## ABSTRACT

Designed to assist California's Cypress College in planning, marketing, recruitment, and retention efforts, this report provides data tables on the demographics of students enrolled in the spring 1995 semester. Tables are provided for the following areas: enrollment history for spring semesters, 1984-94; registration by admission classification; active enrollment by sex; and students' degree objectives, class standing, full- or part-time status, semester units taken, age, ethnicity, citizenship status, tuition status, veteran status, high school graduation status, last high school attended by county, last college attended, year of graduation from high school, and residence by zip code. Highlighted findings include the following: (1) total enrollment for spring 1995 was 13,265, a decrease of 7.8% from the spring 1994 enrollment of 14,382; (2) among enrollees who stated their gender in spring 1995, 5,783 were male and 7,435 were female; (3) 5,413 students indicated an educational objective of transferring with an associate's degree, while 1,016 indicated that they sought to transfer without an associate's degree; (4) 4,546 students were attending full-time in spring 1995, while 8,719 were attending part-time; (5) 6,160 students were White, 2,644 were Asian, 2,469 were Hispanic, and 803 were Filipino; (6) 10,412 students were United States citizens, while 2,299 had a permanent Visa; and (7) 10,672 students were high school graduates and 1,367 had a foreign high school or diploma certificate. ## Cypress College

### Active Enrollment Report Spring 1995

#### Summary

The Enrollment Management Report contains important student demographic data that will assist the College in its planning process, marketing, recruitment of students into programs and the College's goals and projects for student retention.

The report is based on the active enrollment statistics of the census period as of February 13, 1995. The census period begins with Monday (Tuesday, if a holiday falls on Monday) of the fourth week of the semester.

The following are highlights of the Active Enrollment Report:

#### **REGISTRATION**

The total number of registrants by the end of the second week of Spring 1995 Semester was 14,042, this represents a decrease of 6.4% over the Spring 1994 Semester that had a total of 15,009 registrants.

#### **ENROLLMENT**

The active student enrollment as of the census period for Spring 1995 was 13,265. This represents a decrease of 7.8% over the same period for Spring 1994 that had an active enrollment of 14,382 students.

#### **WITHDRAWAL RATE**

There was an increase in the number of student withdrawals during the first three weeks of the semester prior to the census period. For Spring 1995, 777 students, 5.5%, withdrew from the College as compared with the Spring 1994 wherein 627 students, 4.2%, withdrew during the same period.

#### **DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE**

Our student ethnic representation is: White(Non-Hispanic) - 46.4%, Hispanic - 18.6%, Asians - 19.9%, Black - 4.2%, Filipino - 6.1%, Native American/Alaskan Native - 1.1%, Other Non-White - 1.0%, Pacific Islander - 0.6%, and Undetermined - 2.0%.

Students 20 years and younger comprise 23.8%; students between 21-34 years comprise 57.8%, and students 35 years and over comprise 18.3%. The average age is 27.16 years.

Students taking 12 units or more and considered full-time comprise 34.3% of the entire enrollment, 4,546 students. Students taking 11.5 units or less and considered part-time comprise 65.7% of the enrollment, 8,719 students.
