## ABSTRACT

This document reports the graduation and retention rates at the University of Hawaii community colleges and compares the graduation and retention rates of students with other institutions. The three rates that are examined in this report are as follows: (1) retention/continuation rate; (2) graduation rate; and (3) success rate (defined as the sum of graduation and continuation rates). The data is gathered by tracking first time freshmen at a specific community college. The report concludes that the average three-year graduation rate is 14%. Also an average of 40% of students either graduate within three years or continue at the same campus after the third year. Furthermore, women have higher retention and graduation rate at most of the campuses. The average three-year success rate is 42% for women and 37% for men. Women also have higher success rates in all campuses than men. Lastly, Hispanics and Caucasians have the highest average graduation rates in all of Hawaii Community Colleges while Asians have the highest average continuation and success rates. The Hawaii CCs have an average continuation rate of 25%. Contains five figures, nine tables, and eight appendices. (MZ)

**GRADUATION AND RETENTION RATES  
PEER AND BENCHMARK GROUP COMPARISONS  
UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, COMMUNITY COLLEGES  
FALL 1998 COHORT, AS OF 2001**

This report summarizes graduation and retention rates at the University of Hawai'i community college campuses and compares graduation rates with those of its peer and benchmark institutions. Peer and benchmark graduation rates are collected from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) peer analysis system.

Three rates are looked at in this report:

- **Retention/Continuation Rate:** The percentage of first-time freshmen in a given fall semester who returned to the campus in a subsequent fall semester.
- **Graduation Rate:** The cumulative percentage of first-time freshmen in a given fall semester who graduated within a designated period of time (3 years), measured as of the summer term.
- **Success Rate:** The percentage of first-time freshmen in a given fall semester who have either graduated or are still enrolled. The success rate is calculated by adding the graduation and continuation rates together.

Rates in this report are the result of tracking first-time freshmen at specific community college campuses and not across the campuses. For example, a first-time freshmen entering Honolulu Community College is tracked at that campus only.

Continuation, graduation, and success rates are provided for the each of the University of Hawai'i community colleges. However, since federal reporting requirements do not require the collection of retention/continuation rates, only graduation rates are available for peer and benchmark institutions. Furthermore, gender and ethnicity breakdowns are not available for peer and benchmark institutions due to confidentiality regulations.

Appendix 1 shows which schools are included in each campus's benchmark and peer groups, as well as 3-year graduation rates for their Fall 1998 cohort.

Due to differing methodologies and databases, the data reported here differ from previously reported data from the NCHEMS/University of Hawai'i Longitudinal Database Project.

### **Graduation Rates**

The community colleges have an average 3-year graduation rate of 14%. Hawai'i Community College has the highest 3-year graduation rate (19%) of the 7 campuses, followed by Maui (18%), Honolulu (17%), Kaua'i (13%), Leeward (13%), Kapi'olani (11%), and Windward (8%).

The average 3-year graduation rate is 6 percentage points less than that of its benchmark average of 20%. The 3-year graduation rate of each individual campus is also lower than those of its peer averages:

- Hawai'i's rate is 3 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 22%.
- Honolulu's rate is 4 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 21%.
- Kapi'olani's rate is 7 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 18%.
- Kaua'i's and Leeward's rates are 12 percentage points lower than that of their peer averages of 25%.
- Maui's rate is 5 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 23%.
- Windward's rate is 16 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 16%.

Graduation rates of women are higher than those of men at all campuses except Hawai'i. The average UHCC 3-year graduation rate is 16% for women and 12% for men.

Ethnicity groups with the highest graduation rates differ among individual campuses; however, Caucasians, Asians, and non-resident aliens appear more often as the ethnicity groups with the highest graduation rates. This is not the case in the average UHCC 3-year graduation rate where non-resident aliens have the highest rate (35%), followed by Hispanics (22%) and Caucasians (15%).

### **Continuation Rates**

The community colleges have a average continuation rate of 25%. Kapi'olani Community College has the highest continuation rate (34%) of the 7 campuses, followed by Leeward (28%), Kaua'i (27%), Honolulu (25%), Maui (21%), Windward (16%), and Hawai'i (13%).

Continuation rates of women are higher than those of men at all campuses except Honolulu. The average UHCC 3-year continuation rate is 26% for women and 25% for men.

Asians and Mixed ethnicity groups tend to have the highest continuation rates at most campuses. The average UHCC 3-year continuation rate reflects this as well, with Asians having the highest continuation rate (28%), followed closely by mixed-ethnicity students (27%).

### **Success Rates**

Success rates are the sum of graduation and continuation rates, and reflect the percentage of students who have not dropped out at the individual campus. The average UHCC 3-year success rate is 40%. Kapi'olani Community College has the highest success rate (45%), followed by Honolulu (43%), Leeward (41%), Kaua'i (39%), Maui (39%), Hawai'i (32%), and Windward (24%).

Success rates of women are higher than those of men at all campuses. The average UHCC 3-year success rate is 42% for women and 37% for men. In addition, Asians and Mixed ethnicity groups tend to have the highest success rate at most campuses. Asians, non-resident aliens, and mixed-ethnicity students have the highest average UHCC success rates, 42%, 38%, and 37% respectively.

## Summary

- The UHCC average 3-year graduation rate is 14%.
- An average of 40% of UHCC students either graduate within three years or remain at the individual campus after their third year.
- Women have higher graduation and retention rates at most of the campuses, and have higher success rates at all campuses.
- Hispanics and Caucasians have the highest average UHCC graduation rates.
- Asians have the highest average UHCC continuation and success rates.

3-Year Success Rates by Campus




3-Year Success Rates by Ethnicity - UHCC




3-Year Graduation Rates


