ABSTRACT

Designed to assist California's Cypress College in planning, marketing, recruitment, and retention efforts, this report provides data tables on the demographics of students enrolled in the fall 1994 and fall 1995 semesters. Tables are provided for the following areas: enrollment history for fall and spring semesters, 1985-95; registration by admission classification; students' degree objectives, class standing, full- or part-time status, semester units taken, age, gender, ethnicity, citizenship status, veterans status, country of origin for foreign students, high school graduation status, last high school attended by county, last college attended by county, year of graduation from high school, and residence by zip code; and grade distributions by academic division. Selected findings include the following: (1) enrollment for fall 1995 was 13,357, down from 14,142 in fall 1994; (2) 5,768 students expressed transferring with an associate's degree as their educational objective, while 1,016 cited transferring without a degree; (3) 4,683 students were attending full-time in fall 1995, while 8,627 were attending part-time; (4) 7,588 fall 1995 students were female, compared to 7,951 in fall 1994; and (5) the number of White students declined from 6,747 in fall 1994 to 5,991 in fall 1995, while the number of Hispanic students increased from 2,631 to 2,659.
