SUBJECT: FY2008-FY2013 SDPBC HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES COLLEGE MATRICULATION SUMMARY

The National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) is an independent organization that tracks the postsecondary enrollment and success of students in more than 3,300 colleges and universities nationwide. The School District of Palm Beach County (SDPBC) has contracted with the NSC to provide data on our students to better understand postsecondary patterns and success.

The Department of Research, Evaluation, and Assessment (DREA) has performed a preliminary analysis of this data on students who graduated from the SDPBC in 2008 through 2013.¹

- Enrollment in the fall after graduation
 - From 2008 to 2013, slightly more than two-thirds of SDPBC graduates attended a postsecondary institution (Table 1).
 - Most students attending college enroll in a public college or university (Table 2), an in-state institution (Table 3), and a four-year college (Table 4).²
 - o Palm Beach State College is the most common school choice for SDPBC graduates (Table 5).
- Enrollment rates in the years after graduation (Table 6)
 - o Approximately 80% of SDPBC graduates enroll in college within the first four years after graduation.
- Degrees achieved in the years after graduation (Table 7)
 - Of FY2008 graduates, 20% achieved an associate degree, 29% received a bachelor degree, and 1% received a master degree.

Tables 8 – 11 give similar data for enrollment in the fall for SDPBC comprehensive high schools.

¹ Graduates are defined as end of year twelfth-graders who earned a standard diploma and are in the state four-year federal cohort (which does not include special diplomas or GEDs).

² The National Student Clearinghouse has classified Palm Beach State College (formerly Palm Beach Community College) as a four-year institution for all years in this analysis.
