INTRODUCTION

This listing contains 2004-05 high school graduates and postsecondary education rates for all public high schools. Included in this listing are the total graduates and those graduates planning to attend a two- or four-year college or university, a specialized associate degree-granting institution, or a nondegree-granting postsecondary school.

Definitions of selected column headings:

COLLEGE BOUND – a high school graduate planning to enroll in a two- or four-year, degree-granting college or university, or a specialized associate degree-granting institution.

NONDEGREE-GRANTING POSTSECONDARY SCHOOL – a postsecondary school that grants a certificate or diploma as the highest award.

POSTSECONDARY BOUND – a high school graduate planning to enroll in a two- or four-year degree-granting college or university, a specialized associate degree-granting institution, or a nondegree-granting postsecondary school.

SPECIALIZED ASSOCIATE DEGREE-GRANTING INSTITUTION – a postsecondary institution in Pennsylvania legally authorized to grant an Associate in Specialized Business (ASB) or an Associate in Specialized Technology (AST) degree.
