ABSTRACT

This report provides longitudinal data on enrollments, finances, programs, and staff for the 16 campuses of the Wisconsin Technical College System, covering systemwide the period from 1988 to 1997. The following tables are provided: (1) headcount enrollment by aid categories of college parallel, postsecondary (i.e., associate degrees and vocational certificates), continuing education, and community services, 1988-97, and by college, 1996-97; (2) Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) student enrollment by aid category, 1988-97, and by college, 1996-97; (3) enrollments by gender and ethnicity, 1988-97, and by college, 1996-97; (4) special needs enrollments, 1988-97, and by college, 1996-97; (5) graduates by aid category, 1988-97, and by college, 1996-97; (6) graduate employment status, 1987-96, and by college, 1995-96; (7) 1988-97 operational costs by aid category and 1996-97 costs by college; (8) revenues by source, 1988-97, and by college, 1996-97; (9) general state aid, 1988-97, and by college, 1996-97, (10) mill rates, tax levies, and property values, 1989-98, and by college, 1997-98; (11) 1989-98 program fees and out-of-state tuition; (12) 1993-97 customized instruction and technical assistance contracts and contracts by college, 1996-1997; (13) approved programs offered by instructional division, 1988-97, and by college, 1996-97; (14) FTEs and budget for college parallel programs, 1988-97, and by college, 1996-97; (15) headcounts, FTEs, and costs for basic skills courses, 1988-97, and by college, 1996-97; and (16) staff, 1990-97, and by college, 1996-97. Addresses of district offices and campuses and a list of data sources are included. (BCY)
