

#### 2009 ACT and SAT Test Results

The attached data tables show the multiyear summaries of AISD student participation and performance on the ACT and SAT college entrance exams. ACT and SAT data are summarized to show district level participation and performance since 2005 or 2006, comparisons of district, state and national performance, comparisons of performance by ethnicity and 2009 student performance by campus.

## **Highlights**

#### SAT

- In general, AISD students show short- and long-term decreases in each SAT subject area for participation and performance. This parallels general state and national trends. However, since 2005, there were increases in the number of AISD student participants among the following student groups: Native American, Asian, African American, and Other Hispanic (not Puerto Rican, Mexican, or Mexican American).
- Compared to the State and the Nation, AISD student performance on the SAT is:
  - ✓ Higher than the State and the Nation for Mathematics
  - ✓ Higher than the State and equal to the Nation for Verbal
  - ✓ Higher than the State but lower than the Nation for Writing
- Asian, Puerto Rican, Other Hispanic (not Mexican or Mexican American), and White students showed an increase on the Verbal and Writing portions of the test from 2008 to 2009. Native American, Asian, and White students showed improvements in Math during this time.
- Since 2005, White and Puerto Rican students improved in both the Math and Verbal portions of the test. Asian students also improved on the Verbal assessment during that time. Since 2005, African American and Mexican or Mexican American students made performance gains on the Math portion of the test. However, the SAT performance gap seems to be widening for Other Hispanic (not Mexican or Mexican American) students as compared with White and Asian student groups on the Math and Verbal portions of the test.

## ACT

- AISD student performance on ACT changed little over one year, but increased by 0.5 to 1.1 points, on average, since 2005.
- In Math, AISD students' average score was slightly above that of the State and the Nation. In other subjects, AISD student performance was similar to that of the State and slightly lower than that of the Nation.
- Since 2005, African American and Hispanic students' ACT performance continues to lag behind their White and Asian peers. However, every student ethnic group has improved their ACT performance in all subjects over the past four years, but gaps among these groups have widened slightly. From 2008 to 2009, Asian and African American students' ACT performance gap widened or remained the same for all subjects tested. White and Hispanic students' performance increased for all subjects during that period.
- Asian and Hispanic students' increased participation between 2008 and 2009 shows these groups are closing the gap in ACT participation. Long-term participation increases also occurred among Asian, Hispanic, and White students, from 2005 to 2009.
