Nevada (UCCSN) for 1995. Student data are reported for the fall 1995 semester, while staff data are reported as of October 1, 1995. The information in this report supplements a companion document, the *UCCSN Diversity Report--Executive Summary*, and is intended for those who wish to do further analysis of the data.

It should be noted that due to a shift in administrative information systems, staff data collected in 1995 may differ from previous years. Specifically, although improvement in tracking of part-time employees provided for more accurate counts of the number of employees, complete demographic data were not available at the time of the system conversion. In particular, information about the racial/ethnic designations of part-time employees--especially at the universities--is incomplete.

At the time of analysis, not all demographic data were available. Rather than imputing the missing information, part-time employees have been reported as "race/ethnicity unknown" wherever data were not available. Future reports will include the demographic data as resources become available to completely implement the new system.

Footnotes on pages 5, 10, 11-13, 29, and 36-38 of this report detail instances in which data may not be comparable. To maintain continuity and to provide additional explanation, the table shown on page 30 has been added to the report.

Highlights of these data are contained in a companion document entitled, "UCCSN Diversity Report---Executive Summary, August 1996," published by the UCCSN System Administration Office.

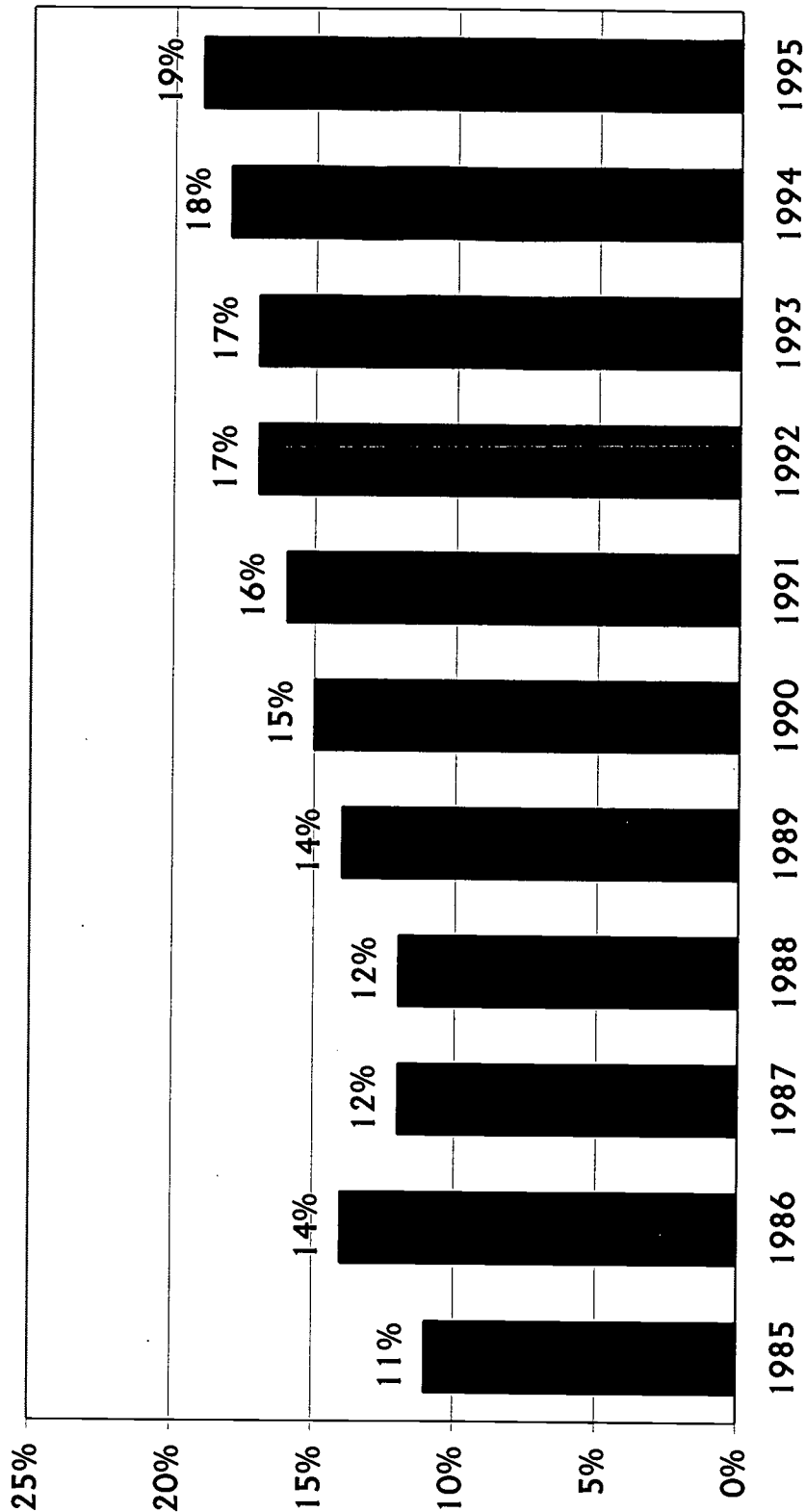

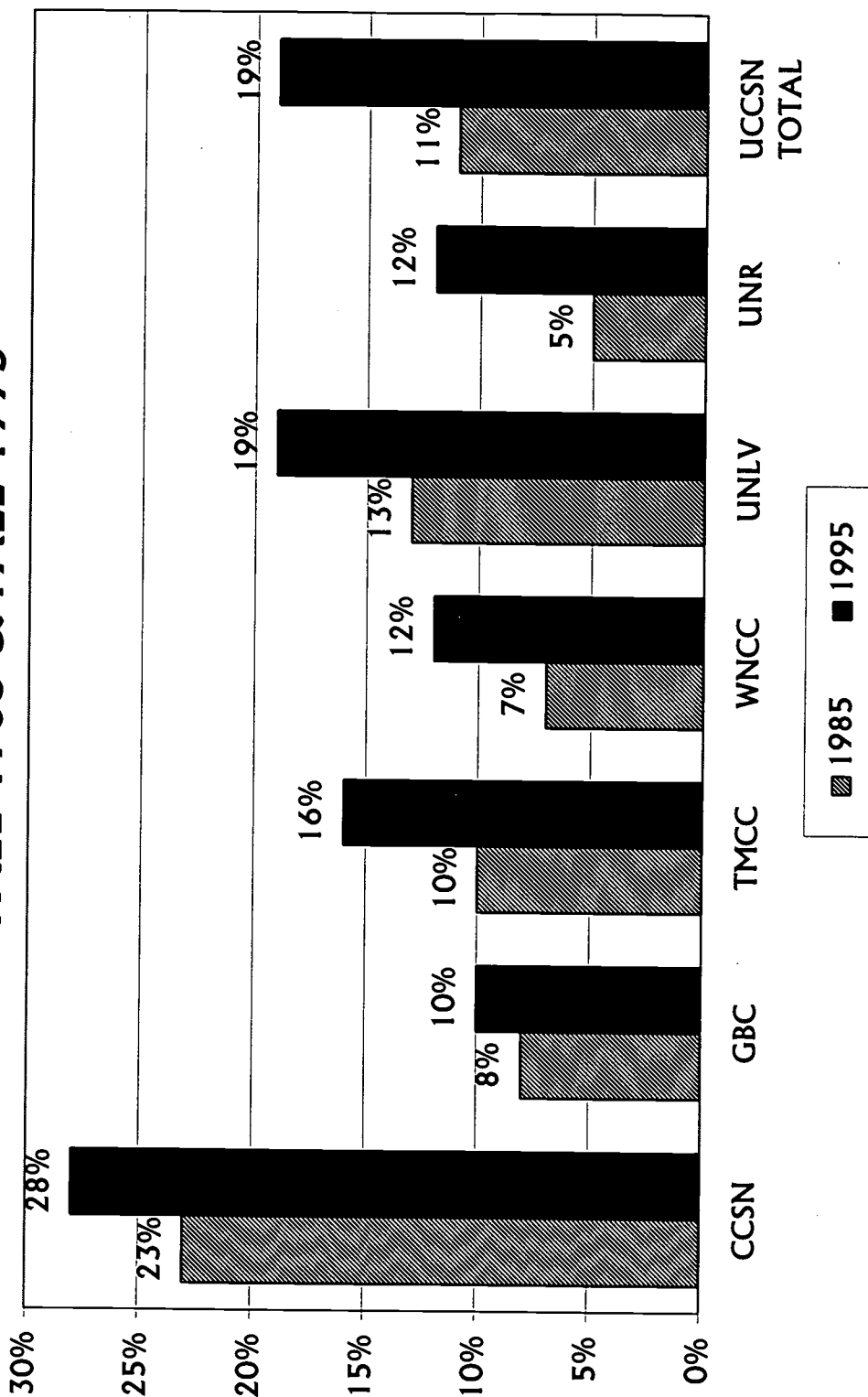

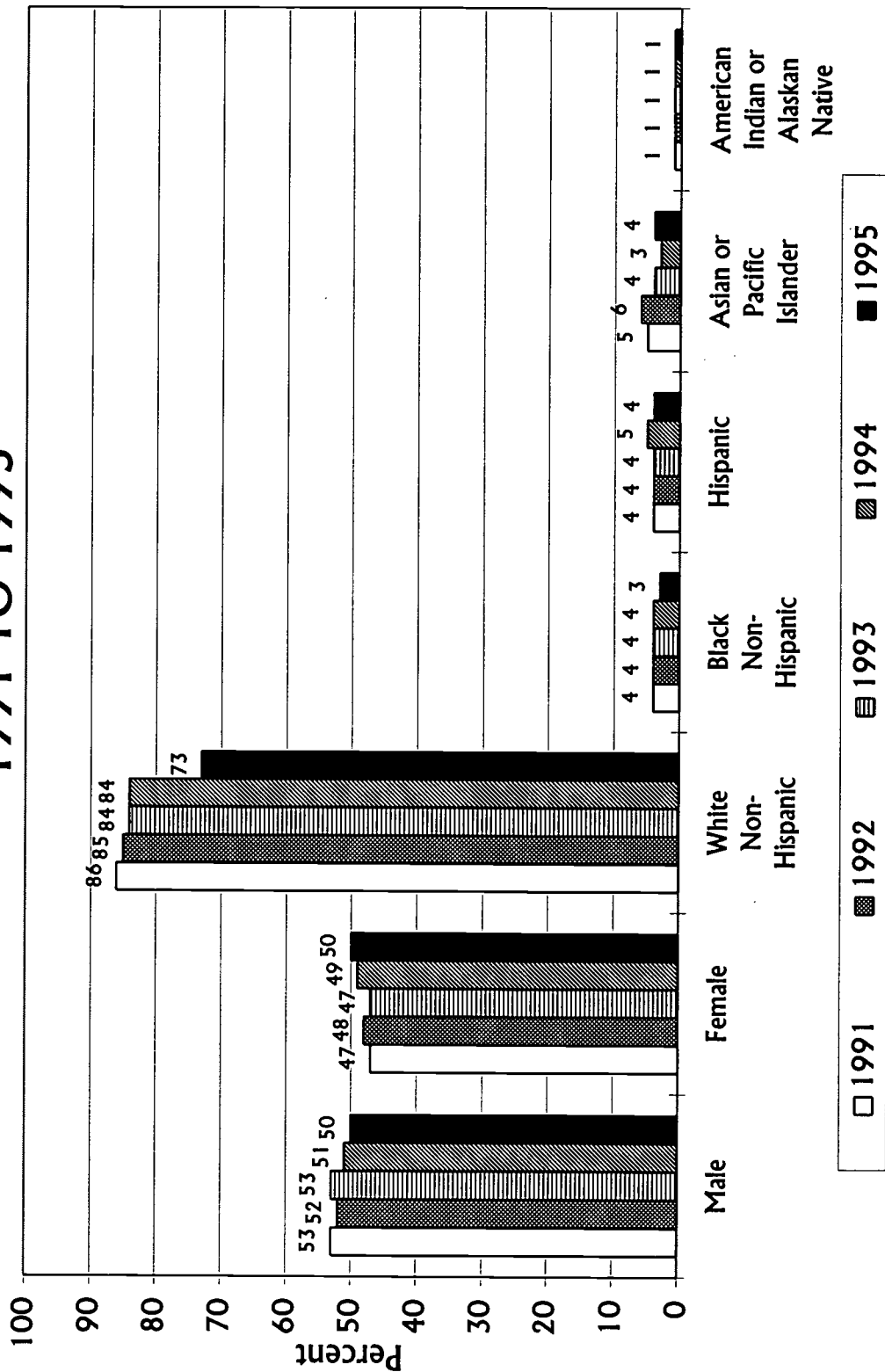

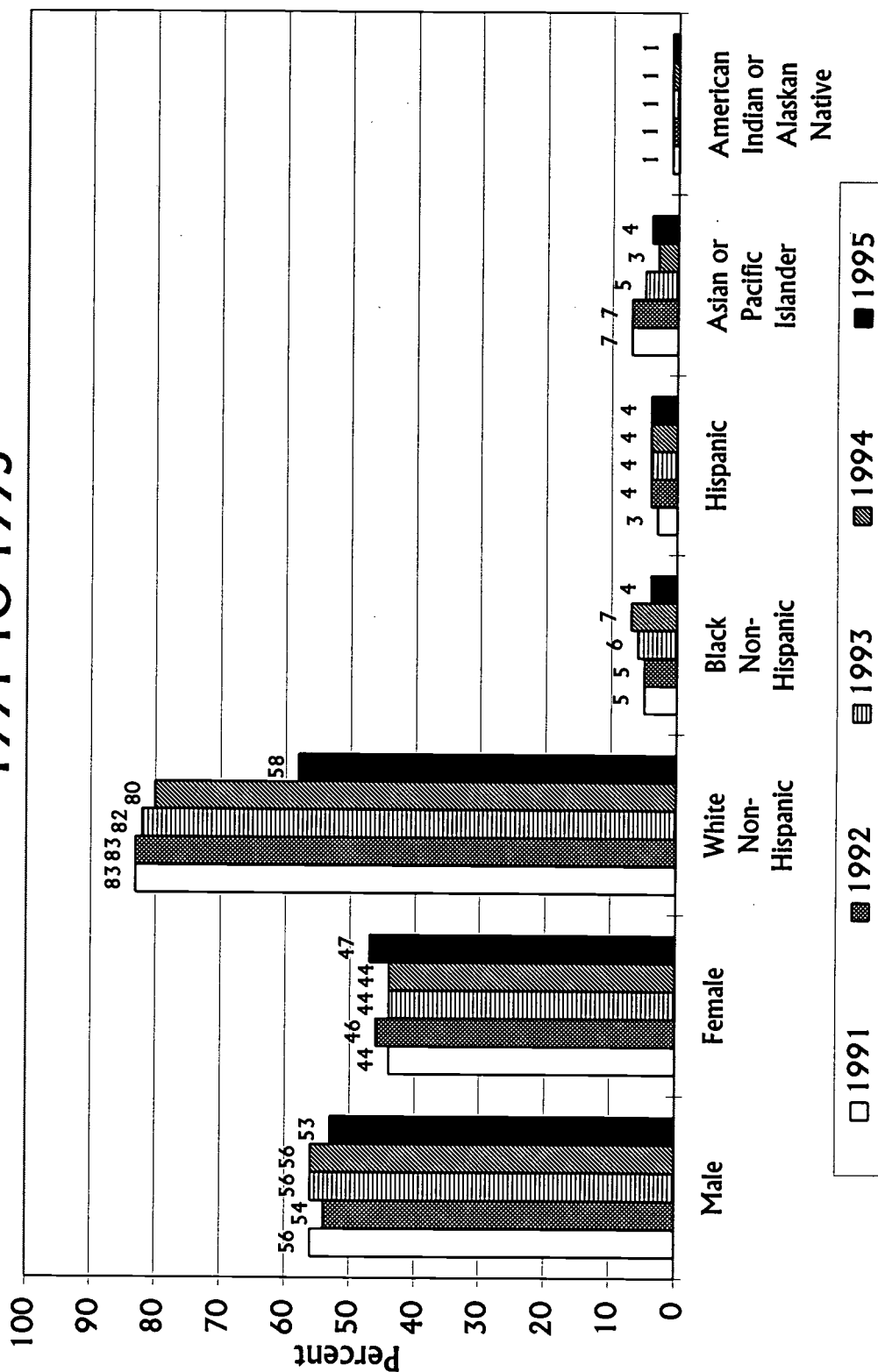

UCCSN FACULTY AND STAFF 1991 TO 1995



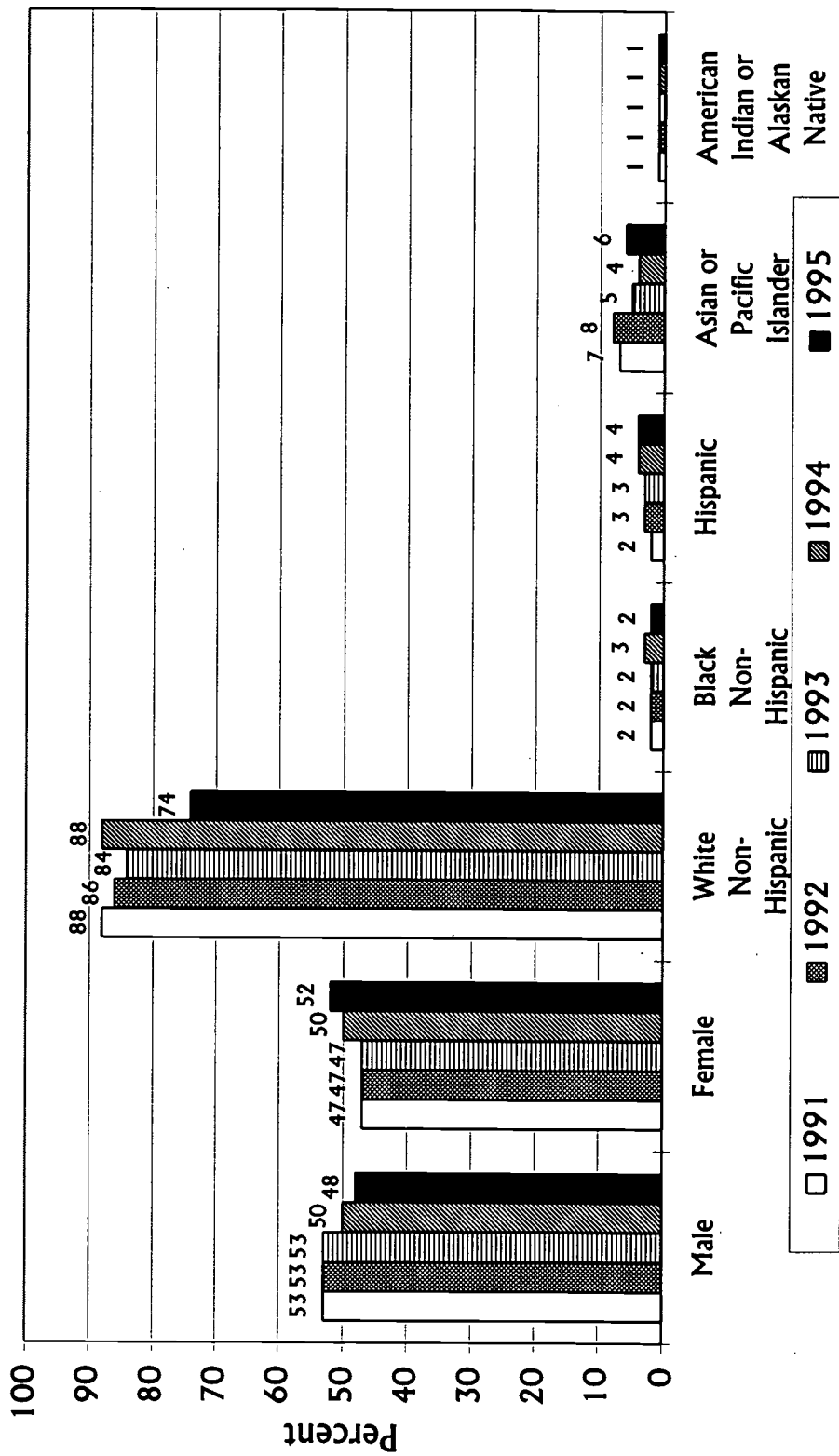

UNLV FACULTY AND STAFF 1991 TO 1995



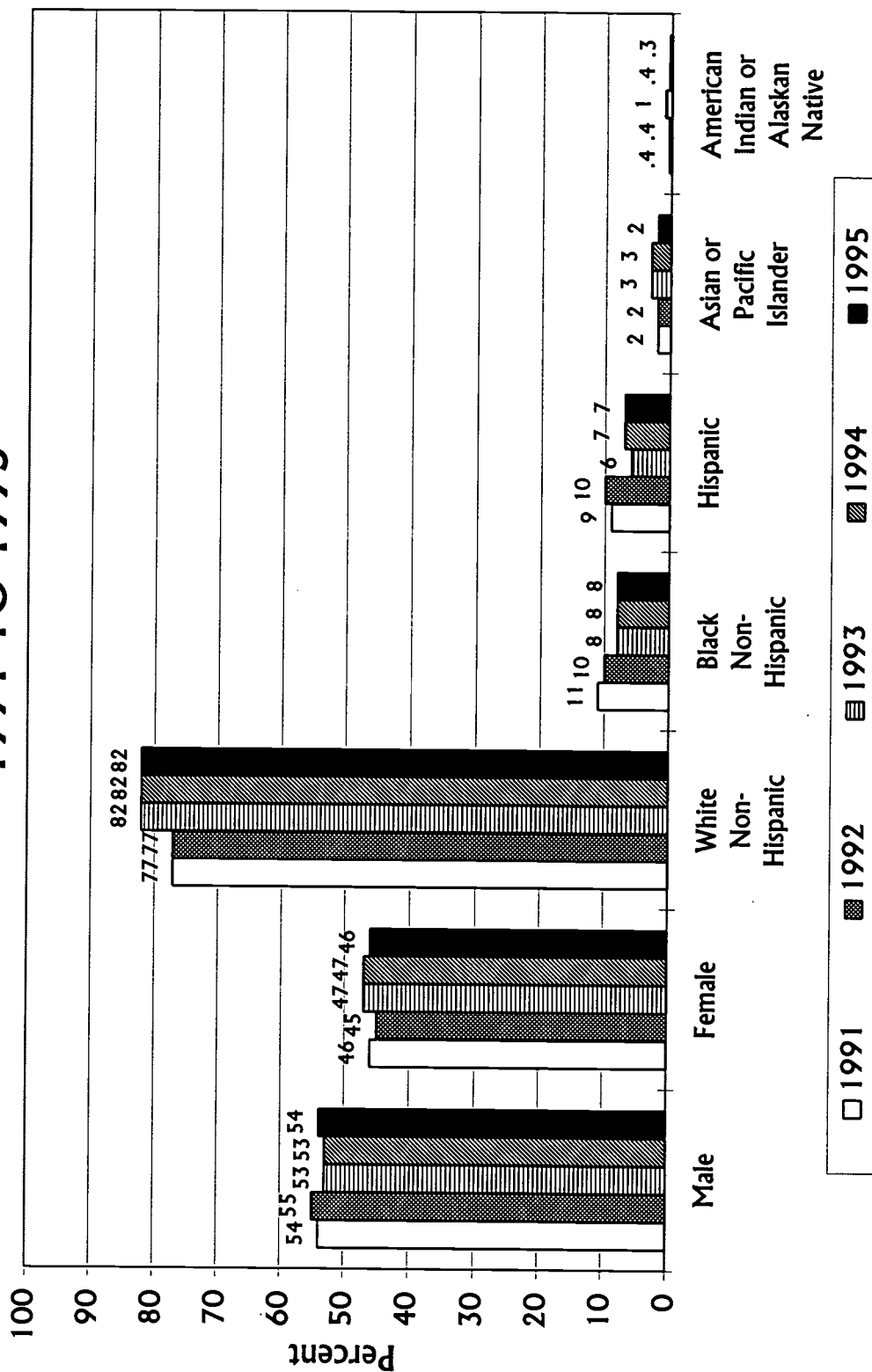

UNR FACULTY AND STAFF 1991 TO 1995

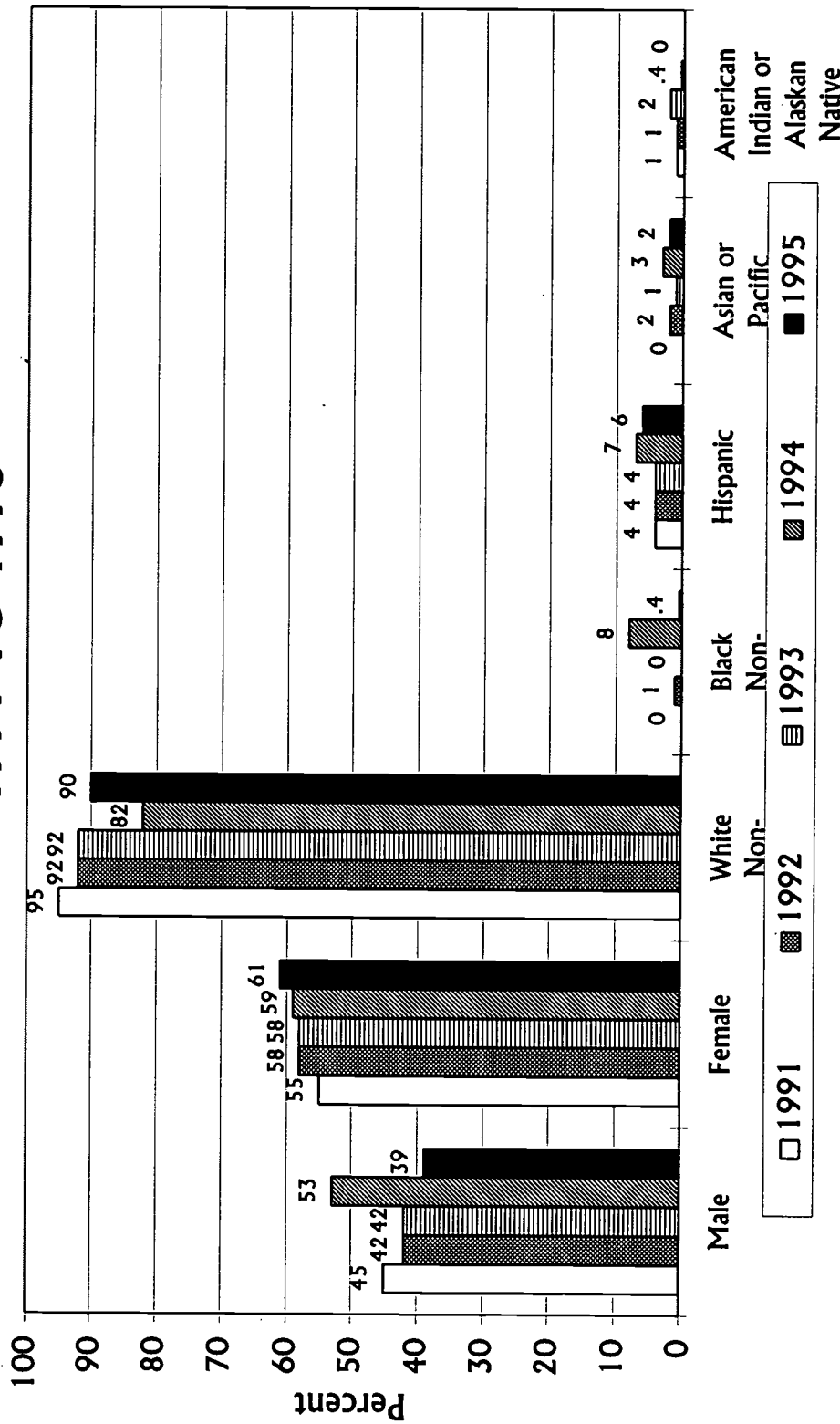

CCSN FACULTY AND STAFF 1991 TO 1995

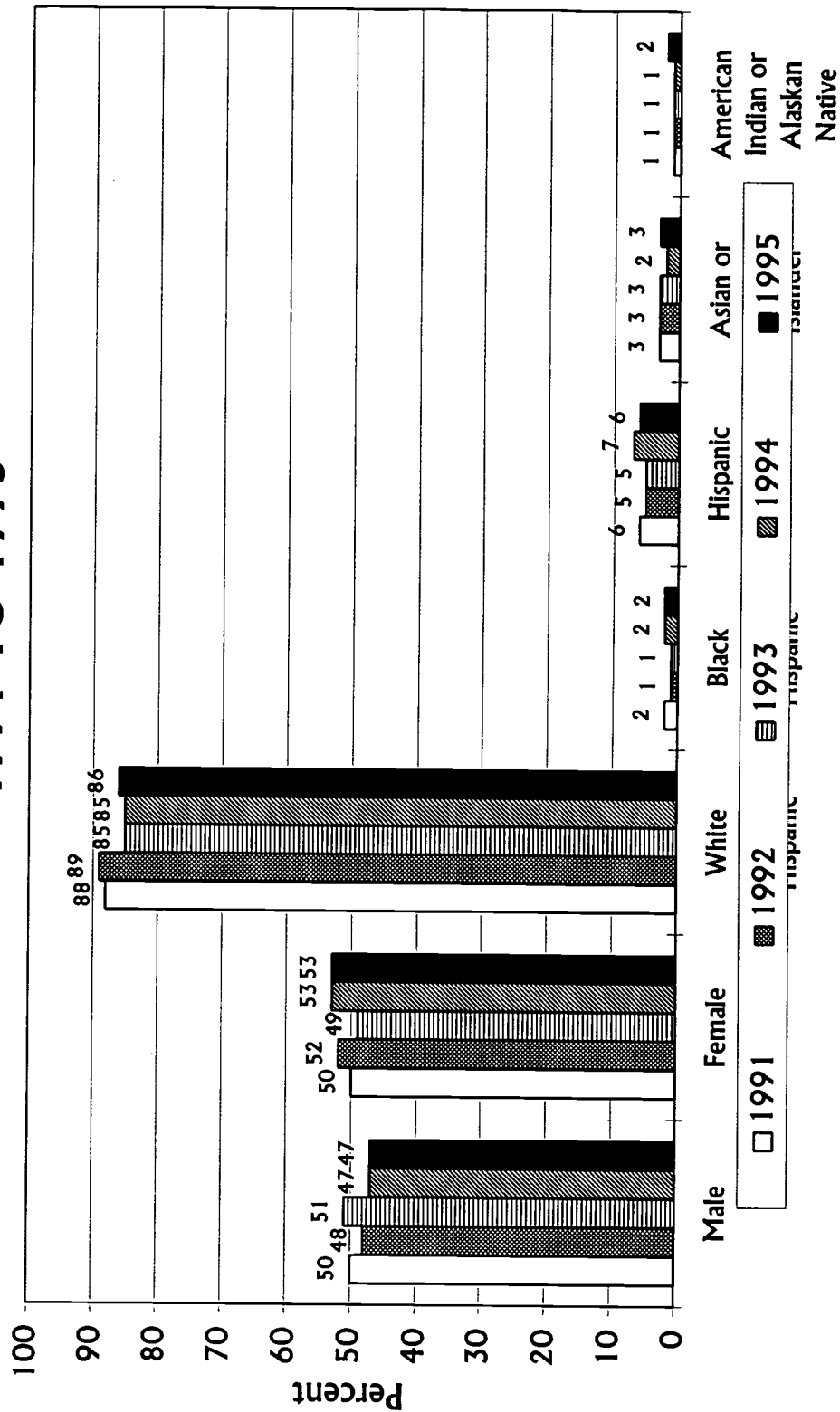


GBC FACULTY AND STAFF 1991 TO 1995



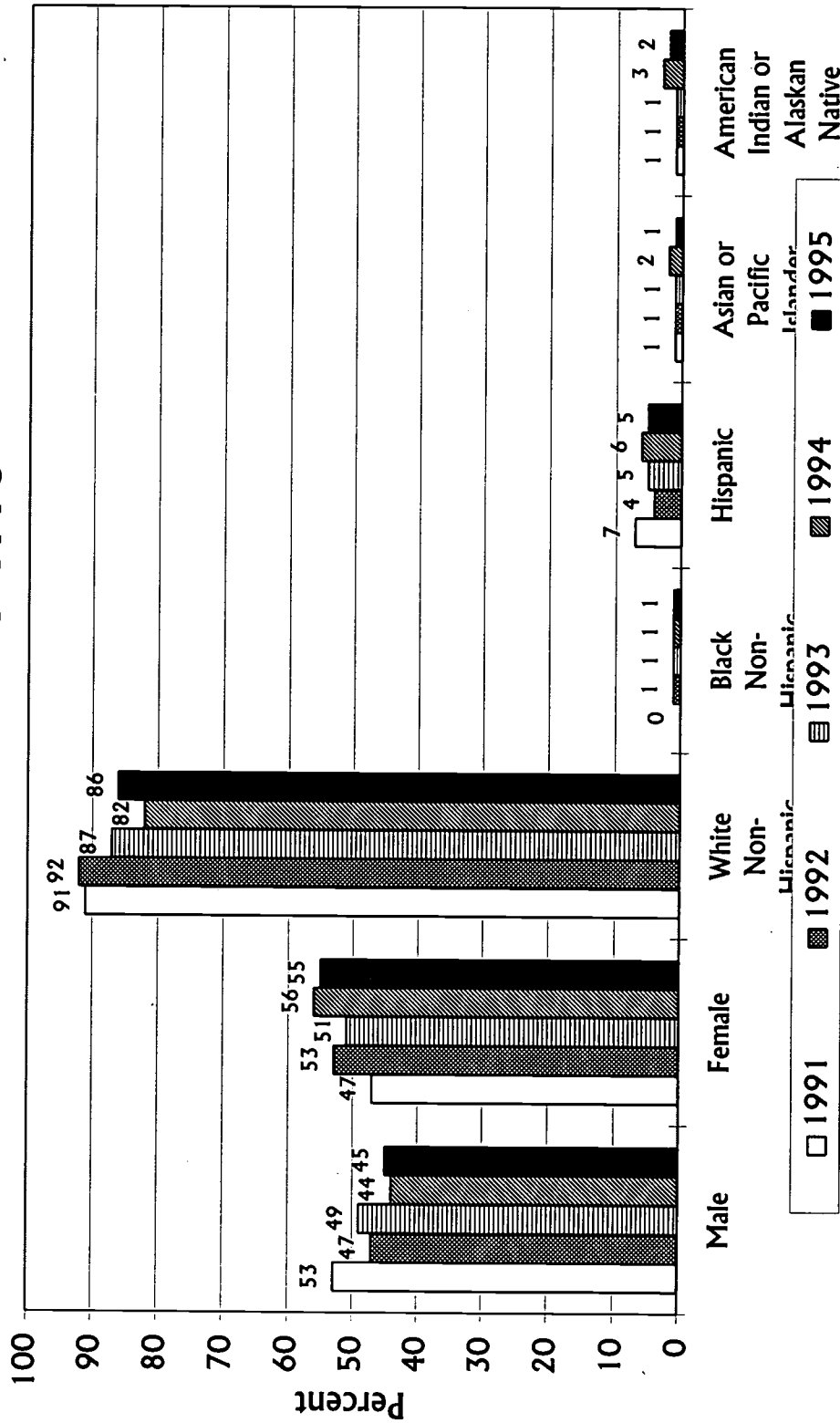

TMCC FACULTY AND STAFF 1991 TO 1995



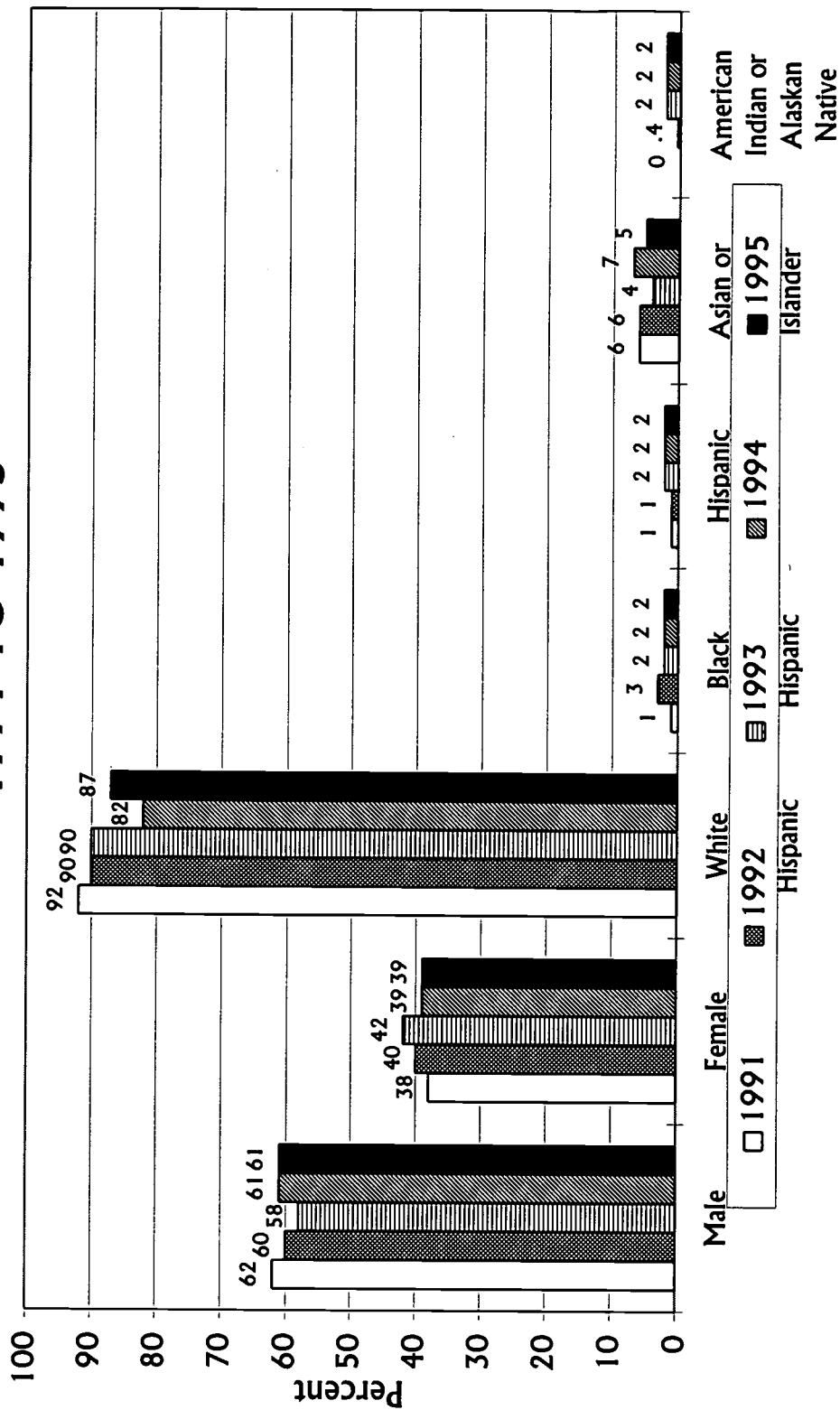

WNCC FACULTY AND STAFF 1991 TO 1995



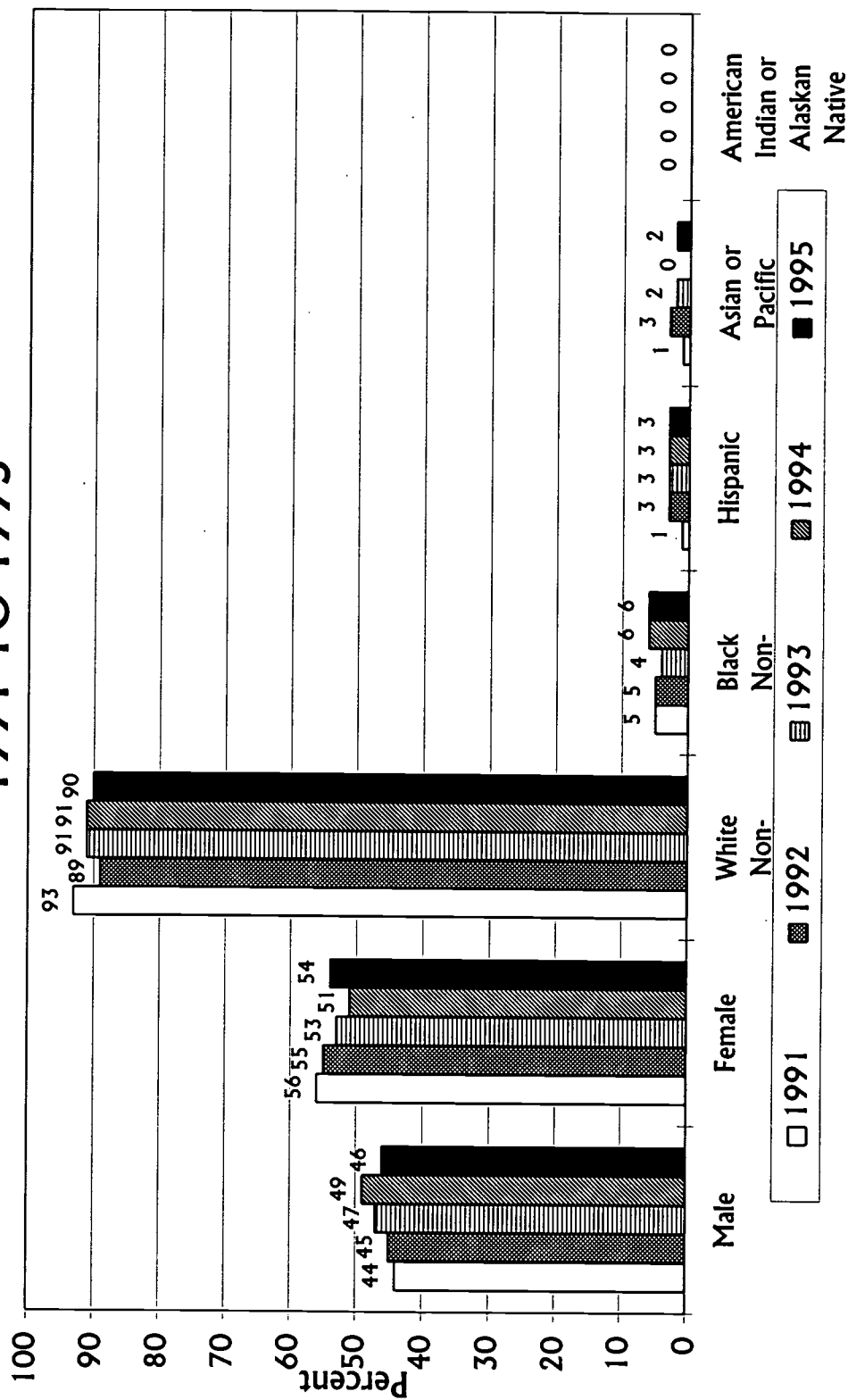

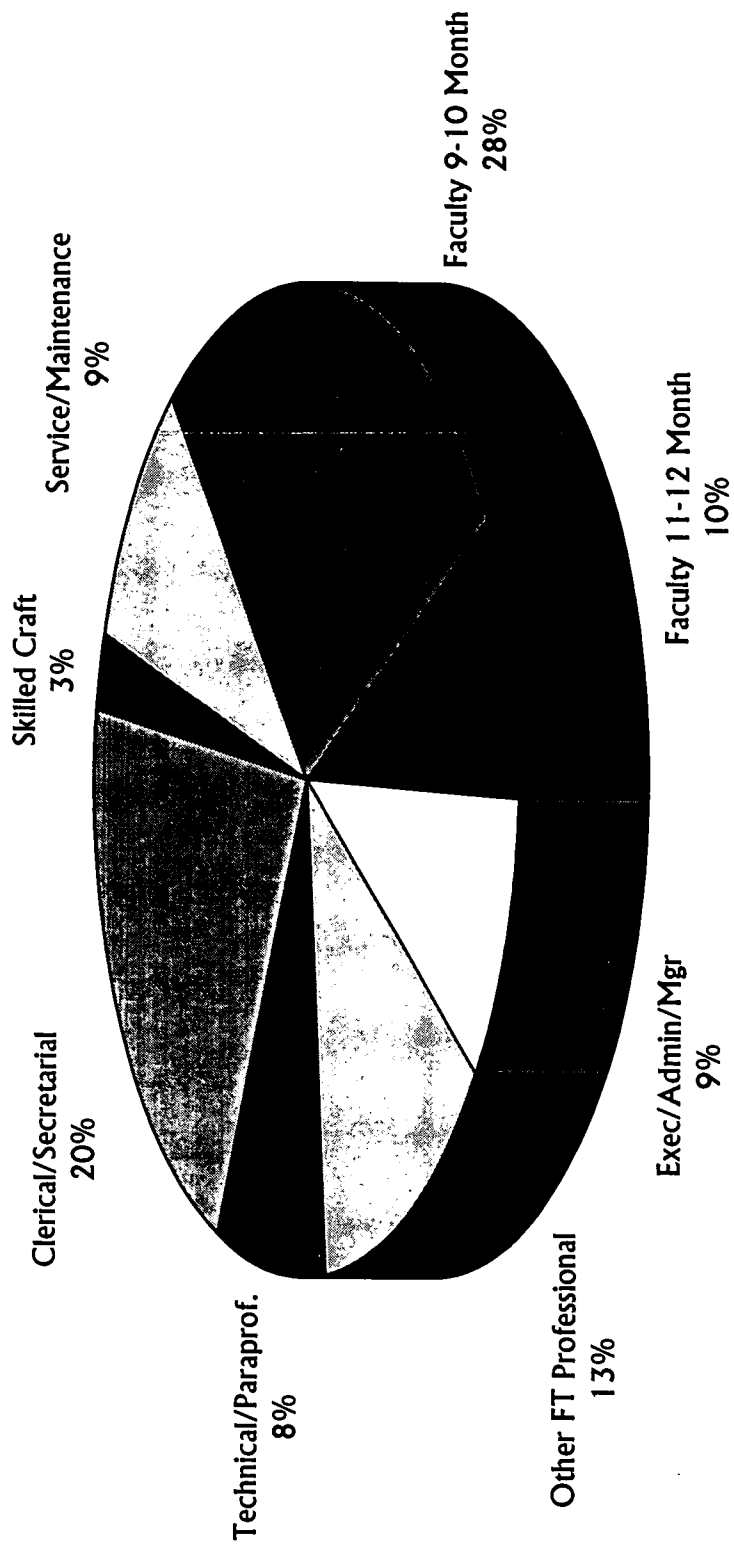

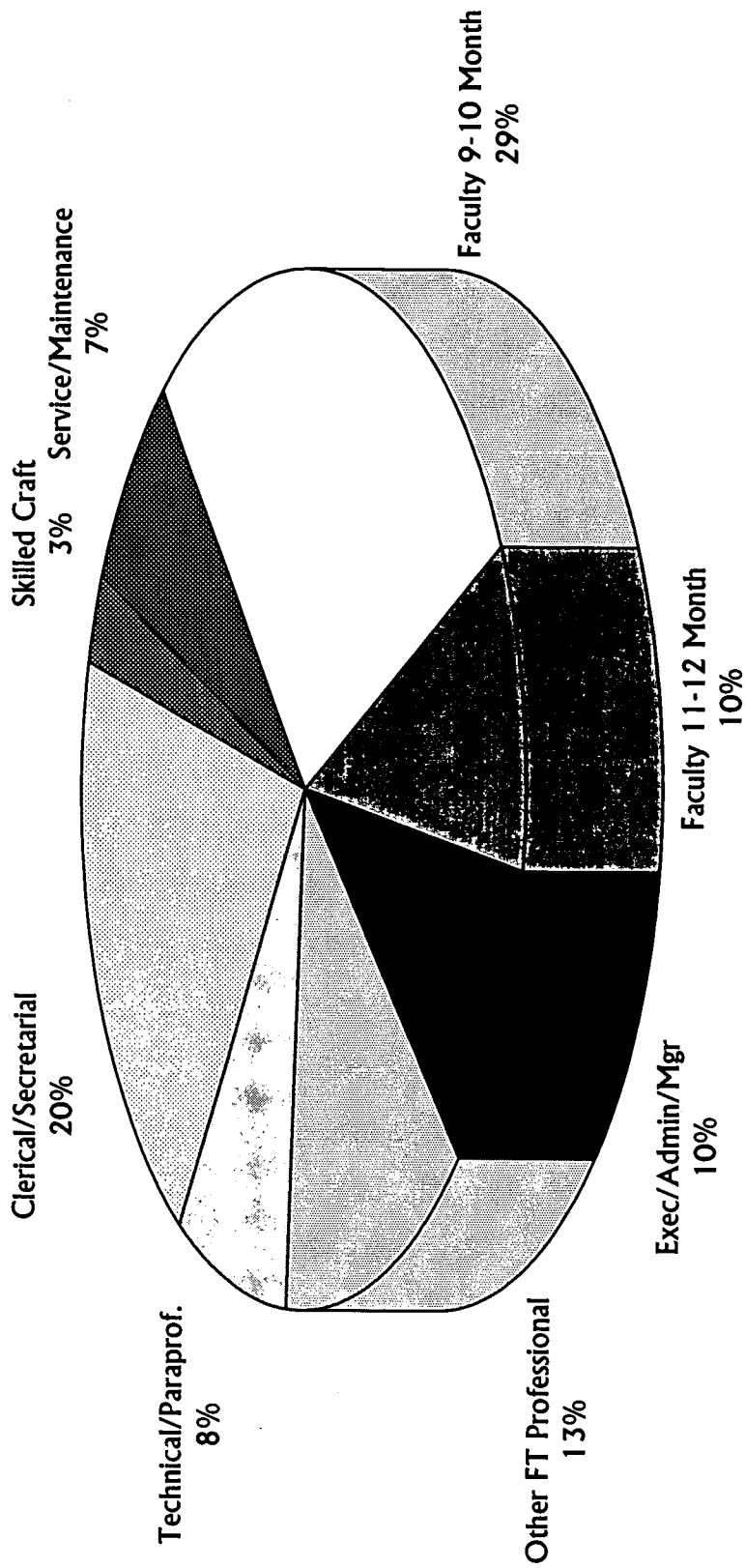

UCCSN FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES JOB CATEGORY BY RACE/ETHNICITY 1995

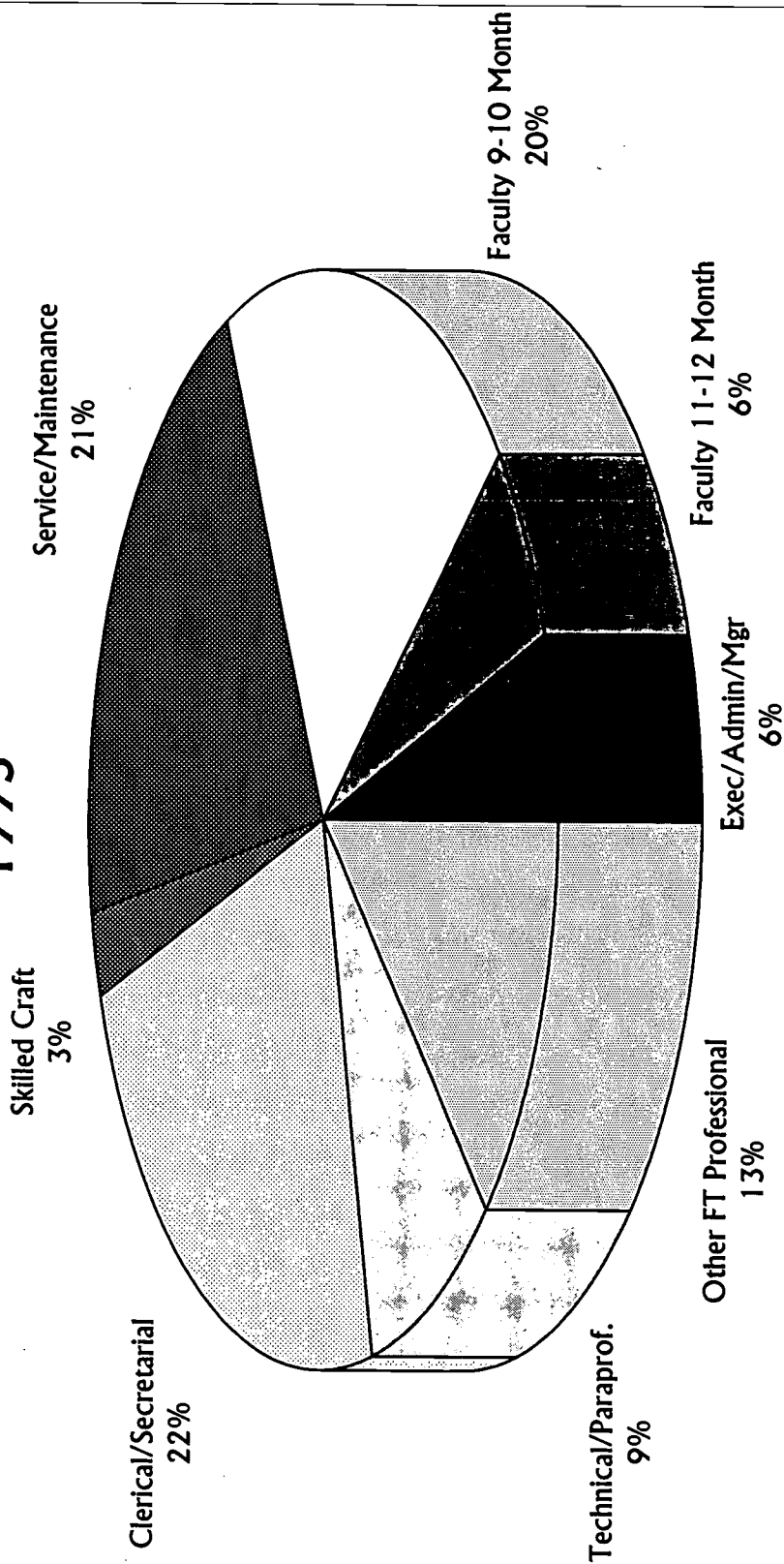

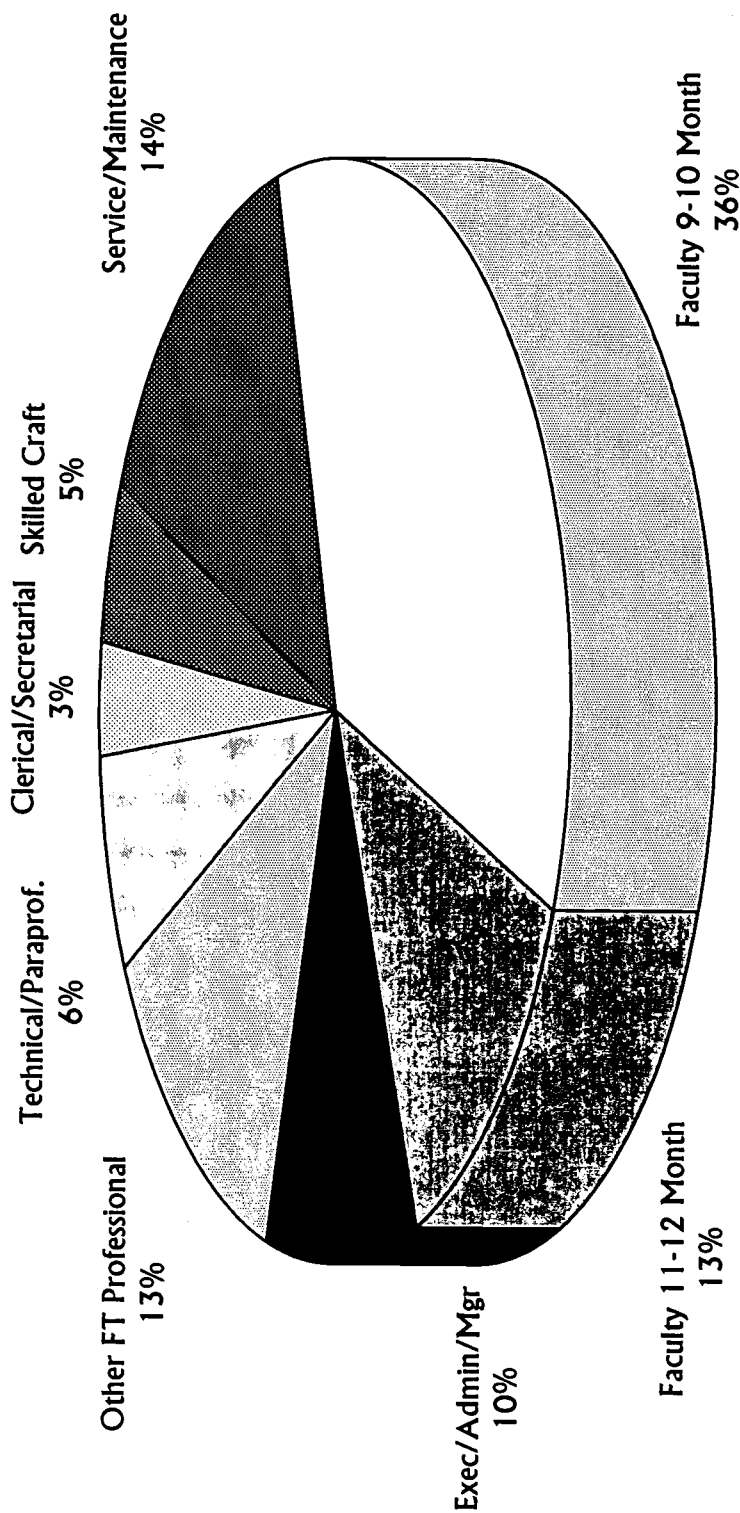

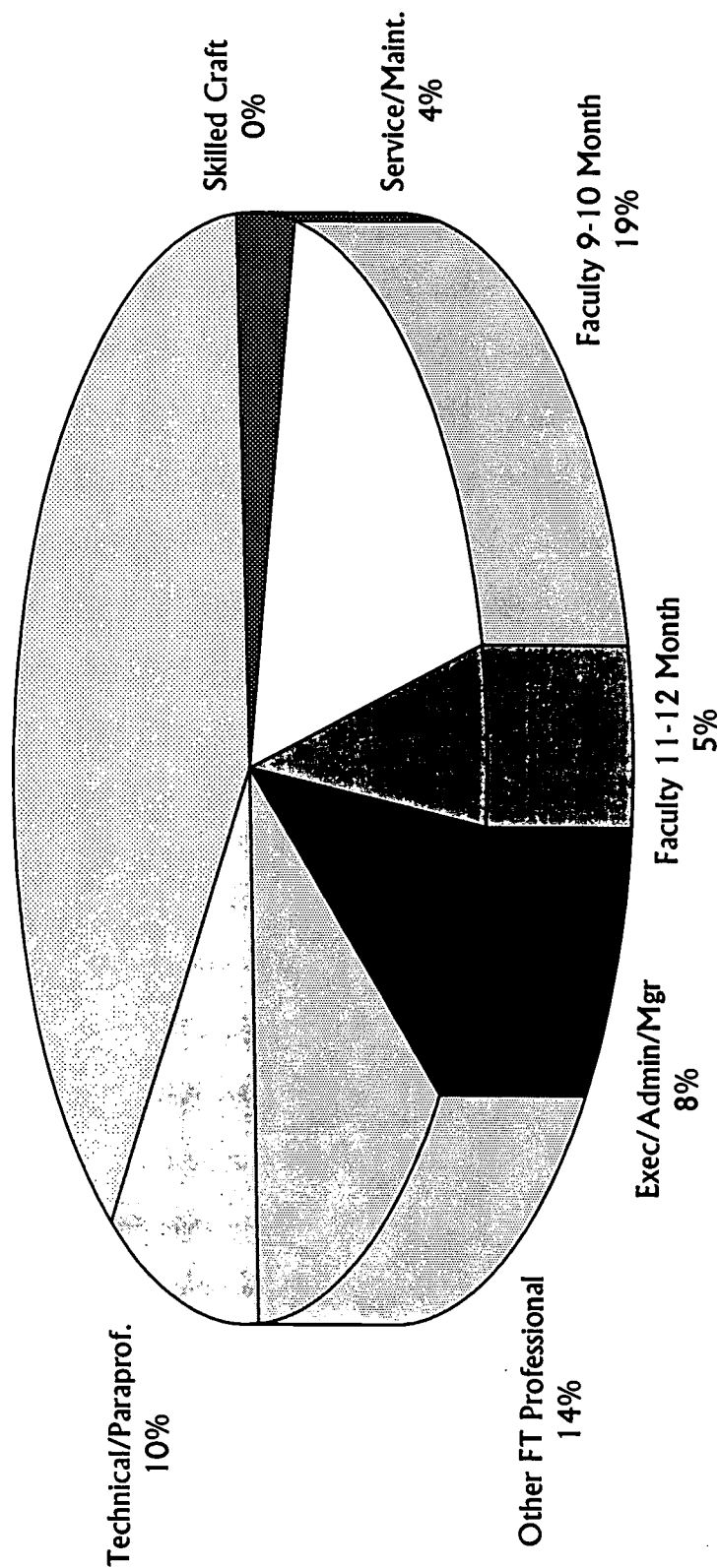
