Are All America's Children Really Above Average? A comparative analysis of fourth-grade reading proficiency on national and state assessments.

Executive summary

According to the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP), only one-third of American fourth grade students are at or above proficient in reading. Yet state assessments indicate that most American fourth-grade students are above average in reading. This analysis raises the questions about standards of success and what children need to know and do to compete in a global economy.

State and national profiles of fourth-grade reading proficiency i

Proficiency in reading on individual state assessments ranged from 25 percent (Louisiana) to 95 percent (Nebraska). Proficiency on the NAEP assessment ranged from 17 percent (District of Columbia) to 47 percent (Massachusetts). Results of 23 state assessments indicate that 75 percent or more of fourth-graders in those individual states are proficient in reading (see state chart). Yet according to the NAEPⁱⁱ, no state has 50 percent of fourth-grade students proficient in reading (see NAEP chart).

Overall disparities


Generally, fourth-grade reading proficiency appears to be significantly higher in state assessments than in the national assessment. Hawaii is the only state that had the same proficiency level (26 percent) on the national assessment and its own test. The differences between performance on the state assessment and national assessment ranged from 0 – 62 percent; Tennessee, for example, reported 90 percent of fourth-graders as proficient in reading on the Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program while the NAEP reports that 28 percent of Tennessee fourth-graders are proficient in reading – a difference of 62 percentⁱⁱⁱ.

More than half of the states had a disparity of 40 percent or higher in proficiency between performance on national and state assessments.

Racial disparities

Results of state assessments indicate that racial disparities exist throughout the nation. Proficiency disparities on state assessments between White and Black students ranged from 8 percent in West Virginia (White 64 percent and Black 56 percent West Virginia) to 46 percent in the District of Columbia (White 86 percent and Black 40 percent). Proficiency disparities on state assessments between White and Hispanici students ranged from 2 percent in West Virginia (White 64 percent and Hispanic 62 percent) to 39 percent in the District of Columbia (White 86 percent and Hispanic 47 percent).

The NAEP results also indicate that Black and Hispanic students have much lower levels of proficiency than their White counterparts. The lowest level of proficiency was 9 percent for Black students in Louisiana, Michigan, and Wisconsin. The highest level of proficiency for Black students was 28 percent in New Hampshire. The lowest level of proficiency was 10 percent for Hispanic students in Utah. The highest level of proficiency was 31 percent for Hispanic students in Florida.

Conclusion

Both state and national assessment results indicate that a large number of American fourth-graders are not proficient in reading. For example, 462,489 fourth-graders (60 percent) were proficient on the California Standards Test, while 184,996 (40 percent) students were not proficient on the California state test. Since education has traditionally been key to social mobility and the American Dream, it is unfortunate to see education assessments so badly skewed. The prospect of millions of American children leaving school unprepared for college and career is alarming.

The NAEP and state assessments also show that racial disparities continue to persist in the nation. All children must have equal opportunity to a quality education that gives them the best chance at success in life. Children who do not receive a quality education are disadvantaged in terms of

college and career opportunities. They are also more likely to be engaged in the juvenile justice system and to earn less in lifetime income. The nation also suffers, facing diminished workforce capacity, decreased national competitiveness and declining economic viability. Decision-makers and education leaders must recognize that learning begins before school, and that there is a link between school performance and early care and education. Research has demonstrated that children who have access to quality early care and education are more likely to be successful in school. Y VI

The results of the most recent NAEP and state assessments are a call to action. Reading is an essential prerequisite skill for learning, and children who are not proficient in reading will struggle academically and are more likely to drop out of school. The discrepancy between performance on national and state assessments indicates that most states need to address their standards. States should work together to determine what students should know and be able to do to effectively compete in a global economy.
