




## County Maps of the English Learner (EL) Population

The following maps depict the EL population by county—changes in their numbers from SY 2000-01 to SY 2011-12, and the total number and percentage of all students identified as ELs in SY 2011-12. The maps were created using county data from the National Center for Education Statistics' Common Core of Data.

(Note: Data are not available for all counties for each map provided.)

### Increase

- 10,000 or more (N=19)

- 9 or fewer (N=336)


### Decrease

- 100 - 999 (N=106)
- 10 - 99 (N=192)
- 9 or fewer (N=146)


- No change (N=166)
